1. Allied Military Government in the Venezia Giulia and Udine area controls the use of P.O.L. by truck operators through the Centro Autotrasporti in Trieste. Part of this control is effected by the issue of a trip ticket which the driver must have stamped or signed at his destination, thus proving that he has made the journey. In many places in Italy drivers are unable to obtain the required signature.

2. It would be appreciated if arrangements could be made for these tickets to be stamped at Carabinieri Stations showing date and place. This measure will greatly assist control of P.O.L. issues and will appreciably hinder black market operations in P.O.L.

1. Allied Military Government 13 Corps controls the use of P.O.L. by truck operators through the Centro Autotrasporti in Trieste.

2. Part of this control is effected by the issue of a trip ticket which the driver must have signed or stamped at his destination, either by the local Autotrasporti Office or any local Police or Government authority.

3. In many places in Italy, drivers state, they are unable to obtain the required signature giving various excuses for their failure.

4. May representations please be made to the Italian Government to give orders to the C.C.R.R. to stamp trip tickets issued by Centro Autotrasporti when presented at a Carabinieri post, showing date and place, thus proving that the truck has actually reached its destination.

5. This measure will greatly assist Control of P.O.L. issues and will appreciably hinder Black Market operations in P.O.L.

That in the supposition that the Allied Command had given new orders, which this General Command and dependent Legions do not know yet.

So that we pray that Sub-Commission to will give the indispensable orders in order to facilitate petrol and oils supply to our legions of the North.

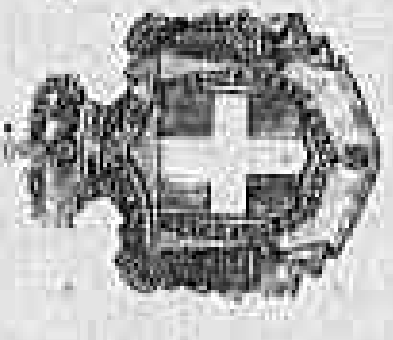

1. Reference your AG/5146/22/Commerce/POL 17.
2. The particulars given in Carabinieri letter dated 11th May 1945 are confused rather than inaccurate. The true position is as follows.
3. AFHQ have allotted 4 light utility trucks, 48 Allied 3 ton trucks and 48 Humber Mark IV Armoured vehicles to the four Regions of the north. This transport will be used to form four mobile battalions each consisting of 1 light utility 12 3 ton trucks and 12 armoured vehicles.
4. 2 light utilities, 4 trucks and 48 armoured vehicles have already been sent to the north. 44 trucks and 8 armoured vehicles are undergoing repair. 2 light utilities have not yet been made available.
5. No P.O.L. is required for this transport other than for the move to the north. This was arranged by you for the recent move mentioned in Par 4. When the 44 trucks and 8 armoured cars are ready for movement your assistance will be asked.
6. The transport mentioned above is all Allied and accordingly MMIA are not concerned. However, MMIA have allotted to the Carabinieri 50 Italian Artillery Recon Cars. These are for general purpose use and not in connection with the Mobile Battalions. 50 Carabinieri drivers are being trained in the use of these special vehicles at the Italian Army driving school. P.O.L. for this purpose has to be supplied from CC.FP sources and it is considered that 6000 litres per month will prove sufficient.

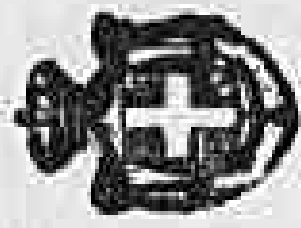

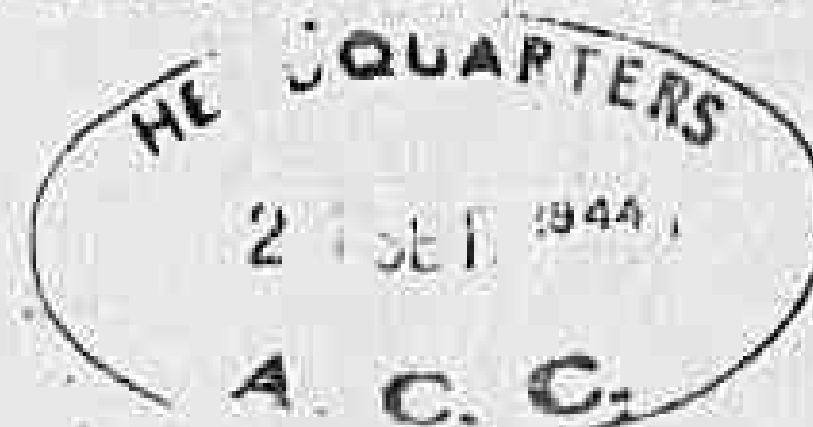

TO:- V.P. Economic Section.

