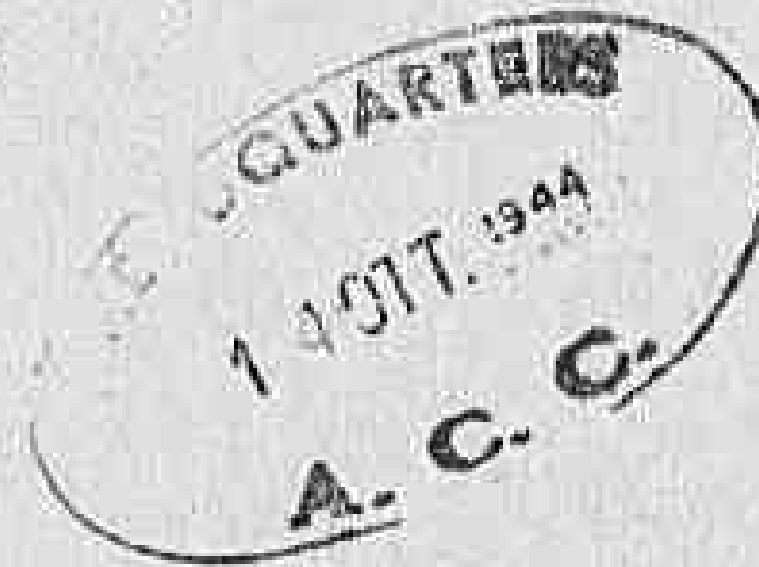

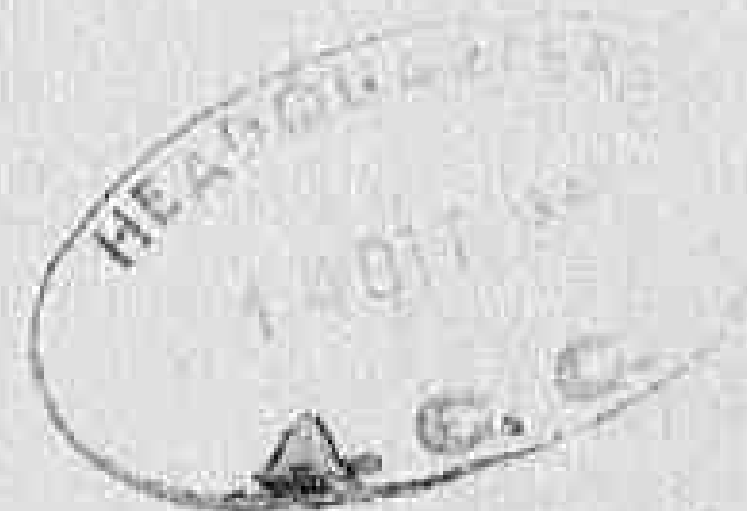

SUBJECT : Trucks for Carabinieri.

TO : V.P. Administrative Section.

1. A great number of requests are being received at this Headquarters for transport for CC.RR to the Northern Regions.
2. In order to satisfy the demand for adequate disposition of Police, it is necessary to withdraw CC.RR from the Southern areas and to transport them by sea, rail or road to the centres in the North where they are maintained pending dispersal to the localities in which they are to perform duty.
3. In addition CC.RR who have been disbanded by the enemy are sent South for screening and re-organizing.
4. At the moment the principal centre for housing and dispersing these men is at Florence, and the Northern Regions will have to be supplied from the Replacement Centre in that City.
5. The provision of these CC.RR is of the highest operational importance, and it is requested that immediate allotment be made of 25 three ton trucks to be used for conveying them and their equipment from the centres to forward localities. It is understood that some 200 trucks have recently been made available to Allied Control Commission.

Subject : Replacement Centers and military sent to newly occupied territories.

To : A.C.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission.

As a result of the verbal request made by your S/C, we are informing you that the Replacement Centers are now functioning only in Rome, Grosseto, Ancona and Siena and have exclusively the purpose to screen the personnel, who arrive from those zones. Their strength is changing continuously in accordance to the affluences and assignments of the military after screening.

These Centers have nothing to do with the supply Centers constituted first in Bari and Naples and at the present time in Rome and which supply the personnel necessary in the newly occupied territories.

The supply Center in Rome will be dissolved as soon as another could be constituted in Florence.

