To : A.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission - Rome.

1. The Sub-Commission's letter n. 14512 dated 16 February, 1945 refers.

2. After the liberation of Rome an allotment of roughly 0.300 Kg. of leather per person has been made to the VV.F. Corps.

The Avellino Corps, which has 25 men in service, has received 10 Kg. of leather.

3. Since the date, mentioned under para 2, an allotment of service uniforms has been made in the measure of roughly 50% of the strength of ~~the~~ each Corps.

The Naples Corps, who had 1450 men in service, has received 720 complete uniforms.

4. The limited availability in the stores has not consented a larger allotment of leather and uniforms.

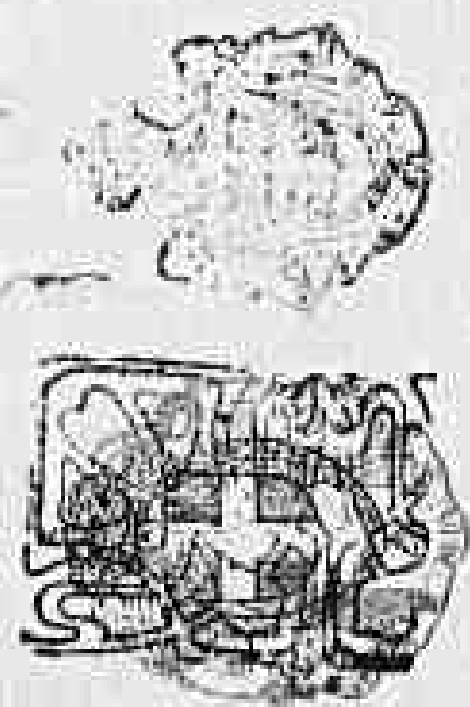

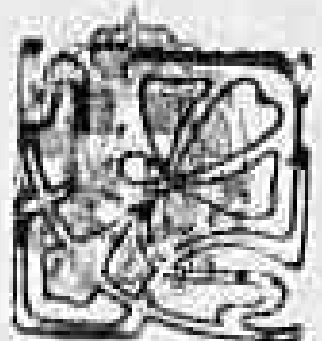

1. Every effort is being made to improve the Civilian Defence of Livorno but certain necessary items of equipment are completely lacking for the rescue squads, viz Ropes overalls and boots.

2; It was understood that certain UNPA equipment was collected from Southern Italy and given to Rome Fire Brigade.

3. Is it possible to have 400 or so feet of about 2" rope from these supplies, also 36 pairs of medium sized overalls, provided they are not too small, the size is unimportant as repairs and modifications can be carried out at the Livorno Fire Station.

4. It is appreciated that boots are in extremely short supply, but they are nevertheless essential if an efficient service is to be maintained.

If it ^{is} possible to get some 24 pairs of Salvage Army boots, the exact details as to size will be forwarded without delay.

1. In agreement with AFLRS, it has been decided to cancel all unfulfilled release orders for leather and leather belting, issued prior to 17 February 1945.

2. The reason for this action is due to the fact that investigation has revealed that the availability returns made by the Italian authorities to A.C. have been based on a misconception of the quantity to be declared with the result that the releases made against availability have in many instances, not been fulfilled or only met in part.

3. Now that a complete house cleaning has been undertaken and future availability returns will be based on existing stock, instead of on estimated production, you are invited to rescreen your demands and, where necessary, resubmit them to this Sub-Commission in the normal way. Copies of your previous release orders, as listed, are returned herewith.

This allotment and the delivery of materials was done,on behalf of this Ministry,to "Industria Commercio Tessuti S.A."of Siena,which began immediately the spinning of hemp and the weaving of a part of yarn. The work was suspended owing to war events and all materials,in order to avoid its stealing by germans,was delivered to Siena VV.FF.- Following General Order of August 23,the "Industria,Commercio Tessuti,S.A."declared above materials to Siena Allied H.Qs.,assuming to be its proprietor.

Those H.Qs have blokaded the materials.

On the matter,we point out that,notwithstanding the sum for payment of these materials had been anticipated from the Firm,these materials have been allotted to this Ministry and do not belong to the firm,which was only intrusted with execution of work;therefore the firm could not dispose of it.

Besides we point out that,coats are now utmost needed for VV.FF.service;and consequently we beg that Subcommission to put yarn,cloth and paraffine at disposal of this Ministry,which will provide to finish the manufacture and to pay the Firm "Industria Commercio Tessuto S.A.",for expences suffered in purchasing the materials,for spinning and partial weaving of hemp.

