1. It is requested that fare concession may be granted to personnel of the Venezia Giulia Police Force travelling by railway, on duty and on leave, within Zone A and in Italy proper.
2. It is suggested that personnel who require to travel on duty should be permitted to do so free of charge. All such personnel would be issued with a certificate for each journey signed by an officer of the Force not below the rank of Inspector.
3. For personnel proceeding on authorised leave it is requested that reduction of 70% may be granted as in the case of Italian Military personnel and that a reduction also be granted to their wives and children.
4. It is requested that authority be given as soon as possible for Zone A and that application be made to the Head office of I.S.R. for similar concession in Italy.
5. A copy of this letter is being sent to AMG 13 Corps, to H.Q. Allied Commission in Rome with a request that these concessions are recommended to the Head office of I.S.R.
