REPORT TO P.R.O. FROM PUBLIC SAFETY SUB COMMISSION  
THRU : Civil Affairs Section.

The sudden liberation of Northern Italy by capitulation of German and Fascist Republican Forces found a total of 75 ANG Public Safety Officers, aided by detachments of Carabinieri totalling 5650, to take over and cover almost one third of Italy in one operation.

Regularly constituted authority had been replaced by bands of Partisans, many with little or no governmental experience. Previous planning had made available these nuclei of Carabinieri and some career Questori to meet the emergency. By careful handling, the transition was quickly made. Returned carabinieri from Prisoner of War Camps totalling 1625 were added to the 4050 Carabinieri recuperated from the liberated areas. Screened Partisans after a period of training were added to the depleted ranks of Public Security Agents and some auxiliary police groups were formed from Partisans for early service. These auxiliaries are now largely disbanded. Prisons were found filled by Partisans activity and improperly guarded. By recruiting, the guard personnel was augmented and by installations of detention camps for political prisoners, a workable prison program was evolved. Special detachment

of Guardia Finanza were placed in service for border control and guarding the Adriatic shore from smuggler activities.

Whereas upon entry the murder and kidnapping reports numbered in the hundreds monthly, now they have reduced to but a few. Strikes and demonstrations still occur but concern but few in numbers and no untoward incidents are reported. While we may be in a calm before a storm it may well be said that order was made from chaos in less than four months.
