2. Of the CC.RR. so far brought forward to Siena, there are nearly 100 unfit for duty due to minor complaints. ✓
3. In addition AMG 8th Army, have requested that the Florence team be built up to at least 400 strong. ✓
4. The peace time strength of NCOs and CC.RR. in Florence is 607 (Command, Internal and External Groups). The present actual strength in Florence is 366 NCOs and CC.RR.. ✓
5. The Siena team of 50 is reduced to 30 on account of sickness. ✓
6. The Arezzo team is also affected by sickness. ✓
7. It is necessary therefore that a further 100 CC.RR. be made available for Florence City and another 100 to augment the Siena and Arezzo teams. ✓
8. Will you please advise me on the availability of these men. ✓

On the 9 August Lt. Col. Hamilton, Military Governor of Grosseto came to Arcidosso.

A meeting held at Communal seat, the major, vice major, secretary, members of the National Committee for liberation, chief of the Partisan Group (TRIPODI), Lt. Col. Hamilton, it was provided among other things to check as quickly as possible the robberies committed in the mountains of Amiata.

Lt. BENZONI Angelo, commanding the "tenenza" of the Carabinieri in Arcidosso, although not invited to the meeting, went to English Lt. Col. and inquired about said matter.

The Lt. Col. having reaffirmed the necessity of arming the Partisans in the locality and its necessity in order to carry on an intensive campaign against these Fascist bands of robbers, Benzoni suggested that said service could be done by the Arma.

Lt. Col. Hamilton answered that it was impossible because a service of such a nature required elements who were well armed and who knew the surroundings. He also asked Lt. Benzoni to surrender the surplus arms of CC.FF. to the major of Arcidosso so that they could be distributed among the Partisans. Lt. Benzoni replied that he did not have any.

The Lt. Col. then stated that he would obtain them himself and he also added that the said arms had to be stored in the Commune and to be delivered to the Partisans when necessary.

English officer wrote the attached statement by which the major of Arcidosso was appointed temporary police chief of Monte Amiata Zone and the majors of Casteldelpiano, Seggiano and S. Fiora, are authorized to arm the Partisans and to take extraordinary measures in order to check the robberies in the respective Communes.

Lt. Benzoni, after Lt. Col. Hamilton had departed, he was assured by major of Arcidosso and members of the Liberation Committee that no action would be taken until they received the opinion of the Commander of "tenenza" of CC.FF.

Lt. Benzoni is certain that he will be able to obtain the same assurance from the three other Communes.

The leaders of the Partisans fear that once their men are released it shall be difficult to control them.

I referred the said matter to English Major Moody, Provincial Chief of Police, who stated that he did not agree with measures adopted by Lt. Col. Hamilton.

Public order of the Province is normal, but it would be advisable to assign to the Grosseto Group the non/coms and Carabinieri requested.

The incident has caused such great excitement that the stations, after departure of the elements who served under the "Republican" Govt., were left with only 2 or 3 soldiers.

Avendo il tenente colonnello Hamilton affermato la necessità di armare i partigiani locali e quelli dei comuni vicini per eseguire intense battute nelle zone ove è presunta la presenza di bande armate fasciste, il tenente Benzoni suggerì l'opportunità di fare eseguire tali servizi dall'Arma.

Il tenente colonnello Hamilton rispose che ciò era impossibile in quanto per servizi del genere necessitano elementi bene armati e pratici dei luoghi. Invitò anzi il tenente Benzoni a cedere senz'altro al sindaco di Arcidosso, perchè fossero distribuite ai partigiani, le armi esuberanti esi-

stenti presso la locale caserma Carabinieri Reali. Il tenente Benzoni rispose che non ne aveva. Il tenente colonnello Hamilton comunicò allora al sindaco che avrebbe provveduto egli stesso a fargliene pervenire e aggiunse che dette armi dovevano essere custodite nel palazzo comunale e consegnate ai partigiani all'atto delle operazioni.

L'ufficiale inglese compilò quindi i cinque certificati che si uniscono in copia con i quali, temporaneamente, il sindaco di Arcidosso viene nominato capo della polizia della zona del Monte Amiata e i sindaci di Casteldelpiano, Seggiano e S. Fiora, sono autorizzati ad armare i partigiani e a prendere misure straordinarie per reprimere il brigantaggio nei rispettivi comuni.

