SUBJECT : Identity cards for Police.

TO : R.C.s Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia, Venezia.

1. Major Fowler RPSO Lombardia by letter dated 4th Dec. 1945 raised the question of the desirability of issuing new Police Identity cards by reason of the fact that a number of unauthorised persons are believed at the present time to be in possession of such cards.
2. This HQ. agrees with Major Fowler that in view of the fact that the northern territory will be handed back to the Italian Government at the end of the year it will not be desirable to issue new cards, but that the Director General of P.S. Ministry of Interior be asked to instruct all PPolice Agencies that Allied Police Identity cards will cease to be valid in areas handed over after the change over, giving instructions for all such cards to be collected from Police personnel and notices inserted in Italian newspapers calling attention of the Public to the change and ordering all persons in possession of such Identity cards to surrender them forthwith to their local Police Stations.
3. The Direction General and Commanding General CC.RR. are being so informed.
4. Any surplus stocks of cards you may have in hand should be discharged.

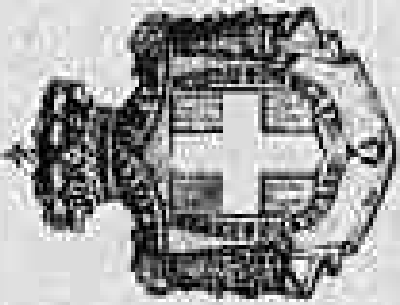

SUBJECT: Withdrawal of Identity Cards issued to Civilian Police.

The Allied Commission has signalled that a large number of identity cards issued by Allied Command to civilian police are at present in circulation.

To prevent that citizens are either led astray or taken in by persons who self-qualify themselves police officers at the dependents of the A.M.G., the Allied Commission has not only stopped issuing further identity cards but has moreover formally disposed, that these cease to be valid from day when Northern Provinces are returned to the Italian Administration.

The attention of the SS.LL. is drawn on the necessity that police Offices take care to withdraw at once documents in question, beginning with depending agents, should they hold them, and collect all those held by civic, rural guards etc.

All collected cards should be handed over to nearest Police Office and, destroy them after having registered holder's name number, date and Command which issued them.

On the understanding that all identity cards cease to have any validity at a given date, it is necessary that holders be informed through every possible means - both across the radio and local press.

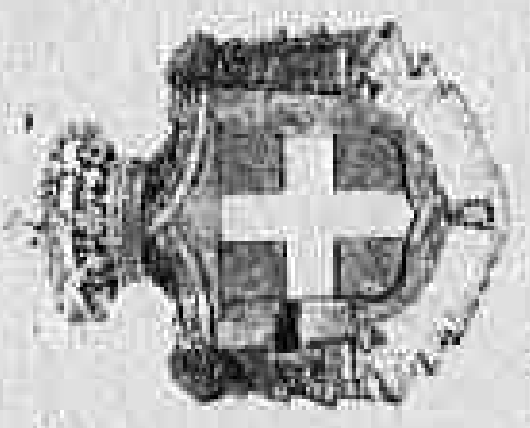

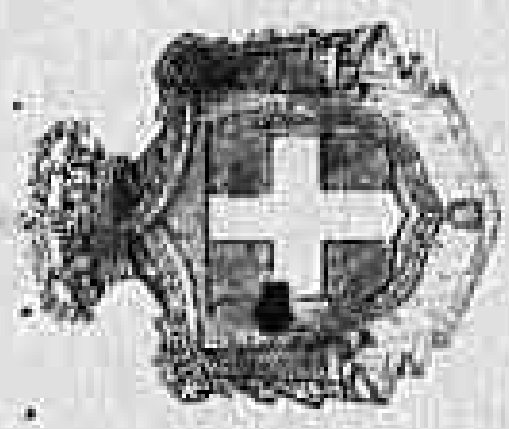

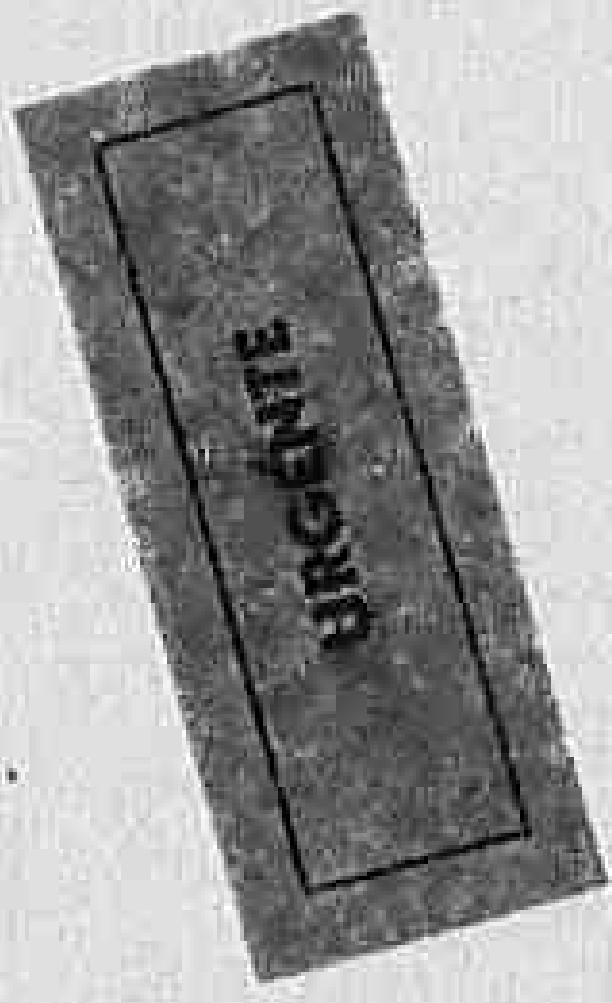

1. It is believed that at the present time there are a number of unauthorized persons in Italy in possession of Allied Identity cards for use of Civil Police.

