Bolzano D.P. Camp, D.P.R.S.C. A.C., at present holds some 1300 German Displaced Persons for repatriation to Germany. Orders have been given that no more are to be accepted in the Camp. Further, D.P.R.S.C. close this Camp as soon as those in it are repatriated.

It is understood that there are more German Civilians in the area for repatriation and it is thought that the Italian Authorities may re-open the Camp. Nothing is known at this Sub Commission concerning this movement of 3000 Germans through Bolzano.

1. Reference is made to your ACJO/EZ/41.a dated 13 June 1946.
2. Nothing is known of the movement of 3,000 Germans through the Separation Centre at Bolzano on way to Germany. Displaced Persons and Repatriation S/C further state that no facilities exist for such large scale repatriation. Infact, for some month past endeavours have been made to repatriate much smaller numbers of Germans but without success.

Separation Centre.

The Ministry of Treasury write to have been informed by the Allied Commission that some 3000 Germans will pass through the Separation Centre of Bolzano on the way to Germany for evacuation from Italy.

Following this the Ministry has instructed me, in agreement with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Allied Commission, in order that this Prefettura should appoint a person to supervise the sequestration, in accordance with the present laws of Italy, of the property of enemy aliens, and with the responsibility to take in charge the personal property of the evacuees when they leave for Germany.

I should be grateful to you if you could give me more particulars about this future transit of German subjects so that I can proceed to the appointment of the person in question, for the supervision of the sequestration.

Ciò premesso, il predetto Ministero mi ha fatto pervenire delle istruzioni, d' intesa con il Ministero degli Affari Esteri e sentito anche la Commissione Alleata, in base alle quali questa Prefettura dovrebbe procedere alla nomina di un sequestratario che, in relazione alle disposizioni in vigore in Italia per il sequestro dei beni dei sudditi nemici, avrebbe l' incarico di prendere in custodia gli effetti personali dei singoli evacuati all' atto della loro partenza per la Germania.

Sarei grato alla S.V. se volesse darmi più dettagliati elementi in ordine al preannunciato transito di sudditi tedeschi, affinché io ne abbia norma agli effetti della eventuale nomina del sequestratario di cui trattasi.