At said Center there are now 1100 military destined to Northern Italy, who, however, will not be able to leave, until they are supplied with arms and equipment, as stated in phonogram n. 96/6, dated 31 August 1944, addressed to your S/C.

folio 41a, contents re; rations were telephoned to RPSO Reg 111, who stated that he had already arranged for the CC.RR to take 4 days rations; also that two or three officers were accompanying the party to take charge of them, and on the arrival in Rome of the Officers, would ACC. P.S. arrange for their return to Naples.

Reference our letter of even number dated 4 July 1944 on the above subject, addressed to Executive Commissioner ACC, copy to you.

1. The principles set out in the above letter have been agreed by ACC, with the exception of para 3(b), for which the following should be substituted :-

"CC.RR.

(i) CC.RR members of the GNR will be interned if positive information is obtained indicating the probability of their endangering our security if left at liberty.

(ii) Other such members should be instructed to report to the nearest AMG Public Safety Officer, who will arrange for them to proceed to one of the CC.RR reception centres located at GROSSETO and CHIETI, where they will be screened.

Any information which FSP/CIC may obtain concerning such members, and which would assist the screening officers at the reception centres in deciding how to deal with them, should be passed to the nearest Public Safety Officer.

If no Public Safety Officer is readily available, it would be of assistance to AMG if FSP/CIC would, if at all possible, arrange for such members to be despatched to the Reception Centre concerned".

SUBJECT: Guardia Nazionale Repubblicana.

TO : HQ. AAI.

1. With reference to your AAI/1402/5/GSI(b) of 4 July 1944 the principles laid down in para.3 (a) (i) and (ii) are agreed to.

2. Arrangements already exist with regard to the CC.RR for screening and re-assigning both officers and men at CC.RR Reception Centres. At present forward Reception Centres have been established at GROSSETO on the West coast and CHIETI on the East coast. It is, therefore, recommended that the following be substituted for your para.3 (b) (i) and (ii) :

"CC.RR."

CC.RR officers and men : to be transported as soon as practicable to CC.RR Reception Centres where they will be screened.

CC.RR Reception Centres are established at GROSSETO (West Coast) and CHIETI (East Coast).

In all cases, local discretion to be exercised and the above principles to be regarded as a guide to be interpreted in the light of personalities and local circumstances.

3. If you agree with these amendments to your proposals and issue a directive on these lines will you please send us a copy.

SUBJECT : Trucks for Carabinieri.

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission, HQ ACC.

1. Centers where Royal Carabinieri are held in reserve for policing newly occupied territory have been established in Naples, Bari and Rome. New centers will be formed as the Allies advance.

2. Requests for groups of Carabinieri are now being received from AMC Fifth and Eighth Armies and Regions in the forward areas where Carabinieri have been disbanded by the enemy.

3. At the Carabinieri Centers there are no means of transport. Fifth and Eighth Armies and also Peace Sections have been asked to supply transport to convey Carabinieri and their equipment, but have refused. For instance, on 1st July an urgent request for CC. 22 to police the port of Bisbino (just captured) was received from ACC Adv. HQ. At 0800 on 2nd July (the following morning) 100 CC. 22 fully equipped were ready to leave the Center at Naples. All efforts to obtain transport from Army and civilian sources failed. Finally, after an officer from this Sub-Commission travelled to Naples and spent many hours contacting various units, arrangements were made through the courtesy of 38 Vehicle Company for the 100 CC. 22 to be conveyed to Rome on 6th July 1477. Their transport from Rome to front line has not yet been arranged.

4. It is therefore requested that urgent representations be made to AMC for the immediate allocation of 5 three-ton trucks to be used for conveying CC. 22 and their equipment from the Centers to forward areas where no CC. 22 are on duty.

SUBJECT : CCRN Replacements

TO : Executive Commissioner (thru Admin V.P.) -6 JUL 1944

1. Your office has made inquiry as to the number of CCRN personnel which are available in Naples and Bari for duty elsewhere, ostensibly in southern Italy in connection with crop harvest.

2. Please be advised that there are 100 CCRN at BARI and 100 at NAPLES who are under orders for movement to areas north of ROME, where urgent demands totalling 1250 have been received from the armies and regions. Were such demands are to be expected. Diversion of such personnel from their present commitments will interfere most seriously with the known imperative requirements to the north.

