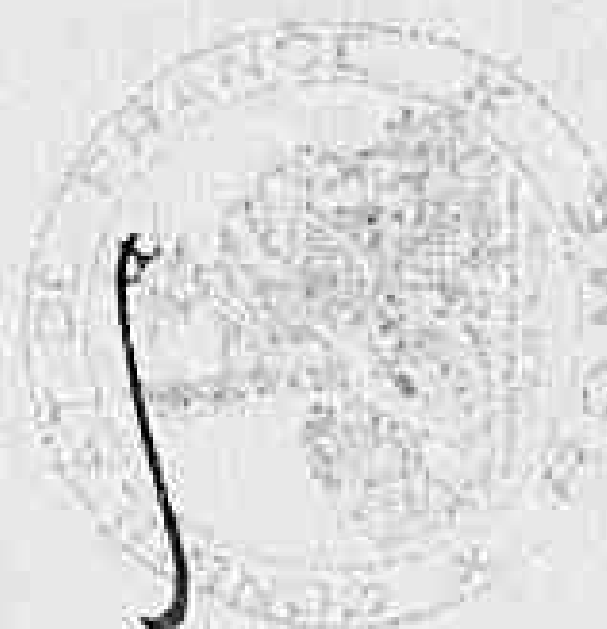

TO : Ministry of Industry Commerce & Labour
(Liquid Fuels Section)

1. The question of the issue of motor vehicle circulating permits to Consular officials has recently been under consideration, and it has been decided that permits may be issued to these officials without reference to this Headquarters in any case in which the Italian Foreign Office is satisfied that :-

(a) applicant is a properly accredited Consular official, and

(b) the use of the vehicle is necessary to meet the needs of the Consulate.

2. This Headquarters considers that in ordinary circumstances the issue of permits should be restricted to Consuls and Vice Consuls.

3. Attention is drawn to the fact that circulating permits must not be issued to Consular officials unless petrol ration coupons are issued at the same time as the permits.

4. Will you please advise your dependent offices accordingly.

1. Further to letter, even number, dated 23 January, 1945, in which it is stated that instructions would be issued at a later stage with regard to the issue of circulating permits in the case of five motor vehicles said to be used in the service of the Argentine Embassies.
2. The issue of circulating permits is not approved in the case of Nos. 1, 2, 11 and 12 shown on your list. It is considered that the use of the vehicles in question is not justified. With regard to Nos. 11 and 12 on the list, according to available information, the Military Mission, Argentine Embassy, has long since ceased to function as such.
3. With regard to No. 13 shown on your list, it is understood that Sig. FILIBERTO Carlos E. now holds the rank of Military Attachee, and that a diplomatic permit has been issued to him for his vehicle by the Italian Foreign Office.
4. The documents relating to all five vehicles are returned herewith. Please arrange for the owners of the vehicles referred to in paragraph 2 to be informed that their applications for permits have been refused.

(Att. Maj. Ballance)

1. Reference your AC/114,02/19/PS of 6 February 1945, - above subject.
2. The Military Mission, Argentine Embassy, has long since ceased to function as such, according to available information, and Mr. Diaz is now employed as a clerk.
3. It is not considered by this office that the issue of permits is justified in any of the cases under consideration with the possible exception of (C) PIZZOSCHI Charles M. who is a genuine Diplomat accredited to the Quirinal according to the list submitted by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
4. The other cases are not recommended by this office for the following reasons:-
 - a) BUCCIARELLI Tommaso. It is considered that the Private Secretary of the Ambassador would have the full use of the diplomatic vehicles at the disposal of the Embassy, and that his work could not justify the issue of a permit for a car for his own personal use.
 - b) CIOCE Francisco. This man is at present released on bail charged with travelling without a permit and carrying firearms. This, in itself, would seem a sufficient reason for not issuing a permit.
 - d) and c) DIAZ Adolfo Villalba. For the reasons submitted in paragraph two.
5. The Political Section concurs in the general view that the issue of such permits is not justified.

