SUBJECT: Repatriation of Carabinieri from Switzerland.

TO : Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

1. Reference the Ministry's Memorandum No. 6/1107/467 dated 24 November 1944.
2. The appropriate Allied Authorities have decided that the repatriation of the Carabinieri from Switzerland may be effected provided the Swiss Government will agree to their release.
3. It will be for the Swiss authorities to suggest conditions under which the release will be granted and terms of subsequent employment may figure in those conditions.
4. It is considered that the Italian Government should approach the Swiss Government on the question of release.
5. Upon the receipt by Political Section of the information that desirable release has been agreed to, as well as an indication of the conditions thereof, the appropriate Allied Authorities will be requested to execute their agreement to arrange for the repatriation.

1. Reference is made to Political Section's 394/385 of 22nd November on the subject of the repatriation of Italian military personnel interned in Switzerland.
2. There has been received from the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs memorandum No. 6/1107/467 dated November 24th, stating that amongst the Italian troops now interned in Switzerland and whom it is desired to repatriate to Italy are 1500 carabinieri whose presence in the country would be of great use to the General Command of the Carabinieri for the preparation and organisation of the police service in Northern Italy. The request, therefore, is made for the repatriation of these carabinieri and further that they be given precedence over all others who may be repatriated from Switzerland.
3. The Director of Public Safety Sub-Commission, A.C., states that the presence of these 1500 carabinieri is urgently required to increase the police strength in Italy and the Director of Land Forces Sub-Commission (M.N.I.A.) has indicated his desire to see repatriated as many carabinieri officers and men as may be possible.
4. The Political Section concurs, sincerely, in this opinion and recommends earnestly that the repatriation of the carabinieri be effected as soon as possible.
5. An early indication of AFHQ's decision in this matter is requested.

1. Confirming conversation (Colonel Chapman - Captain Alper) held 25 November 1944, you are advised that the ceiling of strength for the Carabinieri Forces south of the Pisa-Rimini line has been fixed at 55,000. The present strength of the Force at the present time does not exceed 45,000.
2. In order to augment the Carabinieri it has been necessary to allot for police duty 5000 Italian soldiers who will be presently required for their normal duties.
3. A recruiting program for the Carabinieri Force is now underway but for various reasons is progressing slowly. Recruits are being added at the rate of approximately 500 per month. However, a four months training period is required before recruits can be considered as effective police.
4. Under these circumstances the repatriation of Carabinieri prisoners of war is urgently necessary. Their return would permit an acceleration of the time for the release of Italian soldiers.

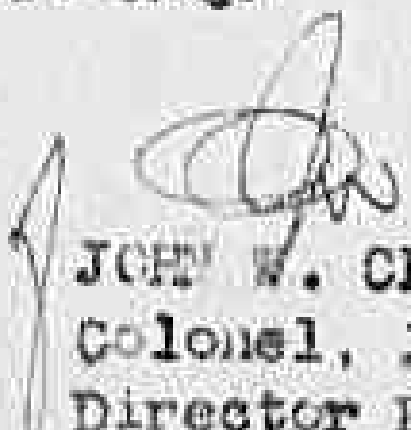

For your information, approval has this day been given for the repatriation of CORTI, Pietro, 81-1-235239, who was admitted to Italian PW hospital at PW camp 129 from the Port of Oran under the following circumstances:

a. Subject PW served as a carabinieri in the city of Orbetello, Province of Grosseto, during the German occupation. Threatened by the Germans with removal to Germany he fled to the mountains at Cappalbio and joined the Partisans under the command of Captain Brego. While serving with the group an American plane brought an Italian Officer named Lt. Paolo and he assumed command of the Partisans. When the Germans began to retreat about 11 May 1944, he and two other carabinieri and a civilian proceeded to the town of Cappalbio. On their way they met an American Officer, who was escorting a group of PW, and they told him their story. The American officer suggested that they report to headquarters and offered them transportation.

b. They arrived at PW enclosure and after unloading the PW they proceeded with an American driver to headquarters. On their way they hit a ditch, overturning the truck and injuring Corti Pietro. He regained consciousness in a hospital at Tarquinia suffering from a fractured leg and bruises. He was processed at the hospital and from there sent to Africa and subsequently admitted to PW Camp 129 as a patient.

Thank you for your letters of the 2nd October on the question of Madame Sacopoulo and of the 19th of September on the question of CC.RR.

Regarding Madame Sacopoulo I am sorry that there is no suitable employment of the type which she wants here. I have tried the Monuments and Fine Arts Section who regret that they have nothing to offer and I do not see that she would be useful in anything else.

