1. According to existing Italian law, the Embassadors, Ministers and the staff of Embassies and Consulates are allowed to import their motorcars in Italy free on Customs duties.
2. Before their arrival to the Italian customs office, they should obtain by the Finance Ministry the special authorisation in order to allow them to import their motorcar without the payment of duties.
3. It is to fear that, especially in these moments, the authorisation of Finance Ministry to the Customs Offices don't arrive *fast* and therefore we suggest to this Headquarters to advise the persons who are in the aforesaid condition to provide themselves with the triptychs or the carnet de passages en douanes.
4. Triptyches and carnets de passages en douanes should be issued by the Automobile Clubs of the countries from which the motorcars owners are coming. Eyt P.A.C.I. is ready to issue to the aforesaid members of Embassies and Consulates.

With reference to your letter ACC/I4414/PS of 11th October, we beg to inform you:

1. According to existing Italian law, the Embassadors, Ministers and the staff of Embassies and Consulates are allowed to import their motorcars in Italy free on Customs duties.
2. Before their arrival to the Italian customs office, they should obtain by the Finance Ministry the special authorisation in order to allow them to import their motorcar without the payment of duties.
3. It is to fear that, especially in these moments, the authorisation of Finance Ministry to the Customs Offices don't arrive fast. Therefore we suggest to this Headquarters to advise the persons who are in the aforesaid condition to provide themselves with the triptyque or the carnet de passages en douanes.
4. Triptyques and carnets de passages en douanes should be issued by the Automobile Clubs of the countries from which the motorcars owners are coming. Evt R.A.C.I. is ready to issue to the aforesaid members of Embassies and Consulates a triptyque for the temporary importation of a motorcar into Italy. It is sufficient that this Central Seat is informed and the dispositions will be taken immediately.
5. This temporary importation may be converted in a definitive importation by the Finance Ministry. This Central Seat is ready to make also the necessary steps in order to obtain from the Finance Ministry the aforesaid authorisation.

6. Persons who don't belong to Embassies and Consulates, wishing to import their motorcars in Italy, where they intend to transfer their residence, are authorized to follow the same procedure which has been pointed out in the above paragraph.
7. After having obtained the free importation, the motorcars' owners must obtain the registration in Italy and consequently the Italian plates.
8. The members of Embassies and Consulates who are authorized by the international agreements to obtain the C.D. plates (Diplomatic Corps), must request these plates to the Communications Ministry through the Foreign Affairs Ministry.
9. Members of Embassies and Consulates who are not authorized to obtain the aforesaid C.D. plates must obtain the usual Italian plate: all the procedure may be followed by the R.A.C.I.
10. Persons who don't transfer their residence in Italy are not authorized to obtain Italian plates before having paid the customs duties, even if they have imported their motorcar with a triptyque or a carnet de passages en douanes.
11. According to the art. 102 of the road code, Italian and non Italian persons residing abroad may obtain an Italian driving license. They have to ask the issuance to a Prefettura supplying a certificate of a Consul from which it results the residence abroad and that he is in order as far as the penal law of his country is concerned.
12. The procedure for obtaining the driving permit considered in the precedent para. is not very easy. We suggest therefore all Italian and non Italian to follow another procedure, that is to exhibit to the R.A.C.I. their national driving license with passport and with three photos. The R.A.C.I. obtains from the Italian authorities an Italian and international driving permit valid for an year, after which it may be renewed.

9. Members of Embassies and Consulates who are not authorized to obtain the aforementioned C.D. plates must obtain the usual Italian plates; all the procedures may be followed by the P.A.C.I.

11. According to the art. 102 of the road code, Italian and non Italian persons residing abroad may obtain an Italian driving license. 12. The procedure for obtaining the driving permit considered in the precedent paragraph is not very easy. The P.A.C.I. obtains from the Italian authorities an Italian and international driving permit valid for an year, after which it may be renewed.