1. Transmitted herewith is a list of eight vehicles in respect of which applications for circulating permits were submitted to the Camera di Commercio, Industria e Agricoltura di Roma. The eight vehicles are said to be at the service of organizations under the jurisdiction of the Holy See.
2. The applications in question have been refused by this Headquarters as they were not submitted in accordance with the procedure as agreed to by the Vatican and this Headquarters. The Camera di Commercio has been advised to refer all individual applicants to the Governatorato, through whom all such applications must be channelled.
3. This Headquarters considers it undesirable that any attempt should be made to obtain the issue of permits except in accordance with the agreed procedure.
4. This Headquarters would be glad to know that the authorities shown in the last column of the attached list have been informed of the procedure to which reference has been made.
5. In particular, this Headquarters would be glad to know whether the Governatorato was prepared to furnish motor fuel in the case of Antonio M. Apolloni since the application form completed by him shows "senza carta carburante perche al servizio Vaticano".

1. With reference to your letter 57/Dir. dated 11 January, 1945, transmitting two lists of persons applying for renewal of circulation permits in respect of vehicles used by (a) the Vatican, and (b) the Consular Services.

2. With regard to list (a), the applications are not approved. Permits must not be issued in respect of any vehicle used in the service of the Vatican except on the authority of this Sub-Commission. This authority is only given on receipt of a written request from the Governatorato of the Vatican City State together with an undertaking from the Governatorato to the effect that all POC requirements will be furnished from an allocation made available to the Governatorato by AFH.

3. Details of the eight vehicles shown on the list will be forwarded by this Headquarters to the Governatorato, for their consideration. Applicants should be referred to the Governatorato for information with regard to their applications.

4. With regard to the list (b), the following applications shown on the list are *not* *approved*

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5. With regard to No 7 shown in preceding paragraph, the Portuguese Consul called at this Headquarters and asked that 67822 Roma be substituted for 55259 Roma. The application for the latter mentioned vehicle will not be dealt with as a Consular vehicle.

6. No 10 shown on the list is not approved. Transport has already been allotted to the Royal Yugoslav Military Mission, and requests for additional transport should be made by the Mission to Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission, this Headquarters, who will take the necessary steps to authorize the issue of any permits required.

7. Instructions will be given in due course with regard to 1, 2, 11, 12 and 13 which relate to applications submitted by the Argentine Embassy and Military Mission.

8. Petrol ration coupons up to a maximum amount granted in respect of private cars will be issued in respect of the vehicles mentioned in paragraph 4. Details relating to the issue of permits and coupons will be reported to this Hq.

9. Circulating permits must not be issued unless petrol ration coupons are issued at the same time, except where specially required by this Headquarters (as in the case of Vatican, Knights of Malta, etc.) or Regional Commissioner, Lazio-Umbria Region (Petroleum Section).

10. The applications relating to the vehicles mentioned in paragraph 4, 5 and 6 are returned herewith. The remaining applications will be returned in due course.

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission (Maj. Ballance)

1. Attached is a schedule B of Consular Representatives of United and Neutral Nations presently in Italy according to the records of Political Section AC.
2. Attached also is a copy of Schedule A being those believed to be in Italy by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs which has been checked by the Political Section. The Italian Government was in some doubt about the accuracy of this list.
3. Can you say how many of those on Schedule B have been granted Circulation Permits and also arrange for those on Schedule A but not included on Schedule B to have their Circulation Permits reviewed. It is suggested that Headquarters AC should assume responsibility for issuing Circulation Permits to Consular Representatives w.e.f. 1 January 1945.
4. The question of POL supplies for the 25 Consular Representatives on Schedule B is being taken up with Petsec but it would assist if it were first known what vehicles they operate.

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1. This sub-Commission, in conjunction with Public Safety Sub-Commission, is anxious to put on a proper footing the issue of Motor Vehicle Circulation Permits and Petrol Rations to members of the Accredited Consular Service.

2. Applications are being received by local licensing Authorities from persons who consider themselves, or claim to be, entitled to privilege on these grounds but, since the Italian Government have themselves no control over the appointments at the present time (which are reserved under the Armistice Terms) they do not know who are and who are not Consuls nor which of those Italian Nationals formerly holding such honorary appointments are still recognised by their respective governments.

3. It is furthermore not possible for the Italian Government to refer to the respective Embassies as they have not in all cases been re-established as yet.

4. Attached is a list submitted by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs of those they believe - subject to considerations set out in para 2 above - to be entitled to Consular Privileges.

5. It is requested that Liaison Division will find out who is the authority at present controlling the appointment of Consular Officers and try to get as complete a list as possible to serve as a basis for some standard treatment of their requirements. Arrangements have been made to pass back to the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs any information so obtained so that an up to date register can be started.
