Subj. : Lido di Roma - Evacuation of the zone on the right side of
Via del Mare (route 8)

As You know, by order of Allied Military Command ^{in last July} the population evacuated the zone placed on the right side of Via del Mare (route 8), owing to military reasons.

The Questura of Rome, informed us that since then, all the houses are uninhabited and that the allied soldiers have taken off boundaries notifying the prohibition of entrance. As the inhabitants are insistently applying for going back to their houses, in order to furnish them for the next winter, we would like to know if the reasons of the provisions are finished or if there is something against their going back.

Therefore we apply to ACC, for asking Allied Military Command, to examine the application of inhabitants of Lido di Roma and give the allowance. We kindly beg for an answer on the matter.

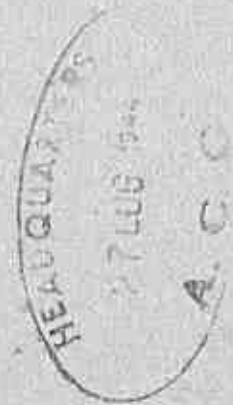
