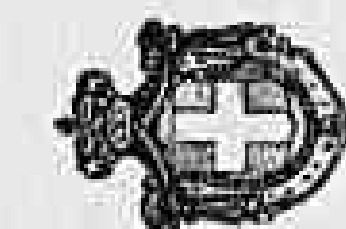

SUBJECT: Pay for Carabinieri at Campione on Lake Lugano.

TO : The Director,
Public Safety Sub-Commission,
HQ AC.

1. The Italian comune of Campione on Lake Lugano is entirely surrounded by Swiss Territory. The currency is the Swiss Franc and NOT the Italian Lira.

2. The American Consul in Lugano used to pay the wages and expenses of the Carabinieri each month, but now this has been stopped and according to the PPSO at Como the Carabinieri are now without wages.

3. The Legion HQ in Milan has written to the Carabinieri HQ in Rome asking for an arrangement to be made with the Italian Government as quickly as possible, so that the Carabinieri at Campione can be paid in Francs. 5800

4. So far nothing seems to have been done and the PPSO at Como again reports that the Carabinieri are without pay.

5. Could this matter please have your attention, as the Carabinieri at Campione cannot go on indefinitely without pay in Francs.

At present he, has in charge his wife and three small
children.

He gets 6.308 lire a month. His wife and children are
obliged to live at Manfredonia, in the family of their Grand-parents,
having not the possibility, here to live an account of the scarce
monthly pay.

The writer his also sick at the lung-for scarce food
for whom he had to submit for deficiency of means.

He also needs a mouth and a dental cure.

Nothing, of all this he can do, because his means don't
consent the least expense.

He has found a situation of whom he could earn daily
425 lire as toy maker or driver to consent at least to earn the least
needed to support his family.

The writer asks, seeing that the State has no more need
of his work or really to put him in a condition to provide the
least necessary for his family, to be released, so that he could earn
at least the bread for his family, that lives to-day in a only room
without no kitchen, paying 4.800 lire rent a month.

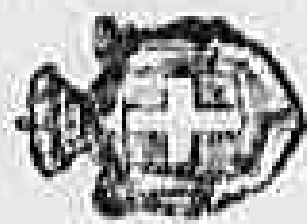

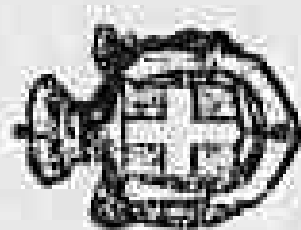

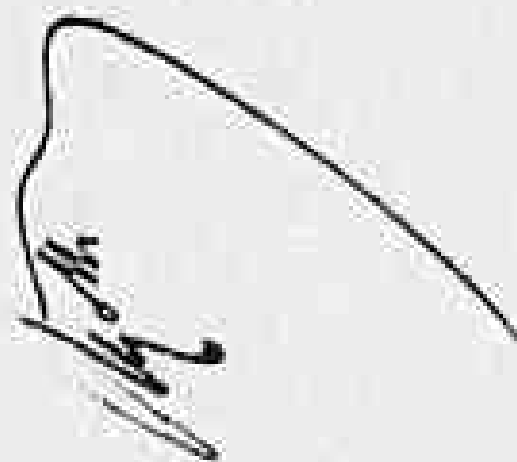

1. After much endeavour, the CC.RR Command at Rome, authorised the Commandant of the CC.RR Mobile Nucleus attached to 13th Eighth Army, to draw the pay of these men at Ancona Legion. This decision was only obtained after about 9 months of negotiation, and was of inestimable value.

2. On 16 Feb 45 the Captain Commanding the Nucleus received a letter from Ancona Legion (Ref NS/7-1944 di prot. dated 3 Feb 45) stating that henceforth pay for the Mobile Nucleus must be obtained from Rome.

3. In view of the distance involved and the probability of its increase in the future, it will be impracticable, to say the least, for this procedure to be carried out, unless the CC.RR Command is willing to send the money out to this HQ. Transport is not available for the Captain of the nucleus here and although repeated requests have been made by him to his HQ in Rome, nothing has been forthcoming. Even so, it would mean the loss of his services for at least a week, once a month, which is impossible.

