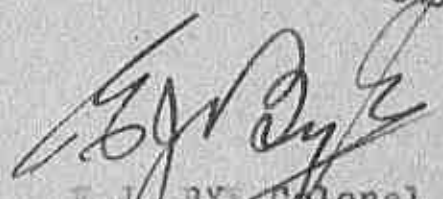
SUBJECT : Albanian Military Mission.

TO : Ministry of Interior
Director General of P.S.

1. With reference to the phone message from Dott. Ferrari to Col. Bye at 16.55 hrs 9th May 1946, with regard to the search of the baggage of the Albanian Military Mission.

2. At 17.00 hrs 9th May a telephone message was received at this Hqs. from A.F.P.Q. stating that the Albanian Military Mission was sailing from Brindisi at 6 pm 9th May 1946, and a telegram had been received by the local Italian Authorities from the Ministry of Interior giving instructions that the baggage of the Mission should be subject to rigid search before departure.

3. The Mission is accredited to A.F.P.Q. and in view of this and as the British Military Mission when leaving Albania was not subjected to special search, A.F.P.Q. have instructed the local Allied Military Commander and A.C. Liaison to arrange with the local Italian Authorities that no search of the baggage of the Mission is carried out.
