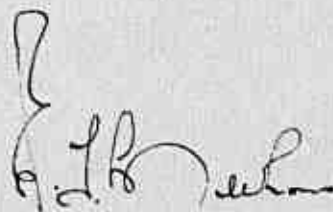

The prison director of Ascoli Piceno writes on 14th April 1946 that a political prisoner, named CIOCCOLI CARLO, was brought to this prison ^{on 22 July 1944} in order to remain at the disposal of the local Allied Military Authorities.

On 2nd September 1944 the Italian Judicial Authority issued a warrant of arrest against the said individual, and he should be tried within a very short time by the Court of Assize for political offences.

After the said warrant of arrest has been issued, the Allied Military Command of Ascoli Piceno repeated their order to hold Ciocchi at their disposal.

In order to clear the status of said individual, and on account of his imminent trial before the Court of Assize, the prison director begs to inform him, if the above named person should still remain at the disposal of the Allied Command.
