2. FUGARDI Francesco will leave Regina Coeli, Rome, at 0900 hours Friday 1 Sep 44 and arrive at AQUILA at about midday. He will be accompanied by two Military Police and two CORR.
3. Transport and escort will return to this HQ.
4. If information is passed to this office when the trial of BERLENDIS is completed, arrangements will be made by this Sub-Commission to transfer FUGARDI to Regina Coeli jail.

Subject : Espionage Trial - BENIGNO Riccardo

To : Colonel A.E. YOUNG + Director, Security Branch

1. With reference to Message No. 611/4 (HQ. ACC Message Centre No. 6656/27) received from ASI Region 5, dated 27th August, 1944, requesting the attendance as soon as possible of Francesco PUGNANI, Riccardo RABINO and Lorenzo LANSONE, who will be required as witnesses at the trial of Riccardo BENIGNO, due to commence at 0900 hours, 4th September, 1944, at Aquila. Arrangements for the attendance of the accused person were also requested.

2. RABINO and LANSONE are located in 371 POW Camp - Padula and their attendance is being arranged through HQ. AAI, OSI (b), who will also arrange attendance of accused person.

3. PUGNANI, recently sentenced to 15 years imprisonment for espionage, is at present in Regina Coeli Gaol.

4. As instructed I have discussed with Public Safety Sub-Commission (Major Wilson) arrangements for the attendance of PUGNANI at Aquila for the trial. Major Wilson stated that he could make the necessary arrangements for PUGNANI to be taken under escort, by HQ. ACC transport from Regina Coeli Gaol to AMX Aquila.

5. It is suggested that a copy of this report be forwarded to Major Wilson, Public Safety Sub-Commission, HQ. ACC for action as at para. 4. 1210
