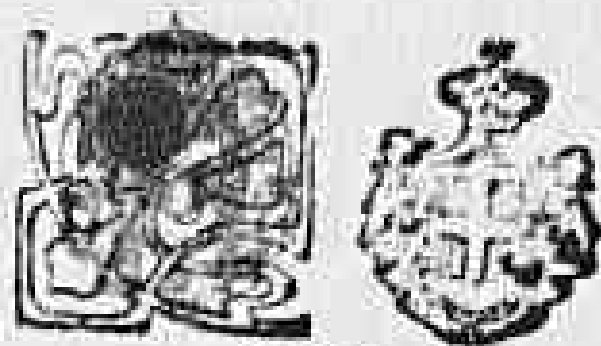

3. His family is in the North of Italy but he refused to leave his post when so ordered by the Germans.

4. A Corps of the importance of Livorno is usually commanded by a man with the rank of Major while AMBROSETTI still remains a Lieutenant which rank he held as second in command.

5. It is appreciated that it is not the Policy of A.M.G. to promote Italian Officials but I am of the opinion that a recommendation to the Italian Ministry of the Interior for AMBROSETTI to be promoted to Captain would do no harm and might have a beneficial result.

Subject : Indemnity to VV.F. in Naples.

To : A.C. P.S. S/C.

With reference to the letter AC/14511, dated 20 December, this Hq. has to state that:

- 1) - the indemnity, to which the letter of Eng. Felsani, Commander of the 54th VV.F. Corps of Naples, refers - usually called Zerbini prize - was disposed by the Under-Secretary at the Interior of the so called Republican Government in favour to the ministerial employees, a few days before the arrival of the Allied Troops in Rome. Therefore, the indemnity in question has not been disposed by the ministerial Authorities of the monarchic Government in order to celebrate the liberation of Rome or to recompense the employees for their morale sufferings during the nazi-fascist occupation.
- 2) - The Command of the Ist VV.F. Corps in Rome, without any authorisation, extended to the proper personnel the payment of the so called Zerbino prize. Such arbitrary provision, blamed by this Gen. Hq., is nevertheless a subject of study, in regard to the charge of responsibility, as neither the payment can be admitted, nor a remedy found to the arbitrary action of the Commander.
- 3) Considering the above, this Hq. communicates, that no provision can be taken in favour of the Naples Corps and of the other Corps of the Kingdom, in regard to the subject in examination; a provision, which among other things, would amount to various millions, which should be requested from the Treasury Ministry, which would certainly oppose refusal

Therefore, the request of the VV.F. Corps cannot be taken into consideration.

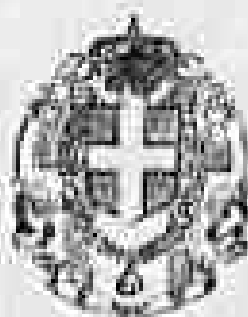

- 2) The gratuity was allowed by the Ministerial Authorities who in Rome replaced the Republican Fascist Government , as soon as the Allies entered Rome .
- 3) The payment of such gratuity began from 10th June .
- 4) The economical treatment , allowed by the Allies to the employees in liberated Italy and by Fascism in occupied Italy, was given because of the conditions and cost of living .
 To prove that either in one zone or in the other the increases allowed on December 1943 were not sufficient is the fact that as from 16th August an additional increase has been allowed .
 But the gratuity given in Rome was of moral nature, not economical, because it was allowed to celebrate the liberation of Rome and to recompense partially the moral sufferings suffered by the employees during the Nazi-Fascist occupation .

1. The correspondence from the Naples Fire Corp (Ref. P.S./10.9. 16th Nov 1944) appears to refer to an indemnity granted by the Fascist Government to meet the high cost of living.
2. Payment of this indemnity was made a day or two after the occupation.
3. During the same period the fire services in Southern Italy received far better treatment under the Allied Government than the Rome Corps enjoyed under the Fascist.
4. The food, which had been hidden from the Germans at considerable risk, was the property of the Rome Corps.

This Command, a short time after Rome was freed, having known that immediately after the Allies entered Rome a gratuity was allowed to the Rome personnel and to the Officers in service c/o the Special Section of the General Directorate, sent to the Ministry of Interior a letter of which a copy is attached herewith.

As, until now, no decision on the matter has been received, our Command is asking your Honourable Commission in order to obtain the requested authorization given.

The Naples Corps personnel is confidently waiting this decision of justice, which, as it is already pointed out in the attached letter, besides alleviating the very bad economical conditions at present, it means a duty acknowledgment of the bold work done during an exceptional and hard period, which Rome never knew.

Thanking you for all which your Commission will do on the subject, we are awaiting any information in this respect.

This Command is aware that all the personnel of the Rome Corps and officers of the Special Section of the General Directorate as soon as the Allies entered Rome, benefitted by a gratuity which, already fixed by the preceding Government, has been allowed under the heading "Gratuity of 4th June". X

The gratuity was allowed under the following rates:

- ✓ Firemen and non-commissioned officers (volunteers) L. 1000
- ✓ Firemen and non-commissioned officers (on permanent service) L. 1500
- ✓ Officers (Volunteers) L. 2000
- ✓ Officers (On permanent service) L. 3000

In addition we are aware that all the Rome Corps personnel have been allowed to get a food-parcel (of varying consistence X according to the number of sons) collecting the foods from the supplies on hand.

Our Command pointing out the above, has to bring to your notice that it is necessary that a similar measure be issued, as our personnel, having acquired merits surely not less than those of Rome Corps, never was allowed to get gratuity which besides to alleviate the very bad economical conditions, it means also a just acknowledgment of the work done during a hard and exceptional period.

Therefore our Command is asking to be allowed to get a gratuity for all the personnel of these Corps, on the rates which your

Therefore our Command is asking to be allowed to get a gratuity for all the personnel of these Corps, on the rates which your Ministry will think reasonable in accordance with the work performed, and to distribute a food-parcel of similar measure 4718 t given to the Home personnel.

The corresponding cost should be charged on the war balance.

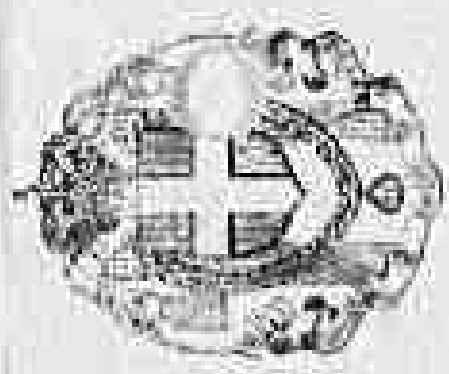
