SUBJECT : Offences by Italians.

TO : Executive Commissioner,
(thru V.P., C.A. Section)

1. On 19th June 1946, Camerino, Gino, of Via del Garbero No. 30, Rome, was arrested by Agents of the Questuri for offences in connection with the importation of sugar into Italy.

2. On being searched the attached documents, 2A to 6A, were found on him.

Nos. 3A to 5A are of no interest to this Hq. 6A is a pass issued to Camerino, authorizing him to enter this Hq. on 25th July, (presumably 1945), and No. 2A is a letter from Lt.Col. Campbell dated 9th March 1946 to Avvocato G. Arpesani, Presidency of the Council of Ministers, regarding the handover of certain dumps in Bolzano to the Italian Government.

3. The letter appears to be the original, but no enquiry has been made to ascertain how it came into the possession of Camerino, who is a civilian, and not an employee of A.C.

The copy letter from Messrs. Fiat was not found on Camerino.