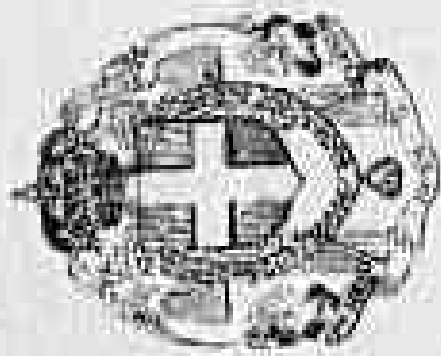

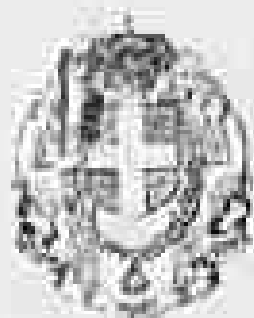

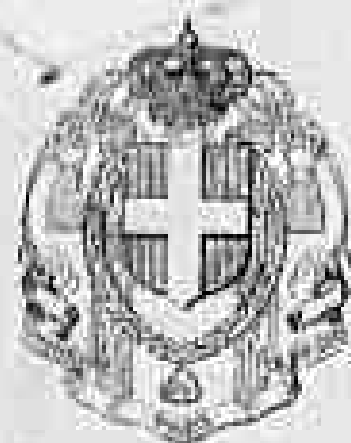

SUBJECT: Clothing for Italian Fire Service Personnel.

TO : D.G.P.S.

1. The supply of clothing and equipment for the Fire Service is normally by the Ministry of Interior through the General Directorate of Anti-Fire Services.
2. The General regulations covering the issue of clothing are very extensive and excerpts from them are attached as Appendix "A".
3. Since the war the issue of clothing has been severely restricted and very strict orders have been issued for the conservation and repair of all articles of wear. Lists of clothing are at Appendix "B".
4. We are not concerned with any of the special issues, such as driver's outfits, sports clothing etc. neither is it thought that we should supply summer uniforms or fatigue dress. The normal colour of the uniforms is khaki and this should be retained if possible.
5. It was possible to obtain issues of cloth and have the uniforms made by the tailors of the Corps - this could still be done but would probably be thought to take too long.
6. Every Corps has its boot repairers and many boots would be saved if an issue of leather were made.
7. All stocks of clothing and leather in Liberated Italy have been exhausted and the Italian War Dept. is unable to assist.
8. It is unlikely that any stocks will be found when further parts of Italy are liberated.
9. The approximate ^{strength} of the Fire Service in the various parts of Italy is given as under:-

10. The priorities for supply are as follows:

Excerpts from General Regulations covering Issue of Clothing

Art. 4.

Commanders of Corps are also responsible for good conservation of equipment distributed to personnel.

Art. 5.

The Allotments and minimum duration of clothing, etc., is shown in Table A (Appendix "B").

Art. 9.

Requests for renewals will be made to Antincendi Fund, branch of Ministry of Interior.

Art. 11.

Each Corps will keep records of all materials received and turned in.

Art. 14.

To record movement of clothing, individuals will fill out schedule 7, mod. E.E. 3, upon which all items will be recorded, issue, renewal, etc. Such records to be in duplicate, the original for the Company Commander and the other to be kept by individual concerned.

Art. 17.

Independent of minimum duration established for clothing and equipment, no renewal will take place if items are in good condition.

Commanders of Corps, because of war conditions, are to keep requests for renewals down to an absolute minimum, especially those items of wool, leather and metals.

Art. 18.

Items for distribution will be handled through Antincendi Fund, branch of Ministry of Interior. In cases of absolute necessity, the Minister may order purchases of materials directly from dealers in the open market.

Art. 30.

Wherever possible, shoe repairs will be done by Firemen who are skilled in this work and who will be given the necessary materials from time to time for making necessary repairs.

All raw materials necessary for such repairs will be properly recorded.

Art. 31.

Where measures of economy are not possible as in above article, work will be let to private concerns for periods of one year at a time, such period to conform to fiscal period of Corps.

The letter from the Minister of Interior (7/553/14 dated 24/3/44) is returned herewith.

The Director of Anti-Fire Services is away at present and I am unable to obtain information as to the number of Firemen they are contemplating clothing. Possibly there is 9000 as they ask for 9000 shirts. The figure on which we are working is 10,000 and includes the whole of Italy South of a line Pisa - Pesaro inclusive. Some 46 Brigades in all.

It is not thought that sheets are an urgent necessity but as most of the Fire Brigades do their own repairs etc. it is thought that possibly the cotton allowance might be increased up to say 50% of the amount they ask for.
