Polish delegations proposed visit to MONFALCONE and TRIESTE shipyards and the Poles move to VENICE, ref signal this HQ GL/1013 dated 2 October, seem clearly inter-related and part of communists plan to strengthen externally their influence generally in VENEZIA GIULIA and the shipyards and area of MONFALCONE where considerable tension amounting to unrest already exist.
2. Cannot stress sufficiently that the visit of such a delegation to VENEZIA GIULIA should not in any circumstance be permitted. All informed.

2. An application (copy enclosed) from the Polish Embassy for a
Polish Delegation to visit the shipyards in TRIESTE and MONFALCONE in
connection with a commercial treaty which was being negotiated with the
Italian Government, was received by this Commission on 30 August 1946.

3. In accordance with normal procedure vide this Commission's
Letter GRI.389-506/40 dated 5 March 1946 (copy enclosed) to the Italian
Government and to XIII Corps whereby all applications to enter Venetian
Giulia are to be channelled through the local Questura to AMG Venezia
Giulia Police Force, the application was forwarded to the Italian Ministry
of Foreign Affairs for transmission through the Ministry of Interior
(Questura) to Venezia Giulia for decision.4. This procedure, the passing of applications for entry into
Venezia Giulia through Questura channels, was put into operation after
APM and XIII Corps had been consulted by Major H.S. Simonds, G-M, APM
(attached to Travel Control Division, C) and had agreed to it.5. Although the agreed procedure was followed in this case, I
consider that perhaps it should not apply to delegations of foreign powers,
and if you concur I propose that in future applications of this nature
received by this Commission shall be submitted to your HQ for decision.

 - (c) Persons having urgent family affairs to conduct; i.e., death, serious illness, important financial or property matters concerning the settlement of estates, etc.
 - (d) Return of persons resident in Venetia Giulia prior to 1st May 1945.

5. Where applications are approved by XIII Corps the permit will be sent direct to the Questura from which it was received.

SUBJECT : Travel Control between VENEZIA GIULIA
and other Italian Provinces.

TO : The Ministry of the Interior
The Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

1. In order to bring about a more efficient control of movement
between VENEZIA GIULIA and other Italian provinces a revision of present
procedure is proposed.

2. It is suggested that the Italian Government should appoint a
liaison officer and small staff to be attached to a Military Formation
at UDINE. This officer would be empowered to approve or refuse applica-
tions to enter other parts of Italy on behalf of the Italian Government.

3. He would pay frequent visits to the permit office in TRIESTE
and to H. XIII Corps for the purpose of examining applications and to
submit applications to enter the Anglo-American occupied zone from other
Italian Provinces.

He would also pay liaison visits to the Displaced Person
Chiefs in TOLMEC and TILIGLIO to advise on moves of Italian nationals and
represent the Italian Government's views.

4. Applications to enter the Anglo-American occupied zone from
other parts of Italy would be received at questura and be forwarded di-
rect to the Military Permit Office in TRIESTE. Permits approved will be
despatched to the questura originating the application.

5. It will be appreciated that the right to move persons between
the Provinces of UDINE and VENEZIA GIULIA would be reserved by H. XIII
Corps but the recommendations of the liaison officer would be followed
in cases involving movement into other parts of Italy.
