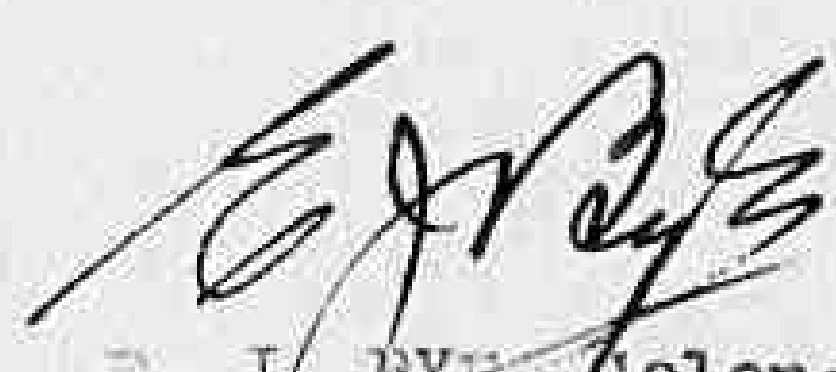

Mrs; Hedua Gabler Vilardo, wife of Prof. Dott. Saro Vilardo of Palermo, has requested certain information from this Consulate relative to proceeding to Germany for the purpose of Bringing her aged mother to Palermo to live with her. Mrs. Vilardo is a former German national but now is an Italian national by marriage. Her husband is one of the examining physicians for this Consulate.

Mrs. Vilardo's mother, a German national, is now living in Kottbus province of Brandenburg in the Russian occupied zone of Germany. She is in destitute circumstances and has written to her daughter that she can get a pass permitting her to enter the American occupied zone. Mrs. Vilardo would like to know if it would be possible for her to proceed to the American occupied zone of Germany and whether or not her mother would be permitted to leave Germany at this time.

Mrs. Vilardo is making an application with the Italian Foreign Ministry in Rome for an Italian passport and for permission to bring her mother to Italy. She would like to know also what procedure to follow if she can enter Germany.

He is a veteran of the 1st World War. During the recent war he was not able to join the Army owing to his health conditions, but was sent to Germany as a civil worker. There he remained for 4 years as a cook, and at the moment of the liberation, he was taken prisoner by the Russians. After 8 months imprisonment, he was released because seriously ill, and sent back to Italy.

She was compelled, owing to war events, to leave Tripoli on the 11/10/1941 together with her daughter, now aged 7, while her husband SCANDOLERA Armando remained in Tripoli, where he is presently working at the B.M.A. Tripolitania.

Her financial conditions are very poor, and she thus longs to re-join her husband at Tripoli, where they have their houses and all their goods.

Hoping that her petition might be granted a favourable issue, she warmly thanks in advance.

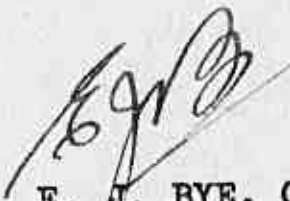

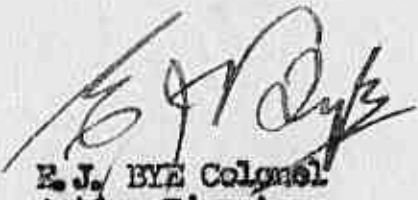
