We are sorry to again trouble you in this connection but  
your letter did not give us the information we requested in ours of  
August 21st. Therefore, will you kindly obtain definite information  
on the following questions:

- A. Did Frank Talotta have any estate in Italy other than real estate?
- B. Was there an administrator appointed to administer his estate? If so, we desire the name and address of the administrator.
- C. In whose name was the title to the various pieces of property in  
and around Soveria Simeri as of November 14 1944?
- D. What is the Italian law relative to inheritance of property of an  
intestate decedent. Frank Talotta, deceased, was survived by his  
wife, resident in Italy, and two (2) children by that marriage  
residing with their mother in Italy. He was also survived by three  
(3) children, by a previous marriage, living in the United States.

As a matter of record, the property in our possession and of which  
we are administrator will, under the Pennsylvania Intestate Law, pass  
1/3 to the widow and each of the five (5) children will receive 1/5  
of 2/3 or 2/15.

Unless the real estate situate in Italy was in the name of  
husband and wife, by the entirety, we feel that, unless the Italian law  
is substantially different from the Pennsylvania law, the three (3) children  
by the former marriage will have an interest in the Italian real estate.
