SUBJECT: Explosive Material in the Prefettura, Turin.

TO: HQ Piemonte Region, AMG (for Regional Commissioner).

1. I have to report for your information that on Friday 5 Oct 45, a report was received that a package containing some explosive material had been found under the Prefect's table in the Prefettura. The account of the events leading to this discovery is based entirely on the story of a 20-year old youth.
2. At about 1900 hrs 5 Oct 45 a youth named Domenico ISIGLIO, aged 20, a close friend of the Prefect, was walking near his home when he is supposed to have overheard a conversation between some persons unknown, which led him to believe that a plot had been arranged to harm the Prefect, and that a bomb or other explosive had been planted in the Prefettura.
3. He immediately went to the Prefettura on his bicycle and went into the private room of the Prefect. At the time it was occupied by the Prefect and 4 or 5 other persons. Isiglio warned the Prefect and the others of what he had heard and told them to leave the room. Isiglio, alone in the room, commenced to search. Some five minutes later he came out of the room carrying a small parcel, and went on to the balcony overlooking the Piazza Castello. According to Isiglio's own story there were several people in the Piazza at the time, and he would have endangered their lives had he thrown

20, a close friend of Isiglio, is supposed to have overheard a conversation between some persons unknown, which led him to believe that a plot had been arranged to harm the Prefect, and that a bomb or other explosive had been planted in the Prefettura.

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4. There are many items in Isiglio's statement which require ~~to be~~ investigation. It is however clear that when he left the Prefect's room, he was carrying a small parcel. In view of the panic caused by Isiglio, it has not been possible to obtain a statement from any other person as to the size or condition of the parcel, or whether

it was possible to see or handle the contents. It is also true that after he threw this package away, there was an explosion. The disturbance to the ground shows that the explosive was not very powerful, and that the explosion could have been caused by a hand grenade.

5. Investigations continue, and when they are completed, I will submit a full report.

In Turin on the evening of the 5 th inst, a certain Iseglio Domenico overheard casually two unknown persons talking about a terroristic attempt against the local Prefect. The bomb had already been placed into the Prefect's Cabinet.

The Iseglio referred at once the news to the Prefecture.

A bomb was thus discovered under the writingtable of the Prefect, and thrown away into the near ditch surrounding Palazzo Madama, were exploded.
