NOTES FOR MAJOR BALANCE

Subject : Gasoline for R.A.C.I.'s members

Among the different institutional services of P.A.C.I. Provincial Seats, one of the most important was the distribution of gasoline to members, through many pumps, some of which belonged to the Seats and some others granted to the same Seats by the oil Societies.

This service - which was not speculative - was very important and advantageous for the members and for the prestige of our Organization.

The necessary gasoline was supplied either by direct purchase on the market or by the most important Societies (Marite, Shell, Agip, Aquila, etc.)

Regarding our institutional services, we wish to recognize this activity, partially at least (a pump for every seat) and we have to point out that this service is carried out by the R.A.C.I. for its members, who are accustomed to use for the supply of each line, for their own motorcars only, of these special pumps, which are marked by the inscription "R.A.C.I."

The sale of gasoline to P.A.C.I. members cannot trouble the market : sometimes it has contributed to moderate and regulate the prices on the market . The sale price had been established with the Societies by a special agreement.

The R.A.C.I. is sure that the "Comitato Italiano Petroli" will not get difficult the reorganization of this service, which is very important for the R.A.C.I. and for motor circulation in our Country, and that it will give the gasoline necessary for these pumps, at the conditions which shall be established by the same "Comitato".

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