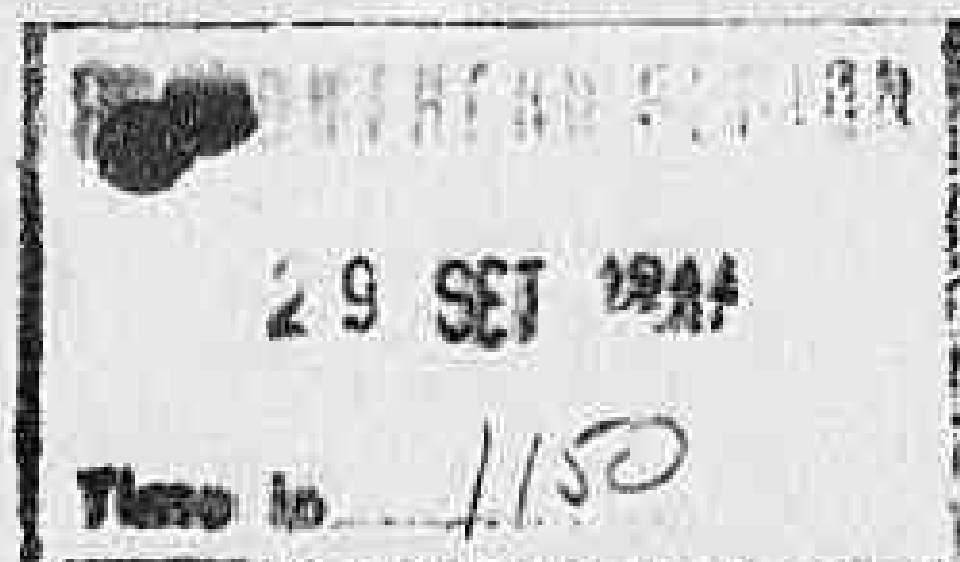

I write to seek your advice in the matter of the registration of the motor cars belonging to this Consulate-General and to members of my staff.


2. At the moment this office has three vehicles, of which one is a utility vehicle of a military type which has been sent from the United Kingdom without a number, and upon which I have had painted the legend "British Consulate-General, B.C.G1." The second vehicle is a civilian car and bears a United Kingdom registration number plate. The third vehicle is new from the makers in the United Kingdom and has never been registered. I am having painted upon its blank number plates the legend "B.C.G3". My Vice-Consuls, Mr. Garnett and Mr. Fisher, own a car between them which they brought from North Africa. This will shortly bear the legend "B.C.G5". I expect to receive further vehicles to put into commission for consular posts in the north of Italy, but I should first like to assure myself that these cars are effectively en règle with regard to the local law. If, for example, one of them is involved in an accident, will these cars be regarded in the present circumstances as being improperly upon the road? 2135

3. I presume that when Naples is handed over to the Italian authorities I shall have to have /them

them registered as directed by those authorities. I should be most grateful, however, for your advice as to whether I should take any further steps at present apart from painting my own numbers upon these vehicles, or whether any other form of registration is necessary.

4. As regards the drivers, I have two Italian chauffeurs who have my written permission to drive, and I have also granted permission to drive in writing to certain members of my staff. I should be grateful for your advice on this matter also.

I have the various correspondence concerning the distribution of film produced by Soviet Cinematographic Industries.

Col. Young has put his finger on the points involved in paragraphs 3 and 4 of his letter of Sept. 24 to your office.

Under Staff Memorandum, Number 56, issued by AFHQ to PWB in Italy, dated 1 July 1943, PWB is charged with responsibility for films in Italy. There has been no abrogation of this order, so it would seem that we are still to be held responsible for distribution. However, I do recognize that this particular request is unusual and therefore propose the following action:

1. Refer the applicant to Lt. Levi, Head of our Film Distribution Section, to discuss ways and means to meet the immediate needs through PWB's existing facilities.

2. Refer the entire matter to AFHQ for guidance on the long range point of view to cover this request and similar ones that may be made by other embassies.

2. The issue of Circulation permits and POL Allocations to members of the Diplomatic Corps has now been completed by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs to whom we turned the detail over. There may however be minor changes upwards or downwards as Diplomats come and go but the Italians have undertaken to keep us informed of all such.

3. Allocations to date are:

4. The relatively large number of Vatican Heads of Missions is due to the fact that, in addition to Diplomats accredited from Foreign Powers, there are a number of Cardinals and others who, by virtue of their appointments, or by a custom, are entitled to be considered as Heads of Missions.

1. In the process of having the Italian Ministry for Foreign Affairs issue to Diplomatic Missions Circulation Permits and Petrol Rations, it has come to light that the Spanish Embassy have very many more vehicles and Diplomatic personnel than other States.

