1. Referring to correspondence no. 302/77/CA, dated
19th March, 1944.

2. On 21st April, 1944, in accordance with directions
contained in the above quoted correspondence, a contingent
of 159 Carabinieri of the original Rome party, left Naples
by train for Palermo, Sicily, to report to CC.RR Headquarters
there.

3. A further detail of 41 Carabinieri entrained on 8th,
May 1944, for the same destination.

4. This movement, which was made under control of Italian
Military Authorities, completed the transfer of 200 CC.RR
for permanent duty in Sicily.

A further contingent of 42 men will entrain for the same destination
in the near future, thus making up complement of 200 CC.RR., previously arranged
for this move.

The above movement has been made under the control of the Italian
Military Authorities.

This party has now been struck off the strength of the Rome Contingent
at present accommodated at Naples.

5) REINFORCEMENT OF CCRR ON THE ISLAND(Extract from letter 2077/2 of the XIth
Corpo d'Armata)

* His Excellency, the Chief of Government - in a recent visit - informed that a recent contingent of 200 CCRR, taken from those readied for security service in the Capital, would soon be sent.

Their urgent arrival is urgently awaited, to the essential end of strengthening those CCRR stations where performance has not been very satisfactory.

The personnel of the stations, substituted by such CCRR, and placed in central provincial stations, might give new form and substance to them that environment and circumstances have minimized.

Sen PIÉCHE called Friday afternoon. He mentioned the party of 200 CC.RR. to go to Sicily & commented that no request had been received from Sen. BRANCA & that there are already many more CC.RR. there than in normal times. Sen BRANCA made us such request to me.

He had with him a list of 8 Officers including 1 Med. Ofc. and 19 NCOs & men who are squadristi. Their cases are under investigation & he promised to send a copy of the list next day. Mastrosanni was off duty yesterday & I have not seen or heard from him today (17/5/44). Sen PIÉCHE requested that the list be treated as confidential.

He also referred to some arrangement reached with you whereby permission could be given for CC. RR. Officers to use ANM's or military transport (when available) in order to make in 3249 after write. I wanted to know whether you had issued your instructions so that he could do likewise.

1. The Chief Commissioner has given careful consideration to the distribution of Carabinieri as between Sicily and Rome and has decided to accede to the request made by the Italian Government to send 200 Carabinieri from those earmarked for Rome to Sicily.
2. You should give all facilities for these men to be released and handed over to the representatives of the Public Safety-Sub-Commission who will also take action on this letter.
