With reference to the speech which your Major Ballance has had with our Commissioner, we beg to point out this Central Seat's intentions about the organization which is wished to be given to the Provincial Seats in Sicily.

1. The necessities of the services which are carried out by the R.A.C.I. for the Italian Government (Public Automobile Register and Collection of road taxes) require that the actual provincial organization is maintained alike in the last years. According to this organization, each Provincial Seat directly and only depends on this Central Seat, which has the right to control the activities of the Seats about the functioning of the single services.

This is established in the convention which the R.A.C.I. has with Finance Ministry.

2. In order to coordinate in the best way the activities of the single Seats in Sicily and to give a development to all institutional services, this Central Seat would intend to entrust, from time to time, the Provincial Seat in Palermo with special tasks concerning the

In order to coordinate in the best way the activities of the single Seats in Sicily and to give a development to all institutional services, this Central Seat would intend to entrust, from time to time, the Provincial Seat in Palermo with special tasks concerning the other Provincial Seats in Sicily, according to the instructions and to the dispositions which will be ~~given~~ <sup>agreed</sup> directly by this Central Seat.

This organization is suggested by the difficulties which don't allow to this Central Seat to carry regularly out the inspection and the control of the single sicilian Provincial Seats : you know very well these difficulties which are firstly caused by the situation of transports and by the financial conditions of the R.A.C.I.

It is very important to establish that the Provincial Seat in Palermo will maintain its character of Provincial Seat. The tasks it will carry out as far as the other Sicilian Provincial Seats are concerned, depend only on a special decision of the Central Seat, to which the results of the enquiries have to be referred.

3. This Central Seat only will have right to adopt all decisions which may be suggested by the aforesaid results. In other words, the Provincial Seat in Palermo would have only the character and the functions of occasional liaison between the other Sicilian Provincial Seats and this Central Seat and between the same Sicilian Provincial Seats and the Allied Authorities, in order to carry out those tasks which from time to time, will be entrusted by the Central Seat or by the Allied Authorities.

4. On the basis of the experience which will be made in Sicily, this Central Seat will study the opportunity to extend this organization to the other countries.

2. Questions relating to the appointment of Directors of R.A.C.I. Provincial Seats must be referred to this Headquarters (Executive Memorandum No. 51, para. 4). Moreover, at the request of this Headquarters, the Central Seat of R.A.C.I. has established a pool of Directors from which appointments will be made to fill vacancies which may arise in the territories under the control of both A.R.G. and the Italian Government.
3. It is requested that a report be submitted to this Headquarters with regard to the proposed appointment.
4. The R.A.C.I. Central Seat will be asked to nominate an employee who will proceed to Ancona to report upon conditions at the Seat.

SUBJECT : SITUATION OF PROVINCIAL SEAT IN ANCONA -

We beg to relate to you following informations we have received about the situation of our Provincial Seat in Ancona.

The old manager, Dr. PIETRO MANCI, who is a fascist, has abandoned the Seat before the arrival of Allied Forces, and transferred himself to Northern Italy, with two motorcars. The premises of the Seat have been now moved to Osimo, where the Prefettura and the other public offices have been established.

In the Seat has remained Mrs. Maria Pucci Nicolai, who has assumed the functions of manager. It seems too that the Prefetto is going to appoint a new manager in the person of an engineer of the Circolo Ferroviario.

In order to avoid that the direction of the aforesaid Seat is taken by a person who does not know deeply the situation and the necessities of the R.A.C.I., we beg you to make the necessary steps for regularising the situation of the Seat in Ancona. If you wish, we could propose to you the name of an employee of this Central Seat who could go to Ancona and Osimo to reorganise the Seat and to give the necessary instructions.

SUBJECT : Appointments by the Italian Government.

TO : Director, Public Safety Sub-Commission, ACC. HQ.

Reference Memo. from this office on above subject dated 5th May 1944 (RPS 014.1) and your reply dated 11th May 1944 (ACC/14041/4/PS).

1. Attached is copy of a communication from Sig. Francesco D'AMICO seeking recognition of his appointment as Chief Director of RACI in Sicily under the terms of AMG Official Order No. 53 dated 7th February 1944 - copy attached. This is one of the appointments referred to in the above-quoted Memo.

