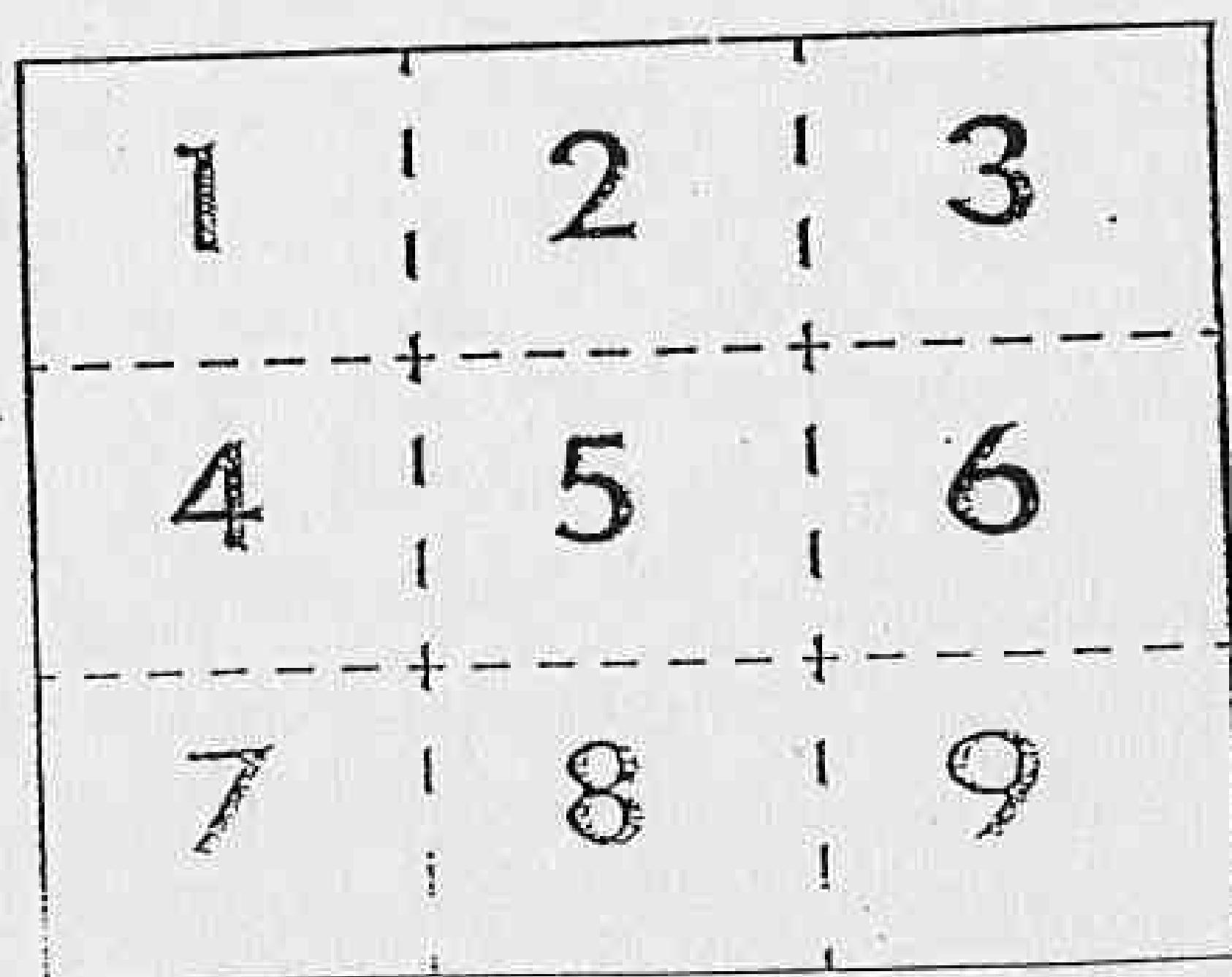
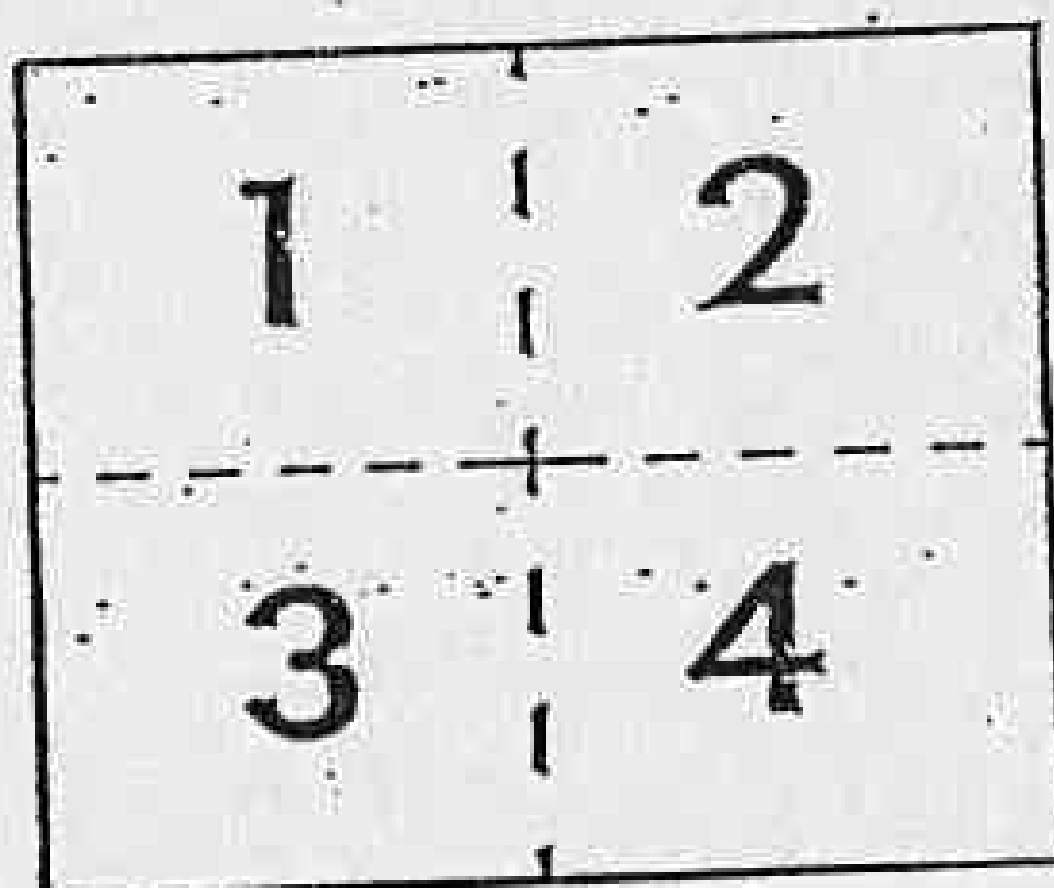

