1. On 13 Sep 44 I enclose (from Public Safety Sub-Commission, HQ., Allied Central Commission, that the following members of CO.MI are being moved forward as shown hereunder.

2. 900 CO.MI are being shipped from HAWAII to LAMARCA and to arrive on 20 Sep 44, enroute to LAMARCA. Transport five LAMARCA will be arranged by HQ, Fifth Army.

Of above members 300 are allocated to Region IX, the remainder to Region X (LAMARCA).

3. 150 CO.MI at present at LAMARCA will be moved forward to LAMARCA within the next two or three days.

1. On 12 Sep 44, I ascertained from Public Safety Sub-Commission, M., Allied Central Commission, that the following numbers of CC.MR are being moved between as shown hereunder.

2. 900 CC.MR are being shipped from NAWA to LAMONG due to arrive on 20 Sep 44 enroute to FLEWING. Transport from LAMONG will be arranged by M.C. Fifth Army.

Of above numbers 500 are allocated to Region II, the remainder to Region I (JAMBUKA).

3. 150 CC.MR at present at GIBET will be moved forward to FLEWING within the next two or three days.

SUBJECT: Provision of CC.RR.

TO : AMC., Rear Hq., Eighth Army (for attention of SGAPO)

1. Will you please note that there are now available a further 150 CC.RR for your immediate use.

2. These are at the CC.RR Caserma at ANCONA and they have been alerted as from 8 Sep 44 by the R.P.S.O., Region 5 upon instructions of Hq., Allied Control Commission.

3. I would point out that this region is not in a position to transport these men and that if necessary arrangements could be made by you to convey them to the point you desire.

4. This contingent, with the 150 already supplied from PERUGIA, will make a total of 300 for the provinces of FORLI, RAVENNA and FERRARA. Hq., Allied Control Commission, have promised further reinforcements of CC.RR in the near future and these will be allocated to yourself and 5th Army as situation demands.

5. For the purpose of the records of this region our allocation of the 300 CC.RR now at your disposal is as hereunder:-

1. In further reference to letter RIX/PS/11/11 dated 9 August 1944, please be advised that it will be necessary for you to notify this headquarters when you are prepared to receive house and feed the CC.RR personnel intended for duty in the Provinces of your Region as they are liberated.

It is important that we be informed of the Provinces to which the men are to be assigned as you call for them, so that the Officers who are already designated by name for assignment to specific areas can be prepared to move forward with the troops.

2. The above mentioned letter is considered as an estimate of your future requirements and not as a request to prepare the men for forward movement at any stated time.

3. As stated in our letter ACC/14601/48/PS dated 18 August 1944 we must inform you that transportation for the forward movement of personnel is not available at this Headquarters. Regional transportation is expected to be used for that purpose.

4. We will appreciate it if you will notify us two or three days ahead of the arrival of your transportation for the forward movement so that all arrangements can be completed thereby avoiding delay.

1. So far as I can ascertain the peace time strength of Carabinieri, non-commissioned officers and men in Region IX was as shown hereunder:-

2. When the Region is occupied all existing carabinieri will be immediately passed back to Replacement Centres for rescreening etc., and the only carabinieri available for duty will be mobile carabinieri attached to the Army.

3. As the advance may be rapid it is likely that within a very short time the mobile carabinieri will move forward with the Army leaving the area concerned without personnel.

4. Bearing in mind the lack of C.C.R.R., I suggest the minimum skeleton force of carabinieri which will be required for immediate service will be as follows:-

5. At present, two Provincial Teams, i.e., Bologna and Forli have moved forward to Perugia and Macerata respectively, prior to entering their Provinces when occupied by Allied Troops. Modena Team will move to Siena today.

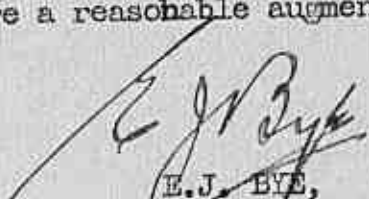

6. To provide C.C.R.R. for service with these ten I ask that 250 officers, N.C.Os and men be made available for immediate service in Bologna and 150 officers, N.C.Os and men for Forli Province from the Replacement Pool at Chieti, where I understand a pool has been recently established. I also ask that 100 officers, N.C.Os and men be made available at the Grosseto Pool for service in Modena.

7. As it may be only a matter of days before these three provinces are occupied I ask that this request be treated as urgent and this headquarters notified immediately the forces are available.

8. Application for C.C.R.R. personnel for the remaining provinces will be made as circumstances dictate.

9. It will be appreciated that the numbers now applied for will form only a skeleton force, therefore a reasonable augmentation will be asked for in due course.
