maintain them.

The 37th Fire Brigade of Gorizia, owing to the remarkable number of motor-cars which was taken away by the Yugoslav Troops, and the inefficiency of most part of those which are at disposal, caused by the over work they have done, cannot ensure the fire-service of Gorizia and it's Province, and therefore they requested an extraordinary assignment of motor-cars.

Our Ministry, not being for the present in a condition to fulfill in another way the request of the a.m. Brigade, has the intention to transfer the motor-cars listed below from 41st VV.F Corp of Pola, where they are not needed, to 37th Corp of Gorizia, in order to procure a remedy to the existing serious deficiency.