In order to make full use of all Italian resources in the war effort, and to allot clothing and equipment to the various categories of the Italian Army, it is necessary that complete inventories of all such resources be rendered periodically by all units of the Italian Army. Therefore, under the provisions of Par 6 1 of AFHQ letter of 22 September 1944, file AG 400/105 D-0, it is requested that you direct the Commanding General of the CC.RR to render to this Headquarters as of the first day of each month, beginning 1 February 1945, a complete inventory of all stores in CC.RR depots, warehouses, repair shops, and legion supply rooms. The inventory should be in two parts:

- a. Items of Allied origin supplied to the CC.RR through the War Ministry.
- b. Items of Italian origin, regardless of source of supply.

2. While it is realized that it is not possible to have the inventories in this Headquarters for some days after the first of each month, this should present no difficulty as the Italian units generally maintain a running inventory and render a monthly report to their next superior headquarters. However, the prompt transmittal of such inventories to this Headquarters will facilitate action on requests for clothing and equipment and allow time for preparation of stocks for issue.

1. Reference your letter No. 24918/V dated 27 Dec. 44.
2. The plan proposed in the A/R letter for exchange with CCRR of repaired boots for boots to be repaired is approved in principle. The quantity of repaired boots to be initially allotted is, however, considered excessive, and the allotment of an equal quantity to each CCRR Legion is considered inadvisable.
3. The total allotment of repaired boots will not exceed 10% of the total strength of the CCRR, which is fixed at 55,000. Therefore, not more than 5,500 pairs of boots will be initially allotted. The sub-allotments to CCRR Legions will be at the rate of 10% of the actual strength of each Legion, and not repeat not an equal amount to each Legion regardless of strength.
4. Boots for repair will be returned to Italian Army Repair Shops in the full amount of repaired boots issued. Any shortages will be deducted from subsequent allotments made available to CCRR from Italian Army Stocks.
5. In view of the above allotment of repaired boots, no further items of boot repairing material will be released from Italian Army Stocks to CCRR.
6. The allotment of boots up to 10% the total CCRR strength, the terms for return of boots as stated in para 4 above, and the terms in regard to repairing materials as stated in para 5 above, have been agreed by the CCRR and Public Safety Sub Commission Alcom as evidenced by Public Safety Sub Commission letter AC/14601/8/1/PS dated 5 Jan. 1945.
7. The collection of boots from Italian Army Depots and the return of boots for repair will be the responsibility of the CCRR. The War Ministry will notify CCRR as to the Depots from which repaired boots will be withdrawn and the repair installations to which deliveries will be made.

