SUBJECT : Stolen baggage of Gen. Maloney and party.

TO : Ministry of Grace and Justice.

1. On 19 April 1946 in the vicinity of Capodichino Airport near Naples, certain articles of the baggage of General Maloney, U.S.A., and his party, were stolen, some of which have been since recovered. One Molinaro Mario is reported to have confessed to the commission of this offence, and on 25 May 1946 he was being held in the Poggioreale Prison at Naples awaiting trial. At that time two other Italian boys were also held in the same prison as possible accomplices in this connection.

2. By letter of the Ministero dell'Interno N° 10.31829/13052.10.230 dated 17 June 1946 it was reported to this Sub-Commission that all perpetrators of this theft, as well as the receivers of the stolen property, had been arrested.

3. It is requested that this Sub-Commission be informed in detail of the present status of the cases of all persons apprehended in connection with this matter as soon as may be practicable.

4. Please consider this request as urgent.





1. On 19 April 1946 in the vicinity of Capodichino Airport near Naples, certain articles of baggage were stolen. The baggage was the property of General Maloney and his party. Some of the articles have been recovered.

2. American Military Police of the C.I.D. in conjunction with the Italian Authorities are conducting an investigation, and MOLINARO Mario, who has confessed to the commission of the offence, is in Poggioreale Prison Naples, awaiting trial. Two other Italian boys are held in the same prison for investigation. Other arrests are expected.

3. It would be appreciated if special interest could be taken in this case to ensure a thorough investigation and the subsequent prosecution of the offenders. May we be informed of the result of the case at your earliest convenience?

1. Certain articles of baggage belonging to members of General Maloney's party were stolen on April 19, 1946 by several Italians while the group was enroute from Villa Gallotti to the Capodichino Airport. Some of the articles have been subsequently recovered but the remainder was either destroyed or sold on the black market.

2. This case was investigated by the CID office of the P.M. 6686 Railhead Group, upon which they submitted their report #4.49 to MTCUSA.

3. Molinaro Mario has confessed to the commission of this crime and is in Poggioleto Prison, Naples awaiting trial. Two other Italian boys are held in the same prison for investigation and probable connection with the crime and a later investigation may implicate others.

4. You are requested to contact the appropriate Italian authorities in connection with this matter to ensure their interest in its prosecution and to advise the commanding General MTCUSA of the final result.