Il tenente Benzoni, dopo la partenza del Ten. Col. Hamilton (ore 17,30), ottenne dal sindaco di Arcidosso e dai membri di quel comitato nazionale di liberazione l'assicurazione che, prima di dare inizio ad operazioni con partigiani armati, ne sia esaminata l'opportunità, presente il comandante la tenenza dei Carabinieri Reali e sentito il suo parere.

Il tenente Benzoni è certo di ottenere altrettanto presso gli altri tre comuni.

Gli stessi capi partigiani temono che, una volta lanciati, sarà difficile frenare l'attività dei propri uomini.

Ho riferito quanto precede al maggiore inglese Moddy, capo della polizia di detta provincia, riportando la netta impressione che egli disapprova i provvedimenti adottati dal tenente colonnello Hamilton.

La situazione della pubblica sicurezza della provincia è normale, ma sarebbe opportuno venissero destinati al gruppo di Grosseto i sottufficiali e i carabinieri richiesti.

SUBJECT : Carabinieri re-inforcement.

TO : R.P.S.O. Region VIII.

Reference your R-VIII/PS/3.1 dated 12 August 1944.

1. Re Para 2-i) It is our understanding that the CC.RR replacement Centre Commanders and the responsible Legion Commanders are fully conversant with the established policies of the Supreme Command CC.RR relating to the members who rejoin following the liberation of territory from German and Republican-Fascist domination.

2. Re Para 2-ii) By all means the men who are found to be acceptable for assignment to duty should be so assigned without delay. If you find that you have a surplus you should report to this Headquarters giving all facts relating to members, condition of uniforms and other equipment and any other pertinent information, we can then arrange to transfer them to locations where their services are required.

3. Re Para 2-iii) The Commanding General CC.RR Supreme Headquarters is planning to open a central replacement Centre at Florence as soon as the Army authorities will permit.

4. The transfer of CC.RR personnel from one commune to another or one province to another within the Legion Command, can be taken care of by the Legion Commander if the Regional Public Safety officer approves. He should inform HQ CC.RR of action taken and send copy for information to this Headquarters.

SUBJECT : Carabinieri re-inforcement.

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission, HQ. A.C.C..

1. Col. Carrai, Livorno Legion Commander, has been in communication with me in respect of CC.RR. for the Livorno and Grosseto Groups.

2. a. For the Livorno Group he requests that 78 NCOs and 182 CC.RR. be sent forward as soon as they can be got ready for service. Confirmed by local A.M.G..

b. The Legion Commander also wants to move a considerable number of CC.RR. who collaborated with the Republic to Grosseto as the public shows much hostility against them.

c. This can be done by Region VIII only if and when transport is available for the purpose, (please note Inter comment under Grosseto) but the transport eventually used to bring up re-inforcements can move these 'unwanted' CC.RR. south, whether to Grosseto or further south still, as I would recommend.

3. For the Grosseto Group the Legion Commander requests a further 50 NCOs and 150 CC.RR.. As he should be receiving 30 NCOs and 50 CC.RR. today 15 August 1944, the number to be made up would be a further 20 NCOs and 100 CC.RR. only required.

4. In respect of the CC.RR. who have not been 'discriminated' and who remain in the Replacement Centre, he states there is much public hostility at their continued presence in town and yet he also asks for Grosseto to absorb 'unwanted' elements in Livorno.

5. The solution to this problem seems to be the early removal to Rome or Naples of these 'unwanted' CC.RR., where they could be accommodated better. Precise figures are not yet to hand.

6. This process of 'discrimination' is a very slow one, largely due to lack of clothing etc, transport difficulties and the slowness of the CC.RR. Command, etc, in this re-organisation of the CC.RR.

7. I suggest that it would facilitate matters greatly with suitable transportation available, like requisitioned civilian or military vehicles, and assigned to CC.RR.

Suitable civilian transport in this area is almost unknown and Regional and Provincial transport much occupied.

8. Region VIII has in fact already had to loan transport to 8th Army A.M.C. to move 4 ration CC.RR. temporarily assigned to Army for various purposes.

9. Much of the contents of this letter have already been communicated to CC.RR. Command by Col. Carrai.

1. Replacement Centre - Grosseto:

I have to inform you that Lt. Col. AMOROSO appointed by the CC.RR. Command to organise the Replacement Centre at Grosseto is proving unsuitable. He is without energy and drive and is incapable of handling the job in hand.

I ask that he be replaced forthwith by an intelligent officer with sufficient ability to comply with the modest requirements of this office.

