1. Information has today been received from the Dutch Representative at Trieste that the following Dutch subject is suspected of fraudulent activity

- De Lange Heinrich

born at Hausenkirchen on the 11st May 1913, holder of Dutch passport No. 434930, issued at Le Hague on the 13rd Dec '45 and military entry permit No. 59922 for the British and United States, zones of Germany, issued at Le Hague on the 21st Jan '46 and signed by A.F. Francois Lt.

2. De Lange also holds a letter from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Holland, and is believed to be armed with further similar credentials. He has obtained money from a Dutch man at Basel and at the beginning of March he obtained money from the Dutch Consulate in Milan by saying that he was on official economical mission and that his money had been stolen. He is travelling with his wife.

3. As this information emanated from the Dutch Consul at Milan, would you please verify this at the Dutch Consulate and make further enquiries as to the authenticity of the military entry permit. Kindly inform this Office of the result.

4. To information addressees: if this man is found in this district please detain and notify this Office.

1. Reference your 73P/15/44 of 27 May 1946.
2. The writer today had an interview with the Dutch Consul and the Secretary who dealt with Lange when he was in Milan.
3. Your knowledge of this man is fundamentally correct and is, in fact almost a translation of the notification sent to the Dutch Consul in Trieste by the Consulate in Milan.
4. The following small conferences and additions however may be of interest:-
 - (a) De LANGE's papers and credentials were so perfect and his manner of speech so confident that the Dutch Secretary in Milan immediately suspected him, had his papers copied and refused him financial aid.
 - (b) De LANGE went to a Sig. NIEUWENHAUS G.J. of Via S. Martino 20, Milan, who is director of Philips Radio, told the hard-luck tale and obtained a loan of 16,000 lire.
 - (c) LANGE then left Milan (early in March) for Bale where he stayed at the Hotel Jura and left after a week without settling his bill.
 - (d) LANGE had arranged with Mr. NIEUWENHAUS to leave an envelope at the Hotel Jura, containing the 16,000 lire lent to him in Milan. This he failed to do. He however sent a telegram to NIEUWENHAUS a copy of which is attached, as NIEUWENHAUS had in the meanwhile gone to Holland and expected to stay at the Jura Hotel in Bale on his way back to Milan.
 - (e) A copy of LANGE's Travel orders are enclosed but confirmation has not yet been received from the Hague, whether these orders are genuine or even ~~however~~ whether ~~KRAMER~~ who signed the orders actually exists at this ministry. It is however thought that this movement order is false.

(1) A copy of the declaration made at the Questura Milan on 2 - 3 - 46 is also enclosed for what it is worth.
5. As the Military ENTRY PASS IT was issued in the Hague, it is not possible for this Office to verify its validity but a copy is attached herewith.

6. As the Dutch Consul has been most cooperative and in view of the possibility of this Office being closed at an early date, will you please keep the Dutch Consulate posted if you succeed in locating this man.