TO : Provincial Commissioners, Regions 4 & 8, A.C.C.

1. CC.RR. returning from enemy occupied territory will, where necessary, be retained for duty in the communes where found. This has been found to be satisfactory to C.A.Os. due to their local knowledge of persons and terrain.

2. The LAZIO Legion has been set up in ROME, in the Piazza del Popolo, to receive such CC.RR. when they can be spared to go. Invariably, men in civilian attire should be returned at once.

3. In this, it must be realised that no CC.RR. can be paid unless, and until, he has been re-registered at Legion H.Q.

4. A reserve of men has now been created in Rome and R.P.S.Os. may apply for reinforcements from the newly reformed Legion.

1. Recently requests have been received at Gen Hq. CC.RR from subordinate CC.RR commanders for the assignment of additional CC.RR personnel at the behest of ACC Public Safety officers

2. While the disposition of the Commanding General CC.RR is to meet requests whenever possible, the incontrovertible fact is that war-power is at a premium, and that the operational needs in the forward areas must be met. Diminution rather than increase in number in other areas is to be expected as a general trend; and requests for additional personnel in such areas should be made only in cases of exceptional urgency.

SUBJECT: Policing of Provinces in Army Area.

TO : P.P.S.Os Viterbo, Grosseto, Siena and Provinces in formation.
Corps C.A.P.Os.

1. The Mobile C.C.R.R. advancing with armies assist as far as possible in the supervision of communes and fractions on their capture as almost always no C.C.R.R. are encountered.

2. The situation usually improves in a day or two by the influx of C.C.R.R. from hiding, but in some cases they are powerless to act either due to allegations of infidelity or that armed partisans will not let them perform their duty.

By tactful handling the partisan side of the matter can normally be handled as the Mobile C.C.R.R. are generally respected.

3. The influx of returning C.C.R.R. is greater in some areas than in others and P.P.S.Os must at once survey the position and distribute C.C.R.R. to communes and fractions commensurate with population, disorder, etc. In some cases the transference of C.C.R.R. from one hostile area to another has solved the question.

4. At all events, the fast movement of the army makes it imperative that the mobile C.C.R.R. move on and P.P.S.Os of Provinces will of necessity cooperate in the preservation of law and order by adjustment of existing C.C.R.R. and those which they have brought into the area.

5. It is realised that transport difficulties exist and it is hoped that R.P.S.Os will take this in hand as soon as areas pass under Regional Control.

6. Republican Police Officers should not be engaged until their position has been investigated.

7. The large numbers of C.C.R.R. in civilian attire in the communes nearer Rome should now be available for refitment.

8. With a view to early treatment of C.C.R.R. in Lazio, it is recommended that C.C.R.R. Officers acting under Colonel Minniti of Lazio Legion visit large centers, such as Viterbo, which would in the long run save considerable time in the rehabilitation of the police.

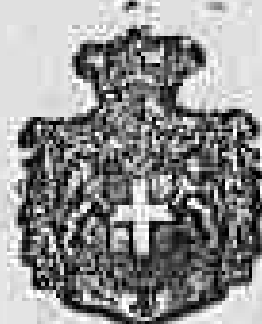

SUBJECT : Reorganization of disbanded Carabinieri in
Rome and areas to the North.
TO : Vice President, Admin. Section.

1. In view of the considerable number of Carabinieri who are members of elements disbanded by the Germans or partly disorganized by them who are in Rome or who are flowing through the lines of the armies, it is imperative that immediate steps be taken to insure that:-

- (a) Individuals guilty Nazi-Fascist activities not be reincorporated in the Corps.
- (b) Qualified and acceptable personnel be reconditioned and regrouped as soon as possible and made available for disposition as the armies advance to the north.

2. To accomplish the foregoing, the following plan, arrived at in consultation with the Commanding General of the CC.RR Gen. Picche, is recommended:-

- (a) Dispatch to the holding and replacement centers at the City of Rome or at Naples or Bari all disbanded or unassigned carabinieri, non-commissioned officers, and officers up to and including the rank of captain where the screening process will be undertaken, and restoration to duty arranged for those who are not proved guilty of Nazi-Fascist collaboration. 47-9
- (b) Dispatch to General HQ. CC.RR Majors and Lt. Cola. for screening and investigation.
- (c) Have generals and colonels report to the Ministry of War for examination by a special commission.