SUBJECT: Boots for CCRR (Cont'd).

A record of all boots returned by the CCRR will be kept by the War Ministry and reported montly to HQ MMIA as at the 25th of each month.

8. This arrangement is based upon current conditions, and may be ammended by HQ MMIA at any time.

9. Enclosed herewith is Authorization Notice No. AQ/45/ITL/13 releasing the initial allotment of 5,500 pairs of boots to CCRR.

The Chief Commissioner has asked me to acknowledge your letter of 14 Dec 44 and to thank you for the memorandum from Gen Orlando which you enclosed.

Clothing for the Carabinieri is a serious question which is constantly before us and I am glad to tell you that we have been successful in effecting a considerable improvement.

In regard to the four items listed in Gen Orlando's memorandum, the first two are for ceremonial uniform, which it is not proposed to issue at present, whilst shooting, the fourth item, is not on the scale of issue to the Italian Army. Everything possible is being done to increase the allotment of boots, the remaining item.

You need not take any further action in this matter.

The trouble you have taken is much appreciated.

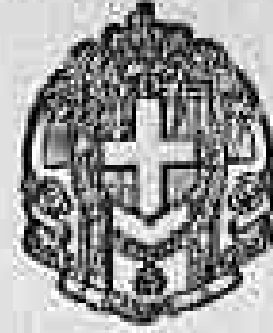

I am sending you a few facts respecting CC.RR in the Sanola Centrale, Florence, which may assist you in any argument you may need to push for clothing.

Of the 790 men allotted to us 66 are without overcoats, 345 without serviceable boots, 716 without two blankets. None have comforters.

The men have straw filled pallasses to sleep on. Those without serviceable boots are in a bad way, a little leather has been found locally but repairs are of a very temporary nature. Our most urgent need for our own 790 is 1249 pairs of socks, 660 shirts and 252 pairs of pants, a large number of the men have practically no socks, many are wearing civilian shirts of poor quality and doubtful condition.

To date our men have received the following:-

151 Overcoats
214 pairs of boots
1018 pairs of pants
276 Jackets
170 pullvers
193 pairs of trousers

most of the articles are part worn but on the whole satisfactory and serviceable.

We appreciate your efforts on our behalf and forward this statement to give power to your right arm.

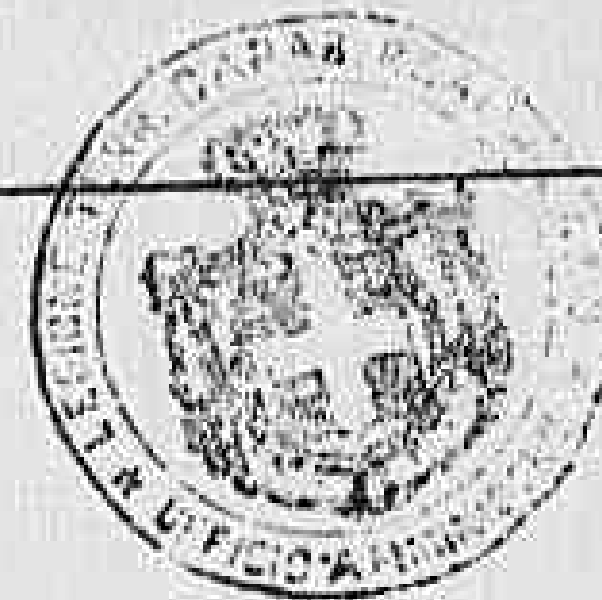

TO : Director, Public Safety Sub-Commission, HQ., A.C. —

1. With reference to attached copy of report from Major A.G.E. May, Provincial Public Safety Officer, Bologna Province.

2. On 27th Oct 44 a small amount of CC.RR clothing was received in Florence for the Spearhead CC.RR and those attached to Northern Regions. It was distributed but amounted to a very small percentage of the total required.

3. The minimum amount required to equip the CC.RR of Emilia Region had previously been submitted to the CC.RR Command by Legion Commander, Emilia Region, but to date, no further supplies have been received.

4. The general reply given by the CC.RR Florence to explain the non-arrival has been "lack of transport", but I would point out that the lack of adequate clothing for the CC.RR of this Region is rapidly becoming a very serious problem, especially now that the Winter season has set in.

5. It seems that the CC.RR are following the usual custom of leaving everything until tomorrow.

6. As the situation is now very urgent can the matter please be taken up with the CC.RR authorities in Rome in order to ensure that adequate supplies are forthcoming at the earliest possible moment.

7. Any action in this respect will be greatly appreciated.
