The very allarming situation which has created itself in the territory of liberated Italy for

-)the appearance of evil doing bands armed with automatic pistols and hand-grenades, that go about in certain zones (Sicily-Campania-Sardegna-etc) committing many murders and crimes against property.
-)The fight taking place between political parties always becoming rougher- that fanatically look for and hide arms-so much so-that real squadrons of armed people already use intimidations and reprisals on the property and the people of their adversaries.
-)The separatist current that has developped amply in Sicily and in Sardegna, also have a considerable following making still more painful the tragic condition of our country trying to break up it's unity;

They make it necessary that the arma disposes of a permanent, ample, very efficacious information service to be able to arrive at seizing the hidden arms and follow all that is stirring up in the various environments, with the aim of not finding themselves caught by events of any kind that might gravely disturb the public order. To carry this out it is necessary that the commands of the carabinieri, also considering the depreciation of our money, have at their disposal ample financial means. That is the reason of the request of funds that we are dealing with, which will be divided between twelve legions who have collectively about three thousand commands of stations, besides numerous squadrons employed, in centres of particular importance, exclusively with services of judicial police.

IN the above mentioned amount is included a sum for premiums to be given to the soldiers who distinguish themselves in discovering crimes and recovering arms.

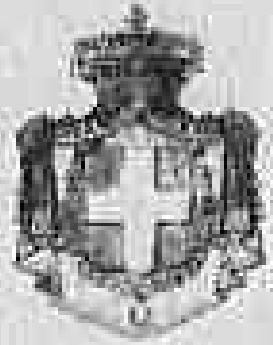
Having in mind the reasons stated, this Ministry has no objection against the allotment of 2.000.000 lire, every quarter, to CC.RR. for confidential information service.