3. Further to accomplish the objectives set forth in para 1, it is highly desirable that Army AMG do not retain in service, except where absolutely necessary disbanded CC.RR personnel who report to them. Additional personnel when needed, are available on 24 hrs. notice from the existing replacement centers.

4. Details for the execution of the foregoing plan, including assignment of officers to accomplish the screening and the standards to be followed, are in process of preparation. In view of the need for prompt action approval of the plan in principle is requested as soon as possible.

5. A similar scheme will be adopted for the Guardia di Finanza.

SUBJECT: Provision of Carabinieri for future needs.

TO : HQ. (Rear) ACC., Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. With reference to the provision of suitable accommodation for the CC.RR. Replacement Centre, Naples.
2. As a result of enquiries made it has been ascertained that the Caserma Caribaldi, Via Forria, Naples, which is at present occupied by U.S. troops will be vacated within the next seven days.
3. Information received from the Real Estate Section, HQ., P.D.S., is that the premises will then revert to the custody of the Commanding General, Italian Armed Forces of Campania.
4. The Legion Commander, CC.RR., Naples, has been informed of the above facts and it is understood he has received a verbal assurance that the premises will be allocated to the CC.RR..
5. For your information it may be stated that the premises will accommodate approximately 2000 men. Water and electricity are laid on and there is ample lavatory and washing facilities. It will be necessary, however, to provide cooking appliances, beds, tables etc.
6. Any support you could give at a higher level to the needs of the CC.RR. in this case would be appreciated.

Moreover it is about 30 kilometer from Naples, which create many difficulties and considerable expenses for the assignment of personnel and the speedy sending out of the orders concerning the leaving and the arrival of soldiers.

I will be very grateful to this Sub-Commission, if it would be kind to designate another building which is more adaptable, situated in Naples, or within the vicinity of said city.

TO : Provincial Commissioners, Regions 4 & 8, A.C.C.

1. CC.RR. returning from enemy occupied territory will, where necessary, be retained for duty in the communes where found. This has been found to be satisfactory to C.A.Os. due to their local knowledge of persons and terrain.
2. The LAZIO Legion has been set up in ROME, in the Piazza del Popolo, to receive such CC.RR. when they can be spared to go. Invariably, men in civilian attire should be returned at once.
3. In this, it must be realised that no CC.RR. can be paid unless, and until, he has been re-registered at Legion H.Q.
4. A reserve of men has now been created in Rome and R.P.S.Os. may apply for reinforcements from the newly reformed Legion.

I am referring to this morning's conversation.

The Bari Legion Comander conferring a few days ago with the Group Comander of Foggia, Maj. Mizzau, mentioned that for the personnel allotted to the newly liberated territory they might need men from his province which has 300 men other than the effective force.

He did not give any order to move this extra force or to ask for the A.M.G.O.T. authorization.

It is however, a problem to be settled when necessary.

This does not exclude that in the future such authorizations can be asked for because the Bari Legion does not have the possibility to furnish from the remaining provinces the drafts necessary for the newly liberated territory.

At any rate I wish to communicate that the Foggia Group with a organic force of 476 men now has at it's disposition 800 men.

(for Chief of Public Safety)

1. Reference is made to your letter 203/2 of 6th June 1944.
2. The difficulty of returning disbanded CC.RR to administrative centres in Naples or Rome in the early stages of advance is fully appreciated. This Sub-Commission recognises that the decision in any emergency must be made by the man on the spot.
3. Nevertheless the general principle has been established that CC.RR who report for duty in newly occupied territory will be sent back to administrative centres to be screened, equipped and reassigned for duty. If this is not done, insurmountable administrative difficulties will be created. Therefore, although in a case of absolute necessity CC.RR may be retained on duty temporarily, they must be sent to the proper centres at the first opportunity.
4. The possibility of attaching a CC.RR officer to your HQs to deal with returning CC.RR is being discussed with the Commanding General.
5. This Sub-Commission is very appreciative of the splendid work being done by Public Safety officers in the forward areas in the face of many difficulties and the absence of adequate numbers of Italian police.

TO : General Commanding CC.RR.

