I transcribe the following cable n.7/58 R. dated 24th instant received from the Tempio (Sassari) CC.RR. Company Command:

""At Tempio (Sassari) on the 23th instant at 1000 hrs. about 200 students forming into procession went to the main square of the town, where a professor hold a speech re-confirming the Italian character of Trieste and other places claimed by Yugoslavia. The demonstration was interupted by social-communists. The CC.RR. Force avoided further disturbances.""

I transcribe the following cable received from the
 Sassari C.RR. group(cable n:427/2 dated 21th April):

""to-day, 21th April, at 10 hrs, in sassari about one thousand
 students of university and middle schools, having crossed the
 most important streets of the town, singing patriotic hymns,
 stopped in front of the town-hall, where has been laid down a
 wreath on the grave-stone of the fallen during the war1915+18.

The prof. Giovanni Roris, chief of the italian democratic
 juvenile movement, having read the spiritual testament of the
 martyr oberdan, spoke against the unjust revengings of Marshal
 rito for the annexation of Venezia Giulia to the Jugoslavia.

Therefor he read the order of the day in order that the
 Italian government will take a definite position refusing the
 absurd jugo-slav revengings.

The demonstration has finished without incidents.

The demonstration produced a great impression to the po-
 pulation."

Subject : Cagliari - Disturbances.

To : A.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission - Rome.

The following report has been received to-day  
from the Int. CC.RR. company of Cagliari:

"" On the 18 inst., at 1700 hrs., at Cagliari, Jenne square, about 500 students attempted to make a public demonstration against the call-up, but were hindered by the Public Forces. Subsequently a group of students attempted to break into the premises of the newspaper "UNIONE SARDA", but were again repelled by the Public Forces. On this occasion, about 20 hand-grenades were thrown, in several points of the city, which slightly injured 1 r.s. official, 4 agents, 5 soldiers and 8 civilians. Also a CC.RR. F.C.C. has been slightly injured. As a result of serious wounds the agent DI MAURRO Ezio died after some hours. At 2100 hrs. Order has been re-established.