With regard to CC.RR from Eritrea I thought I have written to you that such a small number would not be worth the trouble of getting here, but it may be that I asked somebody else to write to you officially on the subject. I have spoken to Tom McCarthy who will be seeing you on his way to Eritrea, telling him this and saying if he can arrange transport no doubt these people can be used and there should be no difficulty about the immigration. I am sorry you did not hear from me about it.

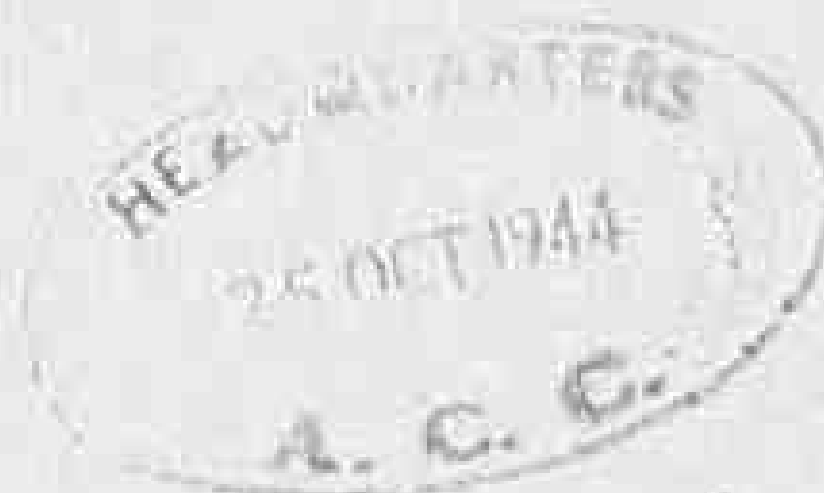

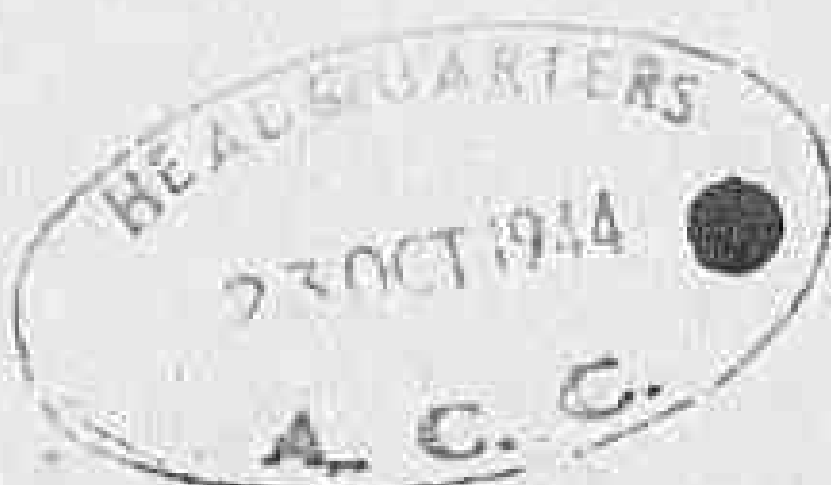

2. However on 4th June 1944 A.F.H.Q. replied that it was not possible to supply CO.RR. from North Africa.
3. Approximately 25 officers and 1000 CO.RR have left East Africa and were due at Suez on 25th September 1944.
4. General FARDEI has arrived from India, Colonel CONTADINI has arrived from North Africa with 50 CO.RR.
5. It is not known where the figure of 4-5000 CO.RR is obtained from; there is no information on this file as to total numbers.
6. It seems that strong representations for the release of CO.RR from North Africa might fruitfully be made now, as it is believed that many camps are to be transferred to the Italian mainland.

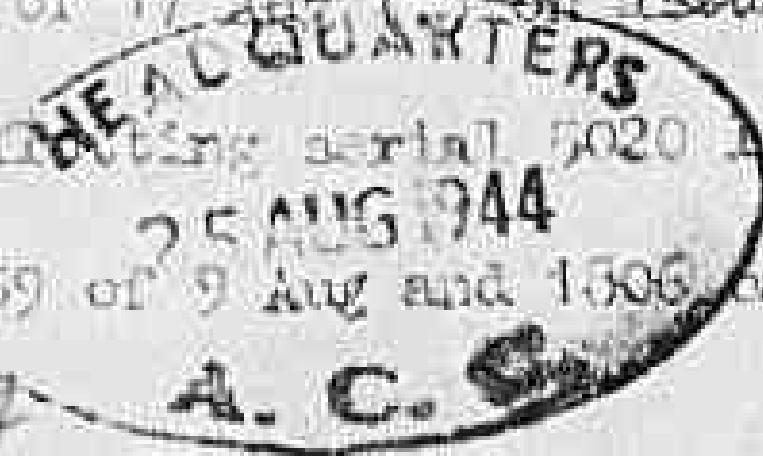

Dear Lush:

I am glad to inform you that the diversion of the Carabinieri and Finance Guards from East Africa to Italy has been agreed and they should arrive in Italy in mid-September.

