1. A trial is proceeding against certain Italian Civilians charged with black-market and other offences in Teramo Province. One of the accused, ANTONIO APPALINO, a well known partisan leader, is stated to have been known to No. 107119 Lt. G.W. LAYLAND, 2nd S.A. M.R. Regt. of MODWRA, Camp No. P.G. 47, who had made a statement setting forth the good work of Appalino in his activities against the Germans.
This statement would be useful to the defense, and the Court of Appeal, Aquila, has asked that the signature of Lt. Layland to the statement be verified.
2. Enquiries have been made at the Allied Screening Commission, but without result.
3. It is assumed that Lt. Layland is still in the Union, as at 15 Feb 45, and this being the case it would be appreciated if the attached statement, forwarded to this office by H.Q. Allied Commission, could be affirmed by him and the signature duly witnessed by a magistrate.
4. Could the matter please be treated as URGENT.

Attache correspondence refers to a trial in consequence of 15 arrests for blackmarket and other activities in TERAMO Provinces in August 1944, while a Capt BOWD was acting as PPSO.

The subject of the correspondence, AMMAZZALORSO Armando, a well known partisan leader was alleged to be implicated and also arrested, later while being transferred from Chieti Prison to Teramo Prison, a demonstration took place outside Teramo Prison and in the confusion AMMAZZALORSO and two of his henchmen escaped. They are still at large.

The trial is to proceed, however and the Court of Appeal Aquila, has asked for proof of authenticity of the signature to the attached document.
