Sir,

Having obtained the approval of Colonel Charles Poletti, S.C.A.O., Sicily, I request that you grant permission for the issuing of a visa for Sicily by H.B.M. Consul General at Tanjer and or Tunis to my mother, a British subject, who has been residing at Tanjer as a refugee since the entrance of Italy in the war. At the time of the declaration of war my mother was my guest at Tripoli, where I was British Vice Consul, and left Lybia with me under diplomatic immunity.

Since my mother has property in Italy, I submit that there should not be any undue difficulty in the issuing of the necessary instructions, since once on Italian Territory she would not be a burden to the Allied Military Government.

My mother could proceed to Tunis, and embark there for Sicily on one of the civilian cargo ships which run between that port and this island.

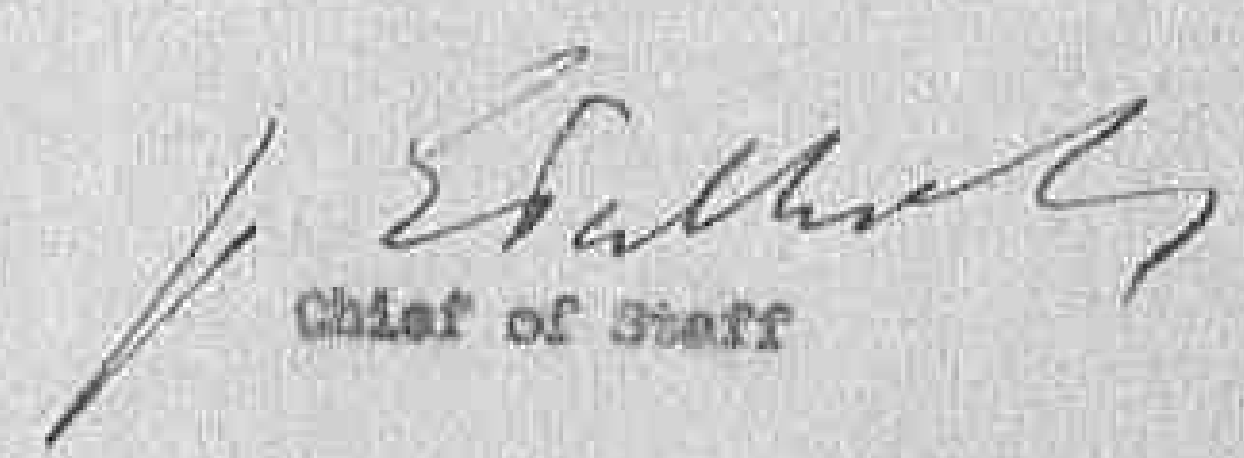
