TO: All Concerned

1. Letter this headquarters, file and subject as above, dated 5 July 1945, is rescinded, and the following substituted therefor.

2. Below is outlined the Form to be followed in making inquiries for relatives or other individuals, when the originator of the inquiry is in MTO (CMF). There is listed below the nations of this theater, and the address of the Agency that will process the inquiry. Inquiries for persons in any part of the world should go direct to these agencies and not through this headquarters.

3. Inquiries originated by persons in Italy, Corsica and that part of North Africa under CMF control should be directed to:

Allied Commission, Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub Commission.
Records Bureau, Rome.

4. Inquiries originated by persons in Greece should be directed to:

British Red Cross Foreign Relations Section,
c/o Headquarters, Land Forces Military Liaison, CMF.

5. Inquiries originated by persons in Jugoslavia should be directed to:

Military Attaché, British Embassy, or
Military Attaché, US Embassy, Belgrade for Jugoslaw Red Cross.

6. Inquiries originated by persons in Albania should be directed to:

British Military Mission, Albania, for Albanian Red Cross.

7. Inquiries originated by persons in Bulgaria should be directed to:

Allied Control Commission, Bulgaria, US Delegation or
British Delegation for Bulgarian Red Cross.

8. Inquiries originated by persons in Rumania should be directed to:

British Delegation for Hungarian Red Cross.

10. Inquiries originated by persons in Austria should be directed to:

Headquarters, British Troops Austria, AMG for Central Records
Bureau.
British Red Cross.

11. This instruction applies to personnel of the Armed Forces as well
as civilians making inquiries.

12. Inquiries must be made in conformity with Appendix "A". -2B-

13. When British Red Cross Units and Allied Commission Units leave
the country, inquiries should be submitted direct to National Red Cross in
the country of the inquirer, i.e. if in Italy to the Italian Red Cross,
if in Greece submit inquiry to the Greek Red Cross, etc.

1. With the cessation of hostilities an increasing number of welfare and whereabouts inquiries in respect of individuals is being received in this headquarters (G-5 Section). In the majority of cases, the only possible action is transmitting to the Allied controlling authorities in the country where the individual was known to have been or from where last news was received.



3. Inquiries in respect of countries not so named should continue to be addressed to this headquarters for G-5 Section and they will be forwarded to the appropriate authorities.

4. It is also requested that the results of inquiries be communicated to the International Red Cross Committee (Records Bureau) GENEVA which will be grateful for the information in connection with inquiries it receives from all parts of the world.