4. It will be appreciated that even when the pay is obtained, it has to be distributed to the men, who are stationed throughout Eighth Army area. This alone requires from a week to 10 days. Considerable difficulty is experienced in keeping these men paid up to date but in the event of the pay having to be drawn from Rome, the additional delay would render prompt monthly payment impossible.

5. May urgent representations be made to the CC.RR Command to revert to the arrangement, whereby the pay was drawn at Ancona.

6. No notification of the change in system has been received at 13th Regt.

1. Attached, are reports submitted to G.S.I. (b) Main Army, by 5 Corps and 263 P.S. Sections, respecting CC.RR. temporarily attached to them for duty.

2. Also attached, is a nominal roll showing CC.RR. who have not yet received pay for October 1944, although they have subsequently been paid for November. It appears that although representations have been made to the Legion at Ghieti by Lieut. Gussardi, the CC.RR. Officer in charge, nothing has yet been done.

Owing to the very severe conditions that exist at this time of the year in this part of Italy and the added hardships caused by the destruction of Public Utility Services and the shortage of any kind of fuel, the effectiveness of the services rendered by the CC.RR. is being greatly handicapped by the large numbers of men who are reporting sick. The duties performed by these men require them to be consistently in the open and bad boots and clothing are taking their toll. In addition the two blankets with which they are equipped are totally inadequate.

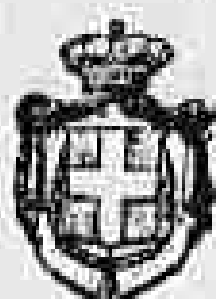

This is an informal communication to keep you current as to the disposition of matters which have been the subject of previous correspondence.

1. Dr. Medica's proposal regarding compulsory domicile is opposed by the Acting Director of the Interior Sub-Commission. It has, in substance, received my approval and is now in the hands of the Administrative Directorate. Copy of my memo on the subject is enclosed.

2. No developments as yet regarding the procurement of equipment or clothing for the new battalions. The additional pay allowance has received the O.K. of the Finance Sub-Commission, as applied to the new battalions only, and on the grounds that they will be charged with missions of a specially hazardous nature.

3. Request for 500 additional GSR will probably be met if military operational plans do not supervene. Same applies to Guardia di Finanza, although the prospect of your receiving them is much more dubious.

4. Based on communication of AFM, Advanced Section, dated 12 December, 1943, 8 type rations (British) for the GSR have been authorized on the grounds that "The whole safety of Italy depends in great part on this corps, which, it is considered, part of the Italian Army ~~and therefore they should~~ and therefore they should ~~be supplied~~ be supplied by us." Gen. Lammio has been advised to make representations to Gen. Macchi, and through him, to the Military Mission with a view to making a similar provision for the GSR in Italy. If effected, the problem of distribution will have to be met in view of transportation limitations. Our efforts regarding clothing and equipment are directed along the same channels.

SUBJECT: Wage Increases for Governmental Employees.

1. Dr. Jung says that plans to order wage increase for governmental employees in Indoglio Province as soon as possible, using same percentages as contained in AMI Wage Order.
2. However, in our discussions with him two points have arisen which require immediate clarification: (a) Jung's draft order makes wage increase applicable to all military and naval personnel as well as civil employees; (b) Jung's draft order abolishes two wage plans, the "Indegnita di Presenza" and the "Primo di Operativita".

3. Regarding point (a), it is our understanding that AMI Order for Sicily did not apply to Italian Armed Forces. 1. General Order No. 14 authorizing temporary wage adjustments applies only to Region I and does not apply to Italian armed forces. It does not abolish the Indennita di Presenza and the Indennita di Operativita, but provides for a sliding scale percentage increase on the total of wages and indennita ^{2/1/50 VAR. 03} in force on 31 October 1943.
2. Yang's suggestion to make wage increase applicable to all military and naval personnel as well as civil employees appears to us to be in conflict with the fundamental object of the wage increase which was solely to enable us poor to obtain food and is only a temporary emergency measure to meet the food situation. The military and naval personnel receive full rations and therefore would not come under the rationing and rationing boards. The Carabinieri have to buy the whole of their rations out of their wages so that there is a complete distinction in this respect between the Carabinieri and the Italian armed forces. Italian ^{2/1/50 VAR. 03} law 736 dated 14 June 1940 specifically excludes Carabinieri ⁵⁷²¹ wage increases then given to members of armed forces.

