TO : Venetia Civil Police Force

1. Reference is made to your VPR/18/34 dated 27 Feb. 46.

2. This matter was taken up with Legal S/C and referred to the Italian Government. It has been arranged that 200 prisoners can be transferred as follows :

49	prisoners	to	the	penal	jail	of	Padova
12	"	"	"	"	"	"	" Piacenza
30	"	"	"	"	"	"	" Firenze
37	"	"	"	"	"	"	" Perugia
19	"	"	"	"	judicial	jail	of Parma
33	"	"	"	"	"	"	" Belluno
20	"	"	"	"	"	"	" Urbino

3. Judicial prisons should only receive prisoners whose term of penal servitude does not exceed 5 years. Former members of Martial Forces should not be sent to MILANO.

4. Transfers can take place immediately, but prior notice of arrival should be given to the Prison directors concerned.

1. It is desired to draw your attention to the fact that the prisons in this area are becoming increasingly overcrowded and in particular to the situation with regard to long-term prisoners who at present number approximately 200.

2. Italian Law (Art. 16 & 17 Prisons Regulations Book) prescribes that all prisoners sentenced for a period of longer than two years shall be removed to a proper Penal Establishment and in normal times this rule would have been carried out in this area.

3. As you are no doubt aware, however, there are no Penal Establishments in Zone 'A' and long-term prisoners are of necessity being detained in prisons which are in no way suitable to accommodate them. The nearest existing Penal Establishments to this area are situated at Padova and Parma. Both these prisons are in Italian Government Territory and in consequence the possibility of transferring long-term prisoners to them from this area becomes a matter of policy.

4. Chief Legal Officer, AMG, 13 Corps, has been consulted and he states he has no objection to the removal of long-term prisoners to penal prisons in Italy; he suggests, however, that only prisoners of Italian nationality be transferred in order to avoid any possible political repercussions.

5. Having regard to the seriousness of this situation, it would be appreciated if the Ministry of Grace and Justice could be approached and an agreement reached whereby they would agree to long-term prisoners in this area being transferred to either of the penal establishments in Italian Territory enumerated above.
