SUBJECT : Powers of Regional Public Safety Officers.
TO : R.P.S.O.s Liguria, Piedmonte, Lombardia and Venetia.

1. Recent reports from R.P.S.O.s received at this Hq. tend to show they are somewhat uncertain of their position in relation to the Italian Government.

2. Whilst the Northern Provinces are in A.M.G. territory it is stressed that no orders from an Italian Ministry are valid in such territory unless they are submitted through and approved by this Hq. furthermore only so much of the Decrees may be implemented in accordance with the recognized policy of Allied Commission.

3. So far as R.P.S.O.s are concerned, they are the King Pins in their respective Regions for controlling the administration and operation of all Italian police forces within their areas and may give such directions and orders as will best ensure law and order being maintained, always remembering that, under International Law it is not within the power of an occupying Force to change the constitution of a Force or institution.

4. It is hoped that the above will assist to clear up any doubt which at present exists.

1. An exhumation is being carried out in the cemetery of Genoa-Sestri of persons killed and buried there during the insurrection.

2. To date 21 bodies have been recovered only 5 of which have been identified as follows:

- Ferrari Carlo fu Giovanni, aged 64 from Ge-Cornigliano - Forman of Ansaldo.
- Caviglia Salvatore aged 38, from Sampierdarena, forman of Ansaldo.
- Ferrarsini Gustavo aged 60, from Sampierdarena, forman of Ansaldo.
- Pinas Antonio, aged 49, from Cornigliano workman of Ansaldo.
- Bonatti Silvana of Ferrando, aged 19, from Genoa, student.
