SUBJECT : Provisions for families of State Personnel
who are in zone occupied by the enemy.

TO : Directorates of Prevention and Penal Institutes

By the circular No. 3762 issued in November 10, 1943 the financial treatment determined by Art. 41 of the R.D.L. May 1941, No. 583, is extended to the families of the personnel who are in Territory occupied by the enemy. Said provisions must immediately be carried out by your Directorate in order to help the families of Civilian and guardian personnel.

Therefore, we authorize your Directorate to advance from March 1, 1944, one half of all the following allowances to wives and children of said personnel, or one third to their parents and other families dependants.

- a) Salary
 - b) Allowance for active duty.
 - c) Temporary war allowance.
 - d) Family allowance.
- (Other allowances are to be excluded from above, as for instance : refugee allowance, detached services allowances etc.)

The funds of such advance payments will be shown on the records of the respective Institutions.

The above temporary provisions will be enforced until appropriate legislation has been enacted there to.

The monthly records of the above mentioned advances should be sent to this Ministry together with documents of the families concerned.

 Replacement of Italian Officials in AMG Territory.

1. It is appreciated that when a vacancy exists in AMG areas for the appointment of a senior Italian official, the Regional Commissioner will frequently be at a loss to find a candidate of sufficient experience and seniority within his own region to fill such a post. Instances have occurred in which under these circumstances, officials have been appointed to a status far beyond their normal expectations of promotion.

2. In most cases when such a vacancy occurs, a qualified replacement is available elsewhere but through lack of information, the R.C. is not able to give him consideration. There must, for example, be many qualified persons in King's Italy who should be available for employment in AMG areas.

3. It is suggested that this problem of demand and supply be co-ordinated with the appropriate Ministries of the Italian Government by requesting them to recommend eligible candidates for appointment.

It is anticipated that they would be more than willing to cooperate, since the proper selection of Italian officials would be of long term advantage to them, having regard to the time when they themselves will have to administer these officials.

4. If, when such a vacancy occurs in future, the Regional Commissioner will refer to this HQ, submitting also the particulars of any local candidate whom he wishes to consider, it would be possible to ascertain from the Italian Government what other qualified persons are available for selection. The appointment would be made by R.C. subject to the necessary confirmation required from this HQ. Such a method would ensure that the selection would be made from competent and acceptable candidates, and, furthermore that the choice would no longer be limited to an otherwise restricted field.

- b) names of the personnel who is presently on actual service at the institution, including for each person the date under which he was appointed and the date he assumed his duties and specifying if he has been transferred on a permanent or temporary basis, or the transfer was a consequence of the war or he was

recalled into service for civilian mobilization

c) names of the personnel appointed at the institution but not on actual duty, specifying for each person the motives of his being absent (mission, temporary discharge from office, leave, military service, suspension from office, arbitrary leave etc.)

Subject: Prison Guards.

To : Col. Paul G. Kirk.

- 1) It is becoming apparent from information received through Regional Sources that the Italian Prison system is facing a shortage of guards. The exact number required is unknown. However, report forms recently prepared for distribution should give accurate information concerning this question with regard to liberated territory.
- 2) The Prison sub division of Public Safety Sub. Commission, ACC, has consulted with the Italian officials in the Ministry of Justice on the question. These officials, for various reasons, have refused to consider undertaking a present program for recruiting prison guards, even on a minimum basis. From their attitude it appears that they would like to wait until the entire country is liberated before undertaking such a program.
- 3) It is obvious that current needs in prison towns under A.M.F., or under Italian Government Control, should not be made to wait until this event, and that a minimum program should be undertaken as soon as possible.

4.) I recommend that the question be taken up with higher Indian authority, with a view to the establishment now of a minimum program of recruiting and training.

5). The extent of the program may be better determined with the return of the projected reports, but it is not too early to start laying the foundations.
