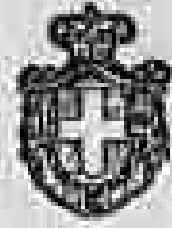

This is said to be necessary owing to the fact that Territorial H.Q. ROME has arranged for the de-requisitioning (for civil exigencies) of a car Fiat 508, Targa No. Roma 49111 formerly on charge to this unit.

2. It is not understood what civil exigencies justify the de-requisitioning of a motor vehicle at a time when the Italian Army is largely deficient in M.T.

3. In Naples, by the local Legion of CC.RR. is about to be formed a Mobile Battalion. Therefore we beg you to obtain to the a/m Legion 12 tanks or, in lack of such means, 12 medium armoured cars, having the light ones _ assigned to Sicily, Sardegna and to Rome Battalions _ proved to be unsuitable to the exigencies of public order.

It is also necessary to assign to the above said Legion (for the new battalion) at least 12 light armoured-cars in accordance with what was disposed for Mobile Battalions of Sicily and Sardegna.

Naples Legion has no motor-vehicles at its disposal for such use.

In this connection we inform you that the formations for Mobile Battalions of CC.RR., established by the Staff of Italian Army, foresees a Motor-cyclist Company every four platoons, having in force 51 single-seated-motorcycles, 22 double-seated-motorcycles and 8 motortricycles.

Such units, particularly if joined to tanks of to armoured cars, proved very useful for public order. So we beg your Sub-Commission to interest the competent Authorities in order to let us have the a/m means even in reduced quantity if it is not possible to ~~obtain~~ the whole needs (612 single-seated-motorcycles, 264 double-seated-motorcycles and 96 motortricycles for 12 battalions).

- 1. reference 3626/RC dated 14 January 1945.
- 2. (a) The primary responsibility for clothing and equipping CC.RR is one for MMIA (Land Forces Sub Commission) and Public Safety Sub Commission is in constant touch with them on it. The present directive is not satisfactory. MMIA's responsibility has, naturally, been primarily to the combat units and Public Safety Sub-Commission has not got the powers, organisation or personnel to look after their supplies. A letter on this is now approved and going forward to AFM, over the Chief Commissioner's signature. The following items have been allotted to northern Regions during the past few weeks

- 2500 Boots
- 700 Tunics
- 200 Pairs Trousers
- 400 Caps
- 700 Ties
- 700 Puttees

In addition the Ministry of war is manufacturing 4000 pairs of trousers for issue to CC.RR. Further clothing will be manufactured as more cloth becomes available.

(b) It is agreed that equipment supplied to CC.RR. generally has been of inferior quality. The grey green type of uniform being made of shoddy soon wears out, and in many cases second hand repaired clothing has been the supply resulting in a very poor turn out of the men. Until cloth of a proper type is obtained and made up it would appear that the unsatisfactory dress will continue. Some good uniforms have been uncovered in the north and a supply of cloth has also been located near Como. It is expected this will soon be unblocked by MMIA.

- 2 -

The shoes issued are 2nd hand repaired goods and as such require changing at frequent intervals.

Firearms have been in short supply and in many cases rifles have been issued instead of muskets. The procedure is to secure a supply of muskets from dumps of surrendered arms in the north. This however is unsatisfactory as evidence goes to show that inferior arms are being turned in; the assumption being that the good ones are being concealed for nefarious use at a later stage.

3. Reference Para 1(b). CC.RR. in the initial stages, as was expected from information received before the occupation, had a bad time as the C.I.N. would not recognise them. The situation is gradually changing for the better. The law abiding public are now weary of the banditry of so-called partisans and look to the CC.RR. to right matters. P.S. Officers are gradually getting the police accepted in their proper role and with increasing apprehensions of law breakers it is hoped that the interior rural districts will be on a par with the towns.

This can only be tackled by the P.P.S.C. and it is a slow but steady business.

4. Quostores for the most part have been appointees of C.I.N. Happily the demand for career officials is now increasing and a blend has been made of career assistants to guide the better of the C.I.N. Quostoras. The transient stage has been sticky and the uncertain political situation has militated against successful local government, but improvement is now apparent.

5. Transport has been a difficult matter. To date 48 3 ton trucks and 48 armoured cars have been allotted by AFHQ for CC.RR. mobile battalions (12 trucks and 12 armoured vehicles to each of the 4 Northern regions). 40 armoured cars proceeded to the North at the beginning of this week and are now in situation. These will be available to go to troubled spots. A further eight are undergoing repair. The 48 trucks were all Class 5 vehicles. 4 only were runners and these have been sent north. The other 44 are undergoing repair and will be sent north in small convoys as they are completed.