2. Since they may be considered as an Axis Power although not at war with the Allies, it seems somewhat unsatisfactory that they should receive greater facilities than other more friendly Powers and also somewhat questionable whether they need all the Secretaries and Attachés (especially the Press Attaché) under the changed conditions.

3. Attached is a schedule of these vehicles and personnel and it is requested you will state whether it is the Policy of the Allies to maintain the status quo or to insist on a reduction. If the latter it should be done at the end of October when the Italian Government are issuing new Diplomatic Targa plates and calling in the old ones.

4. An early reply is therefore requested.

1. Reference conversation today, Major Lionel Fielding - Major W.C. Ballance, and attached letter received from "Représentation du Gouvernement de l'Union des Républiques Soviétiques Socialistes Apres du Gouvernement d'Italie" requesting the issue of two motor vehicle circulating permits to a Mr Giovanni de Berardinis, Concessionaire of Russian films in Italy, to enable him to arrange for the distribution of films produced by Soviet Cinematographic Industries.
2. It will be remembered that before issuing a permit the issuing authority must be satisfied that:-
 - (a) The use of the vehicle is to serve an essential public need; and
 - (b) The motor fuel used will be drawn from authorized sources.
3. The essentiality of the film industry has been recognized, but hitherto, all requests from film agencies have been dealt with by P.S.B. to whom, in ordinary circumstances, applicant would have been referred.
4. The request from the Soviet Embassy is the first of its kind that has been received at this Headquarters, and as similar requests may be received from other Embassies, it is requested that the views of P.S.B. be obtained in order that a statement of policy may be issued on this matter.

a) particulars of the permits already issued to functionaries of the Embassy. It should be indicated which of these permits are issued to members of the Diplomatic Corps. In the case of the standard form of permit, the status of the functionary to whom issued should be shown.

b) particulars of the vehicles for which permits are required, the status of the persons requiring the use of the vehicles, and the purposes for which the vehicles will be used. 21

3. Motor vehicle permits (and fuel rations) are issued only on the basis of essential public need, it will therefore be appreciated that there must be a complete justification for every permit issued.

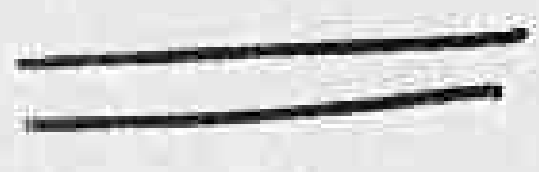

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of 4 Sept 44, and note that you agree that diplomatic privileges should be granted to three Cardinals by virtue of their special position in the Holy See, and that the Secretary of State and two of his Deputies are also entitled to diplomatic privilege. We also understand that the four Prelates mentioned at the end of your fourth paragraph will continue to be granted diplomatic privilege.

2. We also note the personnel who will not be granted this privilege.

3. To insure a full understanding of the matter, we request that you will be good enough to hand us, when complete, the list of all those diplomats, or persons accredited to or associated with the Holy See, to whom diplomatic permits and petrol rations have been granted, and that you will also confirm, if that be so, that the whole of the diplomats accredited to the Quirinale, and listed in the schedule attached to your letter of 25 Aug 44, have actually been granted diplomatic permits and petrol rations.

4. We confirm having handed to Pett. Belcredi on 4 Sept 44 two schedules marked A & B containing names of those

4. We confirm having handed to Dott. Belcredi on 4 Sept 44 two schedules marked A & B containing names of those diplomats who have already applied to Rome licensing office, and have been granted diplomatic circulation permits (List A), and those persons who have similarly been granted ordinary circulation permits because their diplomatic status was in doubt. It is requested that you will examine these lists and will not issue duplicate circulation permits to those entitled to them and who already have them, and that you will issue them to those who have not yet been granted them, or to whom only a circulation permit has been granted.

5. It is also requested that you will draw our attention to any persons listed on schedules A & B who have been granted circulation permits but are not entitled to diplomatic privilege, or are not in your view even entitled to special consideration. We can well believe that there

may have been persons who have been treated with special consideration who are not in fact, under to-day's conditions, entitled to it.

6. We also confirm having headed to Dept. Ed credit 200 diplomatic circulation permits, and 200 record cards, and we understand that these will enable you to complete the issue of both circulation permits and letters of authority for ratifications to those entitled to them. We understand that those for diplomats and personnel of the Holy See will be passed in bulk to the Holy See for distribution, in accordance with custom.