2. Officers for Florence Legion:

3. Carabinieri for 8th Army:

With reference to 8th Army, A.M.G. signal M-428 dated 3 August 1944 to A.C.C. HQ.

183 CC.RR. out of the proposed 200 requested, reached Siena at 1 a.m. 8 August 1944.

30 of the 183 were in plain clothes but had uniform in their possession. They are unable to wear it, being outsize.

About 28 of this party of CC.RR. are suffering from old age debility or general unfitness for service and I am now seeking authority of 8th Army to return them to Rome.

It is requested that only men suitable for service be sent forward and that the necessary measures to fit these men out to be completed in Rome before they are sent forward.

SUBJECT: C.C.R.R. Reserves.

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission, H.Q., A.C.C.

1. Reference your cable No. 1500 dated 8th August.
2. Of the 200 C.C.R.R. sent by you to GROSSETO it is understood that 100 have gone to Eighth Army A.M.G.

The other 100 are in course of transportation today and tomorrow to CECINA for service in this Army area.

3. Several small groups of C.C.R.R. now in the area immediately behind II and IV Corps are being dealt with as follows:

a. Those in mufti are being returned to LIVORNO as soon as transport can be found for them.

b. Those in uniform are being visited by a C.C.R.R. Officer from LIVORNO in the communes where they are found and where they will be interrogated. The officer is being transported under arrangements made by the Corps P.S.O.

4. Colonel Carrai has been told, to build up a small reserve, if possible, in Livorno for use in any emergency that may arise.

5. The C.C.R.R. centre at Grosseto will soon be too far south to cater for the western portion of Tuscany and as soon as accommodation can be found in Livorno the centre should be transferred there to what will eventually be the Legion Headquarters for all the provinces when occupied.

6. GROSSETO is now out of Army area.

1) Since the occupation of Rome City, and the arrival of Advanced H.Q. of P.S., in Rome on the 15th June, 1944, we have been actively engaged in the establishment of a CC.RR. Replacement Centre. This Centre is located at the Vittorio Emanuele Barracks, Via Legnano, and is under the administrative command of Lt. Colonel Bonolfi, appointed for that purpose by General Picche commanding General CC.RR. The Centre receives all CC.RR., who were disbanded or who dispersed of their own accord during the German occupation, and who are now reporting back for service.

It is estimated that up to about 6000 such men may be expected to return. To date, some 1700 have reported back, have been, or are in process of being screened, and are now at the Replacement Centre. Rations are being obtained for them.

2) As requests are received at the H.Q. for CC.RR. to be sent to forward areas the men are drawn from this Centre.

Since 27 June, 1944, the following requests have been received for CC.RR.:-

- (1) 100 CC.RR. for Piacenza Port (5 Army)
- (2) 350 CC.RR. for forward areas (5 Army)
- (3) 500 CC.RR. for Provinces in Reg.8
- (4) 300 CC.RR. for A.M.C. 5 Army.

All surplus stocks of CC.RR. clothing and equipment in this City are now exhausted, and while the men are available to meet all the above requirements, they cannot be sent forward owing to the fact that there are no uniforms or arms with which to equip them. Every effort is being made to obtain uniforms and arms and while some progress is being made in this direction, it is slow compared with the urgency of sending CC.RR. forward.

3) The 100 CC.RR. for Piacenza, have been drawn from the Naples Group, but difficulty in transport has delayed matters: arrangements have now been made which should enable their early dispatch. In the meantime, 100 CC.RR. have been loaned to A.M.C. 5 Army for this assignment by R.F.S.C. Reg.8.

4) In view of the urgency of A.M.C. 5 Army requirements, it is strongly recommended that the 300 CC.RR. (Item 4, para 2) be drawn from the force of CC.RR. on duty in Rome City. If this procedure is approved, this number of CC.RR. could be replaced to Rome City at a later date, when uniforms are available.

1. C.C.R.R. for Region 8 recently received from Naples and Rome have been utilized as follows, excluding those now under 8th Army:

- a. 50 in Grosseto for duty there.
- b. 100 in Livorno for duty there.
- c. 50 in Livorno for duty in PISA when occupied.
- d. 50 in Cecina on call for LUCCA.
- e. 50 in Cecina on call for PISTOIA.
- f. 50 in Grosseto on call for APUANIA and will be removed to Piombino on 25th July 44 so that they will be within shorter distance.

