2. Reference is made to our ACC/14503/2/PS dated 22 August para 5.

3. It is the firm view of this Headquarters that the office of General Inspector should be filled by a fully qualified TECHNICAL Officer of the Fire Service.

Prefect Dr. NERATO PASCUCCI is not considered by us to be suitable for the post; especially as the office of General Inspector most to a large extent concern those parts of Italy under Military Government Control and the Italian Fire Service personnel operating with our Military Fire Fighting Units.

4. The appointments of Vice Prefect Dr. Angelo DE FEO and Eng. GIOVANNI CALVINO are noted with satisfaction.

1. Reference your N 2041 dated 10th August.
2. It was not considered possible or just to give a reply to your letter without allowing some time for observation of the ability of the Acting Director General of Anti-Fire & P.A. Services.
3. Dr. Pascucci has invariably shown the greatest courtesy towards the officers of this Sub-Commission and has accepted their advice generally.
4. It is felt, however, that in view of the difficult times through which the Service is passing, a stronger hand is needed at the head of the Directorate.
5. It is stressed that there is no objection to Dr. Pascucci on political or personal grounds and that the above view is based purely on technical grounds.

1. I refer to previous correspondence and conversations I have had with members of your staff in which the request has been made for Allied Central Commission's approval to the re-employment by the Italian Government of the above-named as Prefects.

2. I am please to inform Your Excellency that it has now been decided to grant your request and no further objection will be made to the employment of these gentlemen in the above-mentioned capacity.

3. His Excellency Serrentino intimated that if approval was given your proposal that the Italian Government would willingly undertake to arrange for them not to be engaged in prefectural appointments in Sicily. I should be glad if in your acknowledgement of this letter you will kindly intimate that this would be done.

TO : Director, Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. The Vice-Chief of Cabinet at the Ministry of the Interior, Comm. CAMERA came to see me yesterday and told me that the Minister is submitting for ACC approval proposals for changing the Directors-General at the Ministry. He left with me a list of the new officials suggested.

2. The list contains the following proposals within your sphere:

- Capo della PoliziaFERRARI, Dott. Luigi
- Vice-Capo della Polizia.....DE BONIS, Dott. Amerigo
- Direttore-Generale per i
- Servizi Anticendi..... PASCUCCI, Dott. Renato

3. I understand the Ministry have already taken up FERRARI's appointment with you.

4. The name of DE BONIS was included among the list of Prefects available for forward provinces. I annex a copy of the biographical particulars furnished by the Ministry in that connection. Security Branch were asked to screen him on 21 July and they have been asked by telephone to send the report to you instead of me.

5. PASCUCCI was a Prefect in Sicily at the time of the invasion and was arrested on security grounds by FSS or CIC. He has since been released and the Acting Vice-President is now considering my recommendation that the Government be allowed to re-employ him. As soon as I have Col. Upjohn's decision I will inform you.