3. Yang's plan to abolish the Indennita di Presenza and the Indennita di Operativita would in effect nullify benefits deriving from the wage increase since these two indennita represent ^{large} proportion of the ^{Civil} Government employees present total salary.

4. Please give us further particulars as to the stated non payment of Indennita di Presenza in Regions II and the four Italian Provinces. When and why was it abolished.

- Q. Do the CC.RR. receive different rates of pay according to different localities ?
- A. The pay scale is static, based upon :-
- A (1) Rank
(2) Married or single
(3) Years of service
- B The location of their service would alter their allowances, but not their pay scale.
- Q. Regarding their service pay-lengths ?
- A. Every three (3) years an increase. The rank and length of service having a bearing on the totals, also as to their marital status.
- Q. Is the pay of the Italian Army different from the pay of the CC.RR. ?
- A. For Officers none. The allowance of the Officers differ. The pay of the Army soldiers and N.C.O's differ from those of the enlisted CC.RR.
- Q. Does the fact of being at War change the pay scale ?
- A. No, allowances only. Officers are paid by the month and ~~Fig.~~ and CC.RR. are paid by the day.
- Q. Do E.M. of the Italian Army receive pay and allowances ?
- A. No. A soldier receives 4 lire per day. The only time when he receives an allowance is when he does not feed with his unit, then he receives an additional 7 lire per day.
- Q. Why do the CC.RR. receive more pay than equivalent rank in the Italian Army ?
- A. (1) Because they are all volunteers.
(2) They do both Police and Army duty.

- A. Before occupation, Sicily was declared a war area without being in actual combat.
- Q. What is the percentage of War Allowance ?
- A. Depends on rank, etc.
- Q. A Maresciallo ?
- A. A flat allowance of about 10%.
- Q. In the Army do they receive pay, allowance and maintainance?
- A. Italian Army Officers - Pay, allowance and rations.

1. In order to secure to the Allied Military Government the full co-operation and efficiency of officers and men of the Carabinieri, it is recommended that early consideration be given to the question of their rates of pay, with a view to a general increase being granted to all ranks.

The amount of pay and allowances now drawn by the various ranks at the lowest and highest levels of their respective scales is shown at Appendix 'A'. For purposes of comparison the allowances in each case are those payable to a married man with two children.

2. The CC.RR. has been designated as the principal arm of law enforcement in the occupied territory by the Military Governor. A great responsibility is thus placed upon the organisation and it is necessary to reorganise it in order that it may best serve the Allied Military Government and preserve law and order in the Island. The general opinion of officers competent to judge is that if we are to establish this force on a sound basis the first step to take is to increase the rates of pay which are inadequate in relation to present day prices and the cost of living and to the services required from the police. This measure is essential in order to avoid one of the most serious evils that can beset any such organisation, viz., corruption, to which the police service, in its contacts with the public is always liable, but particularly prone under the conditions at present prevailing in Sicily.

5714

3. Having regard to the numerous rates of pay existing for the various ranks it is recommended that the simplest manner in which an immediate increase could be approved would be in the form of a percentage Supplementary Allowance. In the case of the lower ranks, viz., from Carabinieri to Maresciallo it is suggested that a 33 1/3% increase might be considered and a 20% rise for ranks above that of Maresciallo; the question of revising the entire scales of pay may have to be reviewed later.

4. This recommendation is submitted subject to study and comparison being made with the salaries now applicable, or likely to be paid in the near future, to other classes of employed personnel.

While this increase for the CC.RR. is urgently sought, the necessity for wages in general being assessed on an equitable basis is appreciated and it is asked that the subject may be examined by the Finance Division, if necessary in collaboration with the Civil Police Section.
