Answers your 3738 cite ACCAS dated 15 August.

The outer port fence of the enclosed port area has been mined with antipersonnel light charges to prevent pilferage. These charges have been placed between double fences and the areas well posted with warning signs both in English and Italian and can only be reached by breaking through bars or climbing fence to reach area known to be off limits for and extended period. Information is that recent victim was killed by flying stone and that he had 35 packages of US cigarettes on his person. Since area is well protected, posted and known to be off limits and access can only be by trespassing on forbidden area responsibility for claims must be decided by individual cases.