The diversion has occasioned a considerable amount of cabling as TROOPERS would only agree to the proposal subject to the numbers originally intended for London being made up from other sources and final agreement on this was only received yesterday. The diversion has also altered the shipping program as TROOPERS, for obvious reasons, would not allow ships filled with Italians to call in at Italian ports and debark only a portion of their load there and it has been necessary to arrange for the personnel for Italy to transship in Mideast.

A cable giving you the gist of the above information was in fact in process of being coordinated with Staff Sections concerned when your letter of the 7th July arrived here today, and will be in your hands when this letter arrives.

2. The Public Safety Sub-Commission has, in conjunction with the Italian authorities, prepared lists of CC.RR. & CC.FF. officers who are believed to be Prisoners of War in India and Africa, and for whom application is made for release, in order of priority as shown on attached lists (Inclosures #2 and #3).

3. With respect to the name of General Taddei Leonetto, Incl #2, CC.RR. list; on 14 April 1944, you made a special representation by letter (ref. 302/101/CA) to Hq AAI relative to the release of General Taddei.

4. Note that the name of Capt. CASANO Unofrio, shown on Incl #2, CC.RR. list, 1st priority, was previously included on second Commando Supremo priority list of 25 names sent to AFHQ by you on 22 April 1944 (ref. CC/G/222).

5. In view of AFHQ letter (MOS 014.12) dated 11 May 1944 (copy attached as Incl #4) and your memorandum referred to in para 1 above, it is suggested that you might want to send the enclosed lists to AFHQ for information of G-5 and for such use as G-5 can make of them.

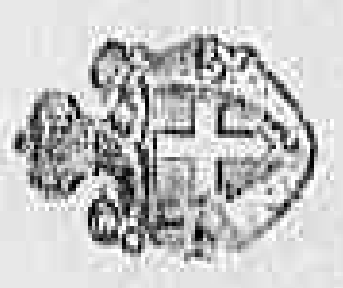

4. I am now endeavouring to arrange for the repatriation of Carabinieri P.W. from East Africa and will keep you informed of developments.

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Carabinieri Personnel

TO : H.Q., Allied Control Commission

1. Reference is made to the Chief Commissioner's letter of 23 April enclosing copy of a memorandum from General Fieche who commands the Carabinieri.

2. The letter above referred to has been brought to the attention of the Chief Administrative Officer who caused investigation to be made with a view to seeing what officers and men of the Carabinieri held in North Africa could be made available for repatriation. The results of these investigations appear below in paragraphs 3 and 4.

3. So far as Carabinieri officers are concerned it is stated that 6 in all have been handed back by the British and that so far as is known there are no others in British custody. On the American side 16 were originally registered by them but except in the case of two whose repatriation is being arranged it is not possible to repatriate any more either because of the key positions they are holding or because of their pronounced Fascist views.

4. In the case of Carabinieri other ranks it is not possible to spare more than 50 for repatriation as the balance held are being used for essential duties here but the 50 have been assembled and are now awaiting orders to embark to Italy.

SUBJECT : Application for Release of POW - GCR and GCTF

TO : Deputy Chief Commissioner, ACC

1. Herewith are nominal rolls of officers of the GCR and GCTF who are believed to be prisoners of war in India and Africa.

2. Their services are urgently required in Italy for the maintenance of public order, and particularly at the present time when it can be anticipated that new territory will be occupied and lack of officer personnel is making itself more evident.

3. With reference to General TADDEI, prisoner of war in India, special representations were made by this Sub-Commission to the Executive Commissioner on the 10 March 1944, reference ACC/14601/6/PS, and a letter, reference 302/101/CA dated 14 April 1944, on the subject was addressed by the Chief Commissioner to HQ, AAI.

4. The Chief Commissioner on 27 April 1944, reference CC/G/236, informed this Sub-Commission that another urgent request had been made to AFHQ for the return of all GCR POW personnel. Also that the verbal support of Generals Wilson and Alexander had been obtained in the matter.

5. At time of writing, it is learnt that 50 GCR POW personnel (not officers) have just arrived at Naples from Africa.

SUBJECT : Officers, Non-Com., EM/OR's of CGFF P.O.W.

The actual strength of the R. Guardia di Finanza is inadequate for the complex duties of the service. We have been compelled, in fact, to hold in the service officers, non-coms, and soldiers already advanced in age, recall men from retirement and request for an enrollment of 4000 Finanzieri and 300 non-coms. for which necessary measures are about to be approved.