1. Reports have been received from Public Safety Officers entering newly occupied territory that in the early stages it is impossible to send back CC.RR who have reported for duty to centers in Rome, Naples or Bari. In many cases it has been necessary for the officer on the spot to employ CC.RR temporarily on police duty, in the place where they have reported.
2. It is recognized that the principle of returning all disbanded CC.RR to centers where they can be screened, reequipped and re-assigned for duty is sound. However, in view of the rapid advance into new territory it is thought that the initial difficulties might be solved by attaching to each Army Hqs a CC.RR officer (or small staff) to deal with returning CC.RR until the situation becomes more normal.
3. I shall be pleased to receive your comments.

1. The situation regarding returning CC.RR. from enemy territory has had to be altered. It is impossible now to return these men to Naples or, even, to send them to a particular centre.
 2. The numbers returning cannot be replaced by others, and the supply of new CC.RR. with incoming provinces is not sufficient to police the communes.
 3. It has been decided in the emergency to retain men where found as, invariably, they are well clad and their local knowledge is most helpful to incoming C.A.Os. Those clad in Mufti can still operate by wearing the civil police armlet.
 4. These CC.RR. should be retained en situ until the situation becomes more static when they could be sent to the LAZIO Legion in ROME, if you can make this arrangement.
 5. The CC.RR. have, in some cases, been suspended since last September because they refused to join the Republican Force. The men are most keen to get to work and are doing well in the reorganisation of communes, etc.

1. The function of the Arma is complex and must confront complex needs. Only this Command has the complete set up and therefore, I would be very grateful to your Sub-Commission if it would repose in me enough confidence to tell me only the purpose that it intends to achieve and vesting in me the necessary measures and reserving for itself only the right of intervention in the case of any failure in the performance of its duties.

Our relationships are so cordial that I inform everything to the Commission and therefore any error could be immediately corrected between us.

Assuming the above, taking the case specifically:

- a) In Bari there will be always ready within 12 hours notice 150 CC.RR. In Naples, there are 100 at the present time and I hope to increase it to 150 within the near future.
- b) Already been disposed of;
- c) Already been disposed of;
- d) For food rations, I have given orders in the manner desired. The equipment shall be the best possible, having in consideration the obvious lack of uniforms.
- e) It is obvious as it was always the case, that the Carabinieri must be taken from those places where they are least needed. For the territory of the Allied Military Government since the orders come through your sub-commission, can this same sub-commission specify on whom is the duty. Is it not possible to take Carabinieri also from the said territory; however, having taken into account the needs of the Naples Legion, I have left at the said legion 50 prisoners who were released and I have earmarked newly 174 newly promoted carabinieri for Naples.
- f) Replacement Centers cannot but depend directly upon the General Command with no interference from region 3, since the a/m Carabinieri must be employed outside region 3 territory and a majority of them originate from territory of other legions.

Therefore, all the requests must come from your sub-commission who in turn will pass it on to me, I shall be responsible for its execution. If Lt. TOES wishes to help us in some manner or other, he is welcome, but for the functioning of the "nucleo" he is not needed. If there are many issuing orders, nothing but confusion can result.

- g) I will strive to hold the dispersed separated. I recommend on this proposal together them in the centers because until now it has not been done, and if I do not have the personnel, the time will soon come that I will not be able to provide any.

2. Concerning your proposals

- a) For Boscoreale - all is well - the beds and furniture are very difficult

to get a supply of them because there is no material nor the enterprise which furnished them previously.

At the replacement center arrived two Captains and four Deputies who shall be held in reserve. 1 Captain and two deputies at Bari

- b) Already done. Please give me the collection of proclamations for Bari.
- c) Already done. It is possible to allocate a superior officer instead of a Captain, i.e. if I could find him. Regardless, there will always be a commander.
- d) It is well.
- e) It has already been completed for 2 months, and enters into the normal functions of the command.
- f) Already answered in the letter Sub-Div. (f) of number 1.

3. It is natural to request benzine; the difficulty shall be to acquire it. But whatever possible shall be done.

4. I thank you in advance for the cooperation of Lt. TOES.

5. Already done.

I have no other desire except to see that every thing goes well; naturally there are difficulties and I will do whatever is possible. I will ask for your help whenever I feel that I cannot succeed with the means at my disposal.