2. The next natural step following the issuance of Order No. 53 would have been to recommend the grant of an increase in salary for Mr. D'Amico, or a special indemnity as compensation for the additional responsibilities undertaken, but time did not permit the taking of such action by AMG prior to the change-over of control.

3. Since that time various representations have been made to ACC by Mr. D'Amico as to his position but he has been advised that the matter is now one for the Italian Government and should be pursued through normal channels. To support him in such action, the question was raised by Colonel Hancock with the former High Commissioner.

4. The present communication draws attention to the fact that the Italian Government does not wish to recognise the appointment and asks that ACC should interest itself on the applicant's behalf.

5. Mr. D'Amico has rendered efficient and valuable service to his Country and AMG/ACC in controlling RACI in Sicily, and it is considered to be distinctly advantageous that control should continue through a central office and not nine Provincial seats. With the

It is suggested that it would be a retrograde step to terminate the appointment but if such a course is decided upon then it is felt that ACC. has some responsibility for urging that Mr. D'Amico should

receive some honorarium for the additional responsibilities undertaken by him during the period he has served as Chief Director of RACI in Sicily.

HAND REGISTERED LETTER

Since some days subsequent to the occupation of this town by the Allied Troops, this Allied Control Commission have been acquainted about my appointment intrusted by the Senior Civil Affairs Officers to coordinate and manage the functioning of the services of the nine RACI Provincial Offices throughout Sicily.

I have fulfilled with zeal such an office, and the orders issued by the Officers on whose direct dependence I have worked, have been scrupulously performed and caused to be performed, so that on the first days of last February, Colonel POLETTI, under his Official Order No. 53, ratified the appointment of the Regional Direction of RACI for Sicily, which had been verbally intrusted to me from August 1943.

My work has been praised in many occasions, which has much flattered me.

In the meantime, owing to the liberation of Rome by the Allied Troops, the Central Office has been re-arranged having as its Chief the Commissary Prof. Giuseppe PATRUNO and as functioning General Director, Lawyer Antonio CATALDO.

Such a Central Office although continuing to use my work for the regular functioning of the Incorporation in Sicily, purposely shows to ignore my rank of Regional Director, in spite of the report I sent on July 22 last, in which I explicitly explained the office intrusted to me by the Allied Government and I informed about Colonel POLETTI's Official Order No. 53.

I do not deem that it is according to justice and equity, because not only for over one year I have multiplied my work and responsibilities, without receiving any increase of salary and any indemnity, but they do not want to recognize morally my qualification, which was conferred on me by the Highest Authority such as the Allied Government is.

Therefore I beg the Regional Commissioner to ask the RACI Central Office in Rome to formally and substantially acknowledge my appointment as a Regional Director for Sicily and to make them pay to me the arrears of the compensation owed to me, adequated to the work performed and that I have to perform.

I rely on your interest into the matter and thanking you please accept my respectful homages.

My work has continued to be carried out with the full approval and trust of the Allied government which has always done its best to help me in my task.

I cannot say the ~~same~~ of my direct superiors. As you will already know there in Rome, the Central Seat has been re-ordered, with at the head, a commissioner and a General Director.

I have hastened to send them a report, in which I have pointed out all the work done by me for over a year with its respective responsibilities.

Said report has been sent by registered envelope on the 22nd July 44, and so far nothing have I received whether in praise, which I modestly think I deserve, or whether in plain acknowledgement. I imagine, I even have a right to believe that the Central Seat has no intention of acknowledging my qualification as General Director for Sicily, conferred me by the Allied Government by Official Order N.53, and which should be withheld until the same government intends to revoke it.

The truth is that up till now, no special recompense has been given me nor any increase in salary for the extra work done due to the new charge, in spite of the personal interest taken by Col. A.N. Hancock, who kindly wrote a letter concerning my situation to the High Commissioner (Alto Commissario).

I beg you major Ballance, for the esteem and friendship which you have always shown me, to also take an interest in my case, and, as you will certainly have the chance of having direct contact with the Central Directors of R.A.C.I. (Via Po 14), to speak to them about me and obtain for me the just reward which I think I deserve.