2. In the event of an emergency those C.C.R.R. in d., e., and f., can be used to supplement or assist any part of 5th or 8th Army Areas bearing in mind that the requirements given for the various towns was the minimum. For example the 100 in Livorno has to deal with a reduced population of 35,000 against the normal one of 130,000. In the event of a return to normal population the 100 C.C.R.R. would require to be reinforced unless there is a considerable influx of C.C.R.R. from enemy occupied territory.

3. Col. CARRAI, C.C.R.R. will take up duty in LIVORNO on 23rd July 1944, so that he can operate in his assigned Headquarters.

4. In order to cope with any demands that can be expected for territory further north it is considered that a further 200 uniformed C.C.R.R. be sent to GROSSETO by 1st August. When established these men would be in a centre much nearer than Rome and be on call for Region VIII, 5th and 8th Armies.

5. The R.P.S.O. Region VIII, to whom notification should be sent, will arrange for transport from Rome to Grosseto.

SUBJECT : Trucks for Carabinieri.

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission, HQ ACC.

1. Centers where Royal Carabinieri are held in reserve for policing newly occupied territory have been established in Naples, Bari and Rome. New centers will be formed as the Armies advance.
2. Requests for groups of Carabinieri are now being received from AMG Fifth and Eighth Armies and Regions in the forward areas where Carabinieri have been disbanded by the enemy.
3. At the Carabinieri Centers there are no means of transport. Fifth and Eighth Armies and also Base Sections have been asked to supply transport to convey Carabinieri and their equipment, but have refused. For instance, on 1st July an urgent request for CC.RR to police the port of Piombino (just captured) was received from ACC Adv. HQ. At 0800 on 2nd July (the following morning) 100 CC.RR fully equipped were ready to leave the Center at Naples. All efforts to obtain transport from Army and civilian sources failed. Finally, after an officer from this Sub-Commission travelled to Naples and spent many hours contacting various units, arrangements were made through the courtesy of 38 Vehicle Company for the 100 CC.RR to be conveyed to Rome on 6th July 1944. Their transport from Rome to Piombino has not yet been arranged.
4. It is therefore requested that urgent representations be made to AFHQ for the immediate allocation of 25 three-ton trucks to be used for conveying CC.RR and their equipment from CC.RR Centers to forward areas where no CC.RR are on duty.

In planning P.S. arrangements for this new Region VIII I have been much exercised in mind as to the provision of necessary C.C.R.R. personnel and have explored every possible avenue for information on the subject.

With respect, I call attention to the impossibility of the present situation, particularly in regard to the uncertain situation in regard to C.C.R.R. which confronts us and the present system adopted to meet such contingencies.

In the first place I am informed that there are in ROME about 70 officers and 5,000 C.C.R.R. who were disbanded and who have reported for duty and are in process of being screened and fitted out as far as practicable in Rome.

This is a very slow process, much too slow for present needs. We need C.C.R.R. now for duty in TUSCANY and I suggest that they should be made available for duty before "screening".

The system now in force at Replacement Centres can never catch up with demands.

Since my previous application on 16 Jun. 44 for certain C.C.R.R. nuclei I find the position is very difficult. Few C.C.R.R. are likely to be found (if my information is correct and it comes from a reliable source) firstly for the reason that many disbanded C.C.R.R. fear arrest for desertion if they report and that many of those who took the oath to the Republican Guard fear arrest for collaboration with the enemy if they, similarly, report for duty.

The sequel can well be imagined.

Patriots working behind the line, many real patriots but many also who are out for personal gain may, unless the forces of law and order are strong enough seek to settle old scores and disturbances of a different nature to what we have yet experienced occur. With a view to obtaining the best possible from a very confused and difficult situation I suggest the following steps be taken AT ONCE

- a. A proclamation or appeal on the Radio calling upon all C.C.R.R. in territory still occupied by the enemy, as soon as possible after we arrive to rejoin or report for duty at the stations to which they are or were normally attached.
- b. That all patriots be called upon to give all assistance and co-operation in this matter in the interest of the maintenance of law and order.
- c. In view of the lack of preparation for P.S. measures in TUSCANY, as were undertaken in respect of ROME - I suggest that a senior officer of C.C.R.R. (and I suggest Colonel QUERCHI who speaks English) together with

This would provide a much quicker solution to the problem than now

obtains.

Starting from this point we can then build up to the normal establishment in TUSCANY which comprises 5000-6000 officers and men.

The quality and loyalty of some of the officers who may remain in FLORENCE and TUSCANY may have been affected and it is as well, at least, to have continued.....