I believe it is opportune to remind you that with the adoption of these measures it shall be possible to ~~bring up to~~ ^{reach} Rome. In addition it shall be necessary to depend solely upon those who are prisoners and those who have been released.

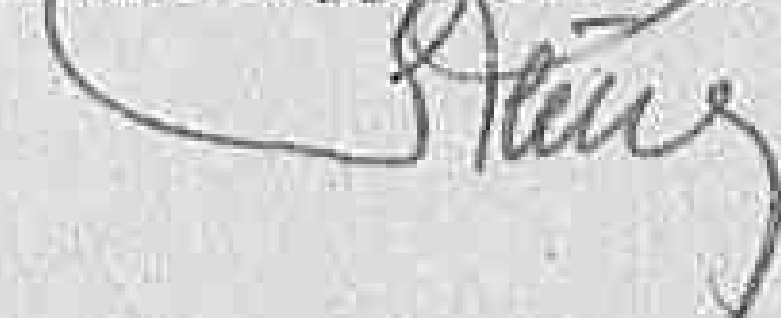

In addition, 50 CERR have been allocated at the Legion Barracks in Naples, ready to move on next Monday morning.

In total, 390 military men have been furnished up to the present time in addition to the personnel for the Capital. The 90 units, each consisting of five military men, including a non-com or corporal (totally 450 men), which I had ordered to be arranged at the regions of Bari, Catanzaro and Naples, have now been almost absorbed.

Steps have been taken for the arrangements of

40 more units, but as the requests for personnel are increasing, I foresee that also the latter will be shortly exhausted.

As already stated, this Command is able to meet the needs of the service at most as far as the Capital.

From Rome onwards must be provided with personnel (the number of which is uncertain) which is to be collected in the new liberated territories, provided that they be supplied with clothes and equipment, which we have already requested many times.

I call your attention on the advisability⁽¹⁾ of pumping and pumping personnel from Liberated Italy (including Sicily and Sardinia) which may cause serious prejudice to the public order. It is still proper to insist upon the repatriation of prisoners war.

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission,
Rear H.Q., A.C.C.

1. CC.RR. are coming into occupied territory in large numbers and have, by force of circumstances, been retained for a period until an opportunity permits them being transported to Naples.
2. In addition to returning them by truck, which is now a very long distance, use is made of returning food ships from GAETA.
3. C.A.P.Os. in the line and Littoria P.P.S.O. are so fully occupied in their duties that it is impossible for them now to escort them to these places from where they can be trucked or shipped. Further these CC.RR. are so foot-sore and hungry they are unable to make the journey until they have rested.
4. The pool of CC.RR. has not been able to return man for man.
5. The solution would appear to be that a responsible CC.RR. officer be housed at LITTORIA. He would receive and register these men as they come in and either be empowered to put them back into service, when they are fully uniformed, or, to retain those out of uniform and send them to the rear in organised batches. The piecemeal method that obtains at present is not satisfactory. For one thing, it is possible for any man, acting as an enemy agent, to go elsewhere than the Legion H.Q. at Naples.
6. When the situation is cleared in LITTORIA the officer referred to in paragraph 5, could be available to act in another area with the same powers.
7. Incidentally, Corps Generals are insistent that the demands for CC.RR. are met and, so far, this has been complied with.

SUBJECT: Replacement Centre at Naples.

TO : General Commanding CC.RR.

1. In view of the importance of CC.RR. Replacement Centres for the purpose of supplying CC.RR. at short notice to the areas newly occupied by the Allied Forces, it is considered that the following principles should apply:

- a. At each Replacement Centre 150 CC.RR. should always be available at 12 hours notice. 1 Capt. and 2 Lieuts should also be immediately available. 4720
- b. These men should be kept in a separate building and during the waiting period should receive suitable training for their duties.
- c. The Replacement Centre should be under the control of a CC.RR. officer who should be responsible for moving the men in compliance with orders.
- d. The CC.RR. should be responsible for ensuring that the 150 CC.RR. are adequately equipped and that a supply of 7 days rations is available.
- e. The CC.RR. to fill the Replacement Centres should be drawn from those Legions which can best spare the men. No CC.RR. should be taken from Military Government territory without the consent of Public Safety Sub-Commission except in an emergency in which case subsequent adjustments will be made in consultation with Public Safety Sub-Commission.
- f. There should be a recognized channel for ordering CC.RR. to move out of the Replacement Centres. Requests for CC.RR. should be submitted to the Public Safety Sub-Commission. Orders will be transmitted from Public Safety Sub-Commission through local Public Safety Officers to the Replacement Centres.

- a. Dishar 1 CC.RR. who have returned for duty should be kept quite distinct from the Replacement Centres.

2. To put into effect these principles the following proposals are suggested for Naples:

- a. A Replacement Centre be established at once in the ex-Municipio at Boscoreale (near Torre Annunziata). On 1st June 1944 this building was placed at the disposal of the Naples Legion of CC.RR. by 57 Base Area. The building, which will accommodate at least 250 men, will need cleaning and the provision of beds and essential furniture. Until the building is ready for occupation 150 CC.RR. to remain at the Tribunale Caserma, Naples. 1 Capt. and 2 Lieutenants to be available at CC.RR. Legion HQ.
- b. The 150 CC.RR. to receive instruction, especially as regards Allied Proclamations and the giving of evidence before Allied Military Courts. Proclamations and a booklet of Court procedure have been supplied to the Legion Commander.
- c. A Captain of the Naples Legion to be permanently in charge of the Replacement Centre. 4720
- d. Equipment and rations to be supplied through Naples Legion Commander. A special ration (vide Appendix A) to be kept in reserve.
- e. Plans to be prepared for drawing CC.RR. from all parts of Liberated Italy to meet future requirements and to prevent denuding the Naples Legion.
- f. All requests for CC.RR. to be drawn from the Replacement Pool at Naples to be referred to Public Safety HQ. Salerno. Approval will be sent to CC.RR. HQs and also to Region 3, Public Safety. Lieut. Toes, (Region 3) will pass on the order to the Legion Commander who will issue instructions to the CC.RR. Captain in charge of the Replacement Centre.

3. In connection with the establishment of a Replacement Centre at Boscoreale in addition to arranging for rations through normal channels it is suggested that application be made for an extra allocation of petrol to enable supervising officers to visit frequently.

4. As far as means of transporting CC.RR. to forward areas is concerned, Lieut. Toes of Region 3, will render every assistance in his power.

1. Reference ACC/14601/34/PS, dated 26th May 1944.
2. With the intake of 50 CC.RR. from Naples Legion today the situation in regard to Mobile CC.RR. of this Unit is satisfactory.
3. Forty (40) CC.RR. were posted to LITTORIA Province on its partial occupation and stationed at GAETA. It was intended to use these as replacements for CC.RR. returning from occupied territory. As things turned out these were not sufficient to put this into practice and men had to go to communes as they were occupied.
4. The position now is that CC.RR. are returning in good numbers and some have been retained for a short period due to the urgency of the situation.
5. Assessing the pre-war strength of CC.RR. in LITTORIA Province as 240 it would appear essential that at least another 50 be sent to GAETA to be supplemented by another 50 when the situation becomes more stable. This will allow 4 CC.RR. approximately per commune.
6. In making this assessment, allowance has been made ⁴⁷²for the employment of Metropolitani and encouragement is given to the employment of reputable citizens by Sindaci to ease local government control quo ad police.

1. The attached draft will, I hope, explain the working of the proposed Replacement Centre Scheme which I have arranged with General Pische. This should ensure that organised groups of Carabinieri will be available to police those provinces which we shall have to take over as the military advance progresses.
2. I have already visited Region V and introduced the Colonel of Carabinieri who will have charge of the AQUILA, TIRAMO, PESCARA Group to the R.P.S.O. and details of planning and organisation are already being worked out between them.
3. This scheme should obviate the necessity for having large numbers of Carabinieri with nothing to do, waiting in the rear of Army Areas and presenting an administrative problem themselves. In future they will be held in the Replacement Centres where they will be specially trained and fitted for their duties.
4. I am anxious that those disbanded Carabinieri who are expected to volunteer for further service should not be immediately re-employed in the locality in which they re-enlist but are directed to the appropriate Replacement Centre where they will be properly "vetted", re-equipped and re-grouped for further service.
5. Instead of dealing with this as a technical matter I would prefer that you should circulate the attached letter to Regional Commissioners and I will follow it up in fuller correspondence with Regional Public Safety Officers.
