1. Attached are three copies of five false AMG stamps which have been discovered in connection with a case of forged vehicle requisition notes, licenses and trip tickets.

2. The forger has been arrested and condemned to 5 years and 3 months imprisonment, and seventeen forged documents have been recovered so far. On the other hand there are strong reasons to believe that other vehicles are circulating with forged licenses similar to those used by AMG/AC on requisitioned vehicles and forged WD Form 48 trip tickets bearing in all cases one or more of these five stamps and the forged signature of an Allied Officer of Piemonte Region. The signatures most popular with the forger were:
