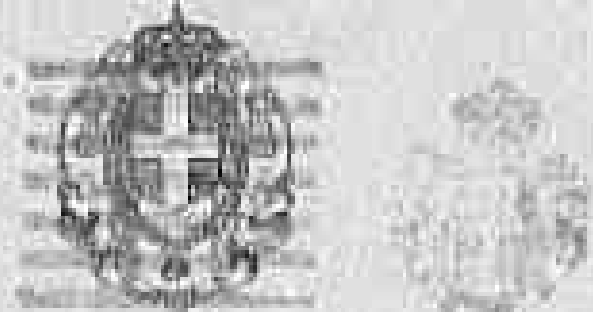

TO:

(1) The recent situation with respect to prisons points out the necessity for a regional officer assigned to coordinate the activities in the prisons of Sicily and directly responsible to the Ministry. As previously reported, a Regional Directorate was established by AMG order and Dr. Ferdinando COLUMBA was appointed Regional Director.

(2) The activities of the police in the intensive grain campaign resulted in additional overcrowding in the prisons and required a survey which led to the present construction program to alleviate the situation. In maintaining contact with this situation some difficulty has been experienced because of the lack of coordination on a regional basis.

(3) The Regional Directorate of Prisons, established by AMG order, was dissolved by order of the Italian Government. Dr. COLUMBA, relieved as Regional Director by this latter order, was appointed by the Ministry temporarily to conduct a survey of prison conditions, and has now returned to his former assignment as Director of the Palermo Prisons.

(4) Since the dissolution of the Regional Directorate an unsatisfactory state of affairs has developed with respect to prisons. There has been overcrowding, the escape of a number of prisoners, and of which seriously affect the Public Safety problem and further indicates the necessity of placing a direct representative of the Ministry in Sicily Region in order to coordinate the prison problem. It is therefore recommended that the Regional Directorate or some similar organization be re-established and that Dr. COLUMBA be re-appointed as Regional Director.

Subject : Reinstatement to duty of the warders -
SCURTI Antonio - RUSSO Giovanni - MAGGIO
Giovanni - of the Castelvetro prisons.

To : A.C.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission - Rome.

The Gen. Hq. of prisons in Sicily, with letter n. 648, dated 29/1/1944, which has been transmitted to the pretore of Castelvetro through the Trapani judicial prisons Hq., ordered the discharge from duty of the warders SCURTI Antonio, RUSSO Giovanni and MAGGIO Giovanni, attached to the Castelvetro prisons. This, because said warders have systematically neglected their duties, allowing serious abuses and interferences on the part of persons not belonging to the prison.

The pretore of Castelvetro carried into execution the a/m provision, appointing then on 1/4/1944 the as provisional warders of said prisons, CARADONNA Gaspare, FAVOROSO Giacomo and MASARACCHIO Nicolo. The a/m discharged warders appealed to this Ministry against the provision taken, asking its revocation and their re-instatement to duty.

For this purpose they have stated:

- a) that having not received in due time communication of the accusations, they have not been able to provide for their defence;
- b) that they have always performed their duties in a praiseworthy manner (Scurti since 21 years, Russo since 17 years) and that therefore the a/m provision is not justified.

Inquiries have been made re the duties performed and the behaviour of the claimers.

It appears from the reports received from the pretore and CC.RR., that Scurti, Russo and Maggio have never neglected their duties, but on the contrary displayed zeal and capacity, that they never tolerated interferences / For their special attitudes, they have been always qualified as very good and that they became still more appreciated for their conduct shown during bombardments, in as much as they remained at their post even risking their lives. 269.

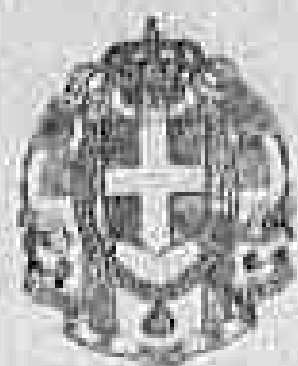
Consequently the prosecutor of the Kingdom at the Trapani tribunal has proposed the re-instatement to duty of Scurti, Russo and Maggio.

This Ministry is of the opinion, that said proposal should be accepted.

We would appreciate to know if this Commission deems it advisable to re-assume the three warders.

Data esecuzione dal pretore di Castelvetro all'ordine pervenutogli, e, nominati poi, con decorrenza dal 1° aprile 1943, custodi provvisori di quelle carceri Caradonna Gaspare, Favoroso Giacomo e Masaracchio Nicolò, lo Scurti, il Russo ed il Maggio hanno proposto ricorso a questo Ministero contro il provvedimento di dispensa, chiedendo la revoca di esso e la loro riassunzione in servizio.

All'uopo hanno addotto:

- a) che non avendo avuto a suo tempo comunicazione delle accuse, non hanno potuto provvedere alla difesa;
- b) che hanno prestato sempre lodevole servizio (lo Scurti da 11 anni, il Russo da 17 anni), e che, quindi, non è giustificato il provvedimento di dispensa.

Chieste informazioni in ordine al servizio prestato ed alla condotta dei ricorrenti, è risultato, giusta rapporti del pretore e dei R.R. Carabinieri, che lo Scurti il Russo ed il Maggio non hanno mai trascurato i loro doveri, che essi, anzi, hanno dato prove di zelo e

capacità, che mai hanno tollerato sul servizio ingerenze di persone estranee, che, per le speciali attitudini rivelate, sono stati sempre qualificati ottimi, e che hanno acquistato anche maggiore considerazione per la prova di attaccamento al dovere data durante i bombardamenti in quanto sono rimasti al loro posto di servizio anche con rischio della vita.

Tenuto conto di tali informazioni il Procuratore del Regno presso il Tribunale di Trapani ha proposto la riassunzione in servizio dello Scurti, del Russo e del Maggio, e tale proposta pare a questo Ministero meriti accoglimento.

Si gradirà ora conoscere se codesta Onorevole Commissione ritiene opportuna la riassunzione in servizio dei tre custodi.-

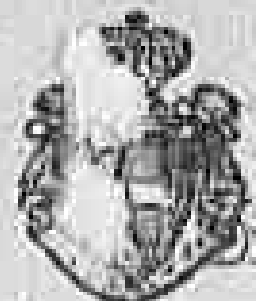