7821

6. On 17 February the Executive Commissioner suggested to V.P. C.A. Sec. that extra vehicles for CC.RR. should be allotted from the 1700 vehicles being made available for the carrying of supplies. CC.RR. needs were made known to the Executive Commissioner on March 45, but it was then stated that the allotment of a number of trucks from the 1700 available would be wrong in principle.

A request for additional transport for carabinieri was then made to MMIA on 21 March 1945. A complete statement of the vehicle position throughout the entire force was supplied and on 26 April 1945 MMIA replied that no additional vehicles could be allotted.

The matter was then referred to AFHQ by G-4 (B) who were preparing a consolidated statement of the needs of all A.G. transport requirements. The bid was made for 50 trucks on 14 May 1945 AFHQ replied that the general shortage of load carrying vehicles in this theatre made it impossible to release additional vehicles to CC.FR.

7. 50 Italian Army Recon cars have been released to Carabinieri by MMIA. These carry 2 men each and at the present time Carabinieri are being taught to drive this rather unusual vehicle in the Italian Army driving school. These vehicles are only of use for short patrol in towns to show the flag and cannot be considered as any real assistance from a transportation point of view.

8. CC.FR. General Teddei has been in the north reorganising the force and his return and report should soon be available. In the light of his investigations coupled with the reports of R.P.S.O's much improvement should be effected.

9. Finally it must be reiterated that a general programme of refitting CC.FR. - a force of 65,000 - plus the acquisition of more transport must be faced by Higher Authority.

1. It is proposed to form a mobile CC.NR battalion in each of the four northern Regions to be used to deal with cases of public disorder. For this purpose 3 ton trucks and armoured vehicles have been allotted by AFHQ.

2. Each battalion consists of 500 men (to be drawn from the existing strength of the legions) carried in 1 light utility truck or car, 12 3 ton trucks and 12 armoured vehicles. This transport lifts 300 men, the rest form a reserve.

3. At present 48 trucks 48 armoured vehicles and 2 light utilities have been drawn and are undergoing repair. They are class B vehicles.

4. The armoured vehicles are expected to be ready for movement during the coming week and 12 each will be sent to Genoa, Turin, Milan, and Padova.

5. 4 trucks are in good condition. 2 have been sent to Milan and 2 to Senigallia. If the 500 CC.NR have left Senigallia for Padova, the 2 trucks will proceed on to Padova.

6. One light utility has been sent to Milan and one to Senigallia for Padova.

7. The need for transport in northern regions is well understood at this Headquarters, and you will be informed by cable when vehicles leave Rome bound for your areas.

During the meeting held at the Ministry (Col. Balanzino's Office) on the 27th April 1945, in the presence of Major HALL, it was agreed upon that first preference should be given for the repairs of one hundred motor-vehicles of the CC.RR. Force, divided the following way:

and according the following order:

- Trucks
- Cars

Difficulties are met in the putting into effect of the provision then agreed upon, above all in the forwarding of the auto-vehicles to the a/m Repair Units; difficulties which are easily overcome in regard to the vehicles existing in the same locality, where the Repair Unit is located, but not for vehicles detached in localities far away from the quarters of the repair Unit, to which, nevertheless they should be sent in order to be put into efficiency.

Thus, for instance, it is happening now, that, given the small number assigned to the 1st Repair Unit (30), this Gen.HQ. is obliged to send from Rome to the 2nd Unit of Naples, n. 25 Cars and 8 motor-cycles, in charge of the 3 Legions of the Capital: Lazio - Rome and Cadets; the same occurs for the Chieti Legion, which must send to Naples 4 cars and 1 motor-cycle, without even the possibility to effect railway transport. The same applies to the Catanzaro Legion, which must send to Bari 1 truck and 4 cars, and to the Ancona Legion, which must send to Florence 2 trucks, 5 cars and 1 motor-cycle.

Now, other than the possibility of obtaining with the necessary urgency railway waggons, where it is possible, there is no other solution, than that to effect the transport with trucks with consequent remarkable consumption of fuel and an expense superior to the amount of the repairs themselves.

Così, a titolo di esempio, accade ora che, data la modesta aliquota assegnata al 1° Reparto Riparazioni (30 unità) questo comando generale è costretto ad inviare da Roma al 2° Reparto di Napoli, n°25 autovetture e 8 motocicli, in carico alle tre legioni della capitale: Lazio - Roma e Allievi; così accade per la legione di Chieti che deve inviare a Napoli 4 autovetture e 1 motociclo, senza aver neppure la possibilità di effettuare trasporti ferroviari.- Lo stesso dicasi per la legione di Catanzaro che deve inviare a Bari un autocarro e quattro autovetture, e per la legione di Ancona che deve inviare a Firenze due autocarri, 5 autovetture e un motociclo.-

Ora, a prescindere dalla possibilità di ottenere con la desiderata sollecitudine i carri ferroviari, ove tali trasporti sono effettuabili, e tenuto conto che in molti luoghi la ferrovia manca o non è ancora in funzione, non rimane praticamente altra soluzione - anche in rapporto all'urgenza - che quella di effettuare trasporti per via ordinaria, ricorrendo, se del caso, a imprese private locali, con la conseguenza di un notevole consumo di carburante e di una spesa che sorpassa normalmente di gran lunga l'importo stesso delle riparazioni.- Il che si rileva ancor più antieconomicoⁱⁿ questi casi, nei quali il trasporto dovrebbe essere fatto unicamente per dotare gli automezzi della gommatura (copertoni e camere d'aria) di cui sono privi.-

o)-consentire alle legioni che incontrano le prospettate difficoltà nell'invio degli automezzi ai Reparti Riparazioni, di far eseguire sul posto, come per il passato, le riparazioni stesse, evitando così costosi trasporti e inutile consumo di benzina.-

Tale sistema, eliminando la necessità dei trasporti, sembra dimostrarsi più agile e snello non tanto per le cento unità da rimettere in efficienza con precedenza assoluta, quanto per le riparazioni a carattere normale da apportare a tutti gli altri automotomezzi dell'Arma, tuttora inefficienti.-





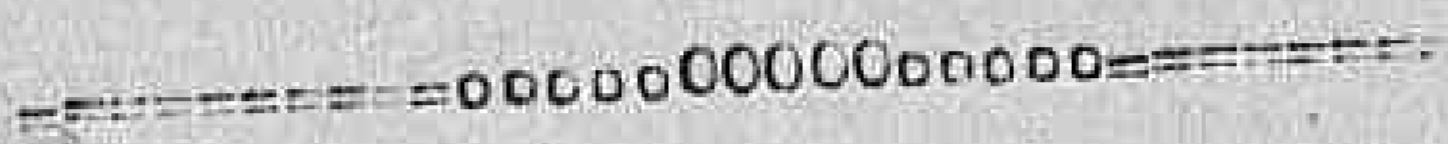

2. Attached is a list of the vehicles issued to BARI CC.RR. Territorial Legion with their present locations. It will be noticed that the list includes two Dodge trucks (Nos 8 and 9) not shown on your letter of 5th April 1945.
3. From enquiry it is understood that the trucks were issued in consideration of the state of public order existing in Puglia and Calabria, which required the rapid movement of bodies of CC.RR. This condition still exists.

1. Reference your AC/14153/PS dated 21 March 1945.
2. It has now been decided that both 'A' and 'B' vehicles for 4 Bns, to the scale shown in Appendix 'A' to your letter of above reference, shall be provided from British stocks, in view of the fact that these units will be operating under No.2 District.
3. A total of 48 "Greyhound" Arm'd Cars will be earmarked against this commitment together with 4 cars lt. Utility and 48 lorries 3 ton 4x2 GS. It should be noted that all the 'B' vehicles will be Class V (Runners), but every endeavour will be made to replace these by Class I or II when the Bns become operational.
4. The position regarding the actual release and collection of these vehicles is as follows

'A' Vehicles Only 29 out of the 48 authorized are immediately available. The remaining 19 have to be serviced and it is unlikely that this will be commenced before May. The release orders for all these 'A' vehicles will be sent to Headquarters 2 District who will advise you re collection in due course.

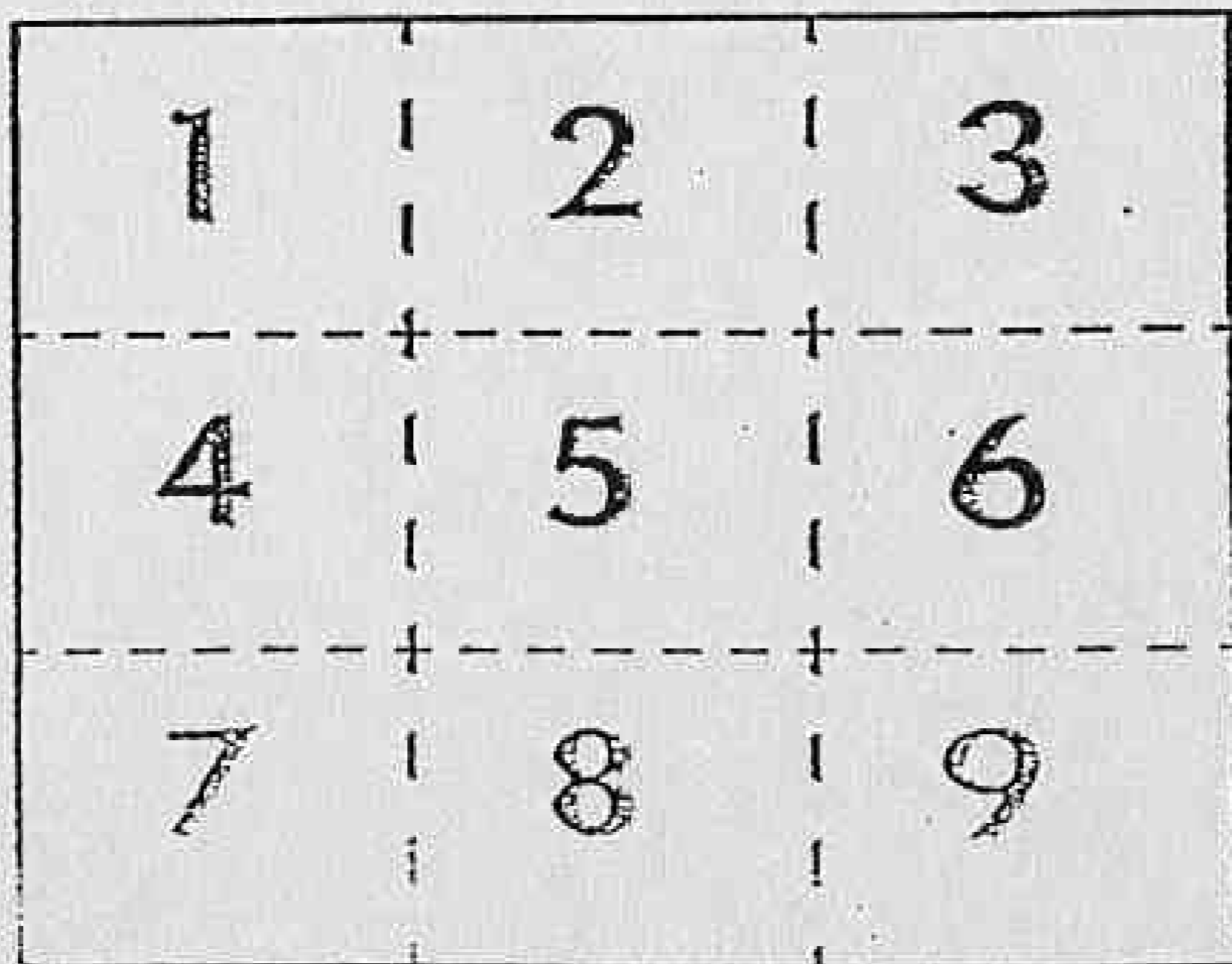
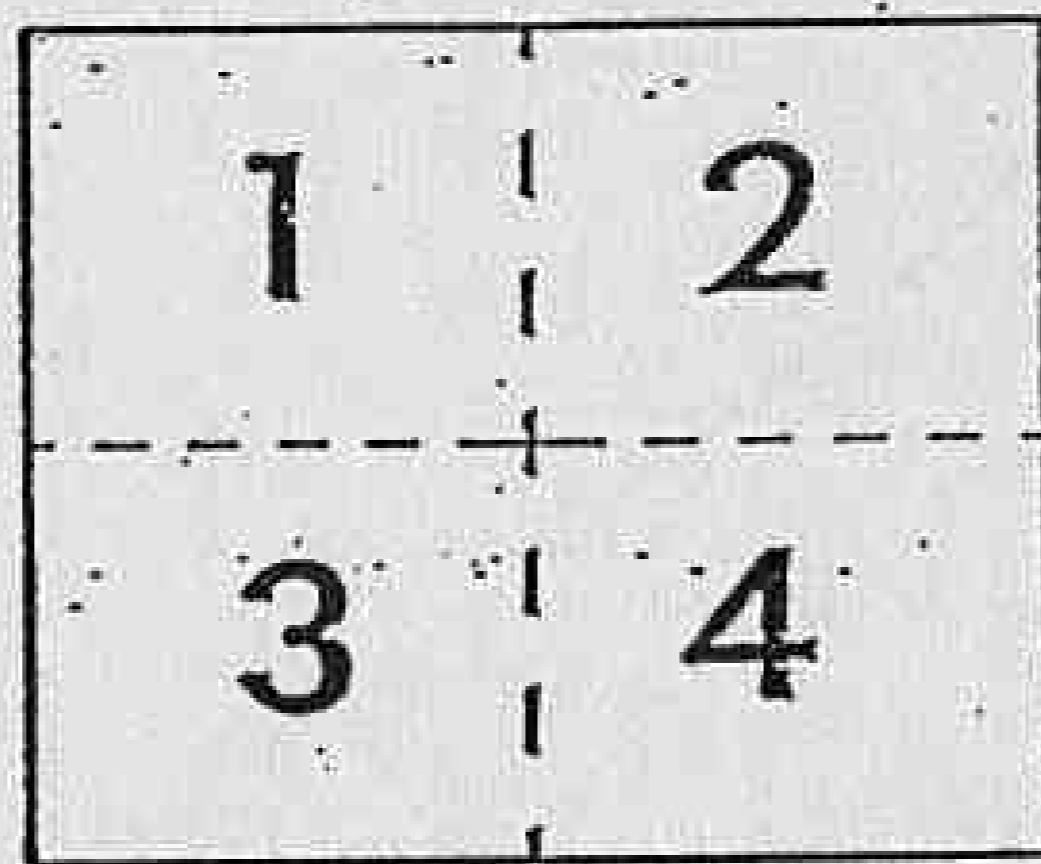
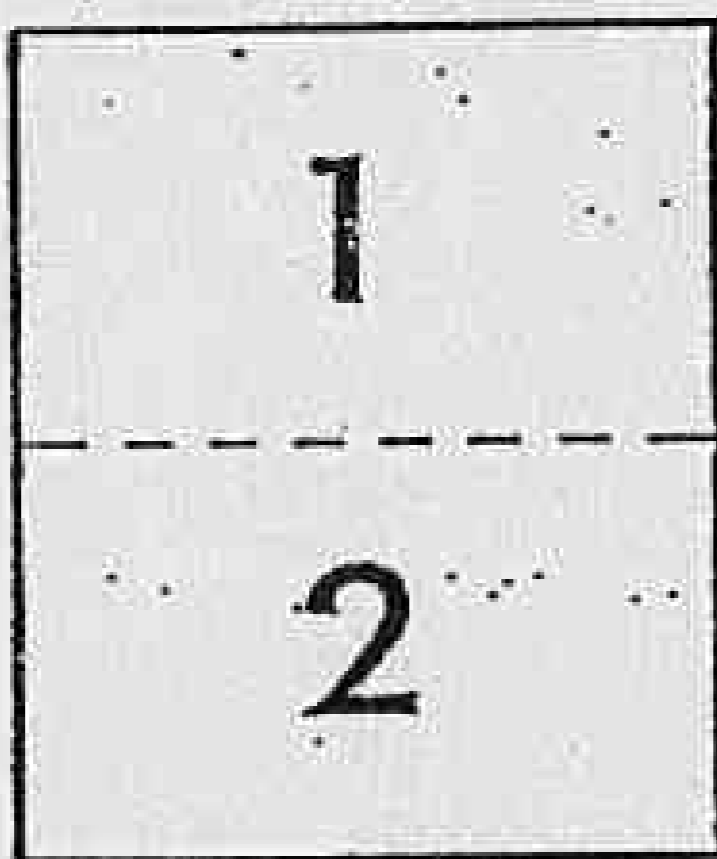

The Rome Legion has no auto-vehicles available to be employed for that purpose, nor is it possible to requisition them from civilians in perfect conditions.

It is deemed opportune to add that the constitution of the a/m unit is urgent in order to put the Force into the condition to meet the eventual exigencies of public order and security.