1. It is understood that an allocation of trucks is shortly to be made to HQ ACC. Two sub-commissions in this section are very badly in need of assistance in transportation:-

- a. Public Health sub-commission, and
- b. Public Safety sub-commission.

2. The trucks required for Public Health are required for the carriage of civilian sick and wounded in forward areas, it would therefore be preferable that they be ambulances. If this is not possible, light trucks which could be converted for this purpose would be acceptable.

3. 12 vehicles are required for use in the forward areas, and 12 vehicles for the use of Italian Red Cross, making a total of 24.

4. The most urgent need at the present moment for Public Safety is for vehicles to be used by the CC. MR. Large numbers of men are required to be moved at very short notice, with their kit and equipment, into the forward areas as the army advances. It is therefore requested that an allotment of 25 vehicles (3 tons) be made available to the Public Safety Sub-commission primarily for this purpose which is of an operational nature. In addition CC. MR found in liberated areas require moving to rear areas for re-organisation and re-equipment before returning to field duty.

5. Considerable delay has occurred in the past owing to the difficulties of getting suitable transport, either by road or rail, to move these men. As an instance of the complicated nature of moves it is necessary at present to move men from Naples to Leghorn by sea and thence by road to their destinations in the Florence area, transport having to be begged from the Army concerned for the latter part of the journey.

SUBJECT : CC.RR - Requisition of Motor Car.

TO : A.D.O.S. (B) R A A C.

1. At 6 P.M. on 1st September 1944 Fiat 1500 Motor car No 52595 Roma was seized by two British M.P's and impounded.
2. The car is owned by Lt Col BERSANETTI, CC.RR Staff Officer to General CARUSO, and at the time of seizure was standing outside the Divisional HQ CC.RR at Piazza 24 May.
3. The car permit produced by Col BERSANETTI at the time expired on 31st August 1944. On 6 September 1944 Lt Col BERSANETTI Produced a current car permit at HQ R A A C; this had been issued on 5th September 1944. He was told that it was not possible to return his car to him, and the current permit was seized.
4. Information on this subject has been forwarded to this Sub-Commission by General CARUSO CC.RR. It is pointed out that Col BERSANETTI commands the Esterno Group of the Rome Region. His duties necessitate the use of a car to visit the areas of his command. Although the Fiat car 52595 Roma, is owned by Lt Col BERSANETTI, its use is authorised by CC.RR HQ. It has been stated that the vehicle is used solely on CC.RR duties.
5. It is considered by this Sub-Commission that the possession of a motor car is essential to the proper performance of Lt Col BERSANETTI's duty. As a result of enquires made it is believed that the car would not be improperly used.
6. It would be appreciated if the Fiat motor car 52595 could be returned to Lt Col BERSANETTI.

SUBJECT: Petrol for CC.RR.

TO : ACC, Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. Every effort has been made by this office to enable and encourage the CC.RR. to obtain by requisition sufficient motor vehicles for the efficient execution of their police duties.

2. The process has been gradual, but the number of vehicles at the disposal of CC.RR. in this Region has substantially increased during the past two months.

3. However their efficient use has been much curtailed by a reduction in the allowance of petrol to CC.RR. by the Intendenza of the Armed Forces of Campania.

4. From information given by Col. Quercia, Commander Naples Legion, prior to the present month an allowance of 10,000 litres monthly was issued to his Command. Now with more vehicles only 7,000 litres have been allocated for the month of May.

5. Further, a considerable waste of petrol takes place in distribution as this allowance is issued piecemeal, 3 times a month.

6. It is suggested that it might be more satisfactory and likely to produce better results from a police point of view if a separate issue of petrol were made in bulk to CC.RR., preferably by Regions (i.e. to each Legion) and not from Italian Army supplies as at present. 533
