SUBJECT : Enemy agents - MENICHELLI

TO : Executive Commissioner (thru V.P.Adm. Sec.)

1. Reference your 292 on imprisonment of enemy agent MENICHELLI.
2. The Director of Prisons has been seen at the Ministry of Grace and Justice, and the special nature of this case explained. It was agreed that MENICHELLI could be kept in solitary confinement, although this is not normally done. Further, the prisoner could be placed in the care of three specially selected prison guards.
3. When it is decided to imprison MENICHELLI, the necessary arrangements can be made by this Sub-Commission.

SUBJECT : MINICHELLI (Enemy Agent)

TO : RPSO., Region 3

1. MINICHELLI Giovanni an enemy agent has been sentenced to 20 years imprisonment. It is essential that he be held in prison in such a manner that he cannot communicate his information to other persons.
2. The Ministry of Grace and Justice have been consulted, and it is agreed that MINICHELLI can be kept in Solitary confinement, although this is not normally done. Further, the prisoner could be placed in the care of three specially selected prison guards.
3. MINICHELLI is at present in S. MARIA jail, awaiting confirmation of his sentence. It is asked that arrangements be made for him to be received at PROCIDA Island prison on or after 15th June 1944.
4. This matter is being handled by HQ., AAI., through RC and MO Section. It has been suggested that your Prison Officer, Capt. DALBY, be communicated with direct, when it is desired to transfer MINICHELLI.