2. In view of the impending handover of the northern territory to the Italian Government it is not deemed desirable by this Hq. that new Allied Cards should be issued, but rather that all Allied Civil Police Identity cards shall cease to be valid as and from the date of the change over.

3. It would therefore be appreciated if you would give instructions to all Civil Police Agencies that as and from the date of the handover, all Allied Police Identity Cards will cease to be valid in territory handed over to the Italian Government and all such cards should be collected from Police personnel performing duty within those areas.

4. It is also requested that you cause notice to be inserted in Italian newspapers calling the attention of the public to the change and ordering all unauthorized persons in possession of such Identity cards to surrender them forthwith at their local Police Stations.

5. This will prevent civilians being misled by persons representing themselves to be Police Officers authorized by the Allied Military Government.
6. All cards collected should be destroyed.

SUBJECT : Identity cards for Police

TO : R.Cs. Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia, Venetia

1. Major Fowler R200 Lombardia by letter dated 4th Dec. 1945 raised the question of the desirability of issuing new Police Identity cards by reason of the fact that a number of unauthorised persons are believed at the present time to be in possession of such cards.

2. This HQ. agrees with Major Fowler that in view of the fact that the northern territory will be handed back to the Italian Government at the end of the year it will not be desirable to issue new cards, but that the Director General of I.S. Ministry of Interior be asked to instruct all Police Agencies that Allied Police Identity cards will cease to be valid in areas handed over after the change over, giving instructions for all such cards to be collected from Police personnel and notices inserted in Italian newspapers regarding attention of the Public to the change and ordering all persons in possession of such identity cards to surrender them forthwith to their local Police Stations.

3. The Director General and Commanding General CC.RR are being so informed.

4. Any surplus stocks of cards you may have in hand should be destroyed.

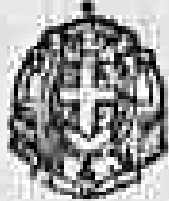
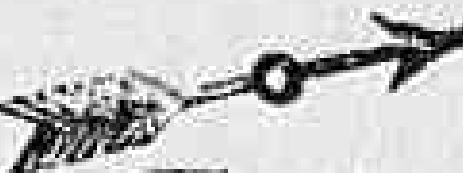

1. Reference your letter dated 9 June, 1944, relative to above named subject.
2. The facts put forward in your letter are fully appreciated at this Headquarters.
3. The directions contained in RC & MC letter, 301/33/CA, dated 28 May, 1944, are intended primarily to apply to the forward areas, but it was considered desirable that there should be uniformity throughout all regions.
4. In the case of Region I, standard identity cards should be issued to those members of the civil police services who are not already in possession of the special identity card printed in the Region.
5. The preparation of the cards for signature, and the preparation of the lists, should be undertaken by the Italian police agencies concerned.
6. A supply of the cards will be forwarded on receipt of a letter giving the number required.

1. With reference to Memo Ref. 301/33/CA. dated 28th May 1944, the identification of members of the Civil Police services is not now a serious matter within this region.
2. The problem of identification of police, principally by Military authorities did exist in the early days of the occupation but identification cards <sup>new</sup> issued and a specimen card is attached. This card proved suitable but as time went on and the various Military Authorities came to recognise the civil police agencies the necessity for continuing its issue disappeared. Further members of all organisations carry identification cards issued from Italian Authorities and their legal standing is now established.
3. In view of the large numbers of <sup>police</sup> personnel now serving in this Island, the reduced staff of Public Safety Division and the volume of work involved in issuing the cards it would seem that the scheme is not justified in this Region.
4. Further directions are therefore requested.

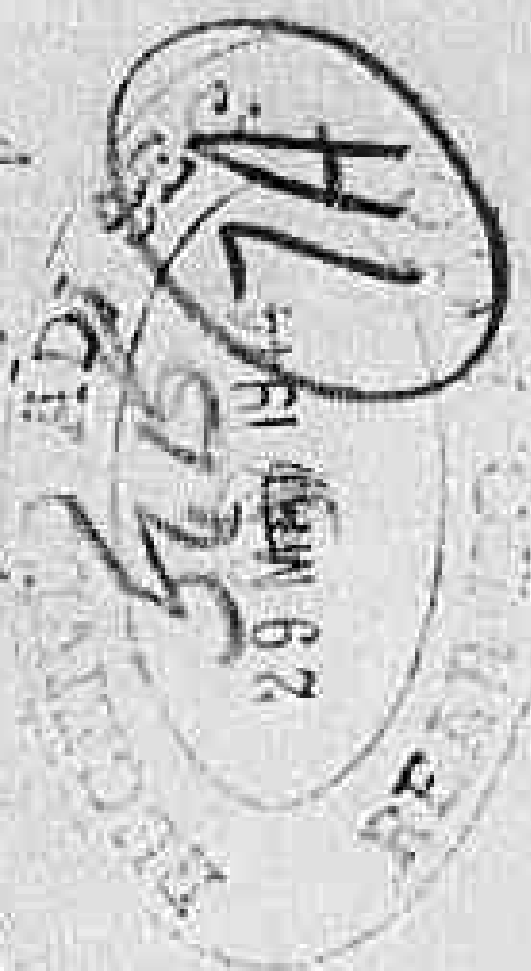