But the situation cannot be examined even in relation to the proximate future because the personnel deficiency will assert itself when the Allied Troops have liberated Rome and the situation will become more critical if we have a sudden collapse of the Germans with the resultant necessity providing for the exigencies of the service entrusted to R. Guardia di Finanza, in all the territory of the nation.

This necessity makes itself felt if we consider that the assignment of personnel situated on the other side of Italy and Balkans, cannot be done immediately because as they gradually return, it will be necessary to examine each case individually in relation to their collaboration with the Germans.

Independently of other measures which must be undertaken to cope with the a/m exigency, I would like to put at the disposal of this Command all the personnel of the R. Guardia di Finanza (officers, non-coms, soldiers (militari di truppa) who are held as prisoners of war by the Anglo-Americans.

SUBJECT: Transmission of Memorandum.

TO : CG CCRR Liberated Italy, Salerno.

I have just returned from Palestine where I had gone to inspect the troops of my division and those who have joined them after leaving internment camps in Turkey.

Capt. Mario QUARTAROLO, Commander of this division of CCRR, has sent me the attached memorandum. In sending it to this Hq., I feel it my duty to add:-

--- Officers, non-coms and Carabinieri are in excellent health and spirits.

They are all anxious to return to Italy to do their part in liberating their country. In view of the impossibility of repatriating at present, the division has organized a reconnaissance unit (pionieri) which will be temporarily employed in Palestine and in Egypt.

However, members of the Arma cannot be included in pioneer companies nor will they be in a position to carry out CCRR function because of the disbanding of the Command of the division and its breaking down into companies in the Middle East, and when completed, these CCRR sections will be available.

In transmitting report of inspection made to the Ministry of War, I mention this availability ~~so that~~ in the event that the Ministry intends to start proceedings with the Allied Control Mission for the repatriation of these sections.

TO: HQ CCRR, Salerno.

Regarding visit of Gen. SOLDARELLI to this camp, we feel it our duty, after a long and forced interruption of communications with the Mother Country, to report on the condition of CCRR personnel here. The latter

are mostly from the "Cuneo" Division, (16, 17th, 232nd, 255th Rgts.) which had been dislocated in the southern Sporadi islands and Cicladi (Greece), as well as Crete and the Aegean islands.

These men have evacuated those islands where they were in service when the Germans took over and left by chance means of transport.

All told, there are 164 of these men as listed below:-

2 Officers (Capt. S.P.E. QUARTAROLO Mario, Commanding "Cuneo" Division and Temp. Lt. (with application to pass into S.P.E) Antonio LAMBERTI, Commanding 255th Mixed Regt CCRR).

3 W.O.I's (among them MM. Dante NAVA, Commanding the 16th Mixed Regt).
 3 Mares. Capi (W.O. II's)
 1 Mares. d'Allogio (W.O. III's)
 10 Brigadieri (S/Sgt)

 124 Carabinieri (Private)

Also here is Capt. S.P.E. PIETRACAPRINA Sergio, who came from Athens and is now with this Division.

The health conditions of all are good.

Morale is good on the whole considering that they are at this moment far from their country and being unable to add their contributions to the struggle of liberation.

The personnel passes its time within the ~~see~~ closed environment of the camp with limited activity (in relation to natural aptitudes) and burdensome in relation to physical fatigue to which they are subjected.

This Command, acting as an interpreter of the sentiments of these men expresses their ~~size~~ strong desire to be recalled as soon as possible to their Country to carry out their functions and which they will appreciate so much more in proportion to its difficulties.

With the development of activities everywhere, even in particularly difficult and delicate situations, they have always sought to keep faith with our traditions.

This Command believes therefore that it can act as guarantor that the personnel of the Arma at El Burrej will continue to do their share, as modest as it may be, in the rebirth of the Country.

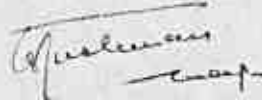

Subject: Recruitment of Units from Sardinia

TO : Vice-President, Administrative Section.

In a letter from Sardinia, Brigadier Dunlop has brought to my notice a proposal from the Sassari Party of Action that a Sardinian Division should be formed as part of the Italian Army.

For various reasons, this, of course, is not possible, but Brigadier Dunlop makes a suggestion that if special units are to be recruited voluntarily from Sardinia, as I think they well might be, they should take the form of Carabinieri units; He has explained that the Sardi is a stolid, disciplined individual who would probably do good work in the Carabinieri. I know that the Carabinieri are woefully short of manpower and I think the suggestion should be examined by your Sub-Commission for Public Safety in consultation with General Picche.
