Dear Brigadier Carr,

Our Delegation has been informed that on December 24, 1946, the U.S. Military Police in Milan arrested a Yugoslav citizen, ZIVOTA MELAMED, who is bearer of a regular Yugoslav passport endorsed with the visa for Italy, issued in Bern on Dec. 20, 46, valid for Italy for 15 days.

According to the same information Mr. Zivota Melamed was handed over by the U.S. Military Police to F.S.S. in Milan, wherefrom he was transferred to the San Vittore prison, where he is still detained.

I have the honour to request herewith that I may be urgently informed about the reasons of Mr. Zivota Melamed's arresting, and that steps be taken for his release without delay.
