SUBJECT : Deserters from the Italian Army
prior to Armistice.

TO : Army Sub-Commission.

1. This Sub-Commission has been informed that there are a substantial number of ex-members of the Italian Army at large, who according to their own statements, deserted because they did not wish to fight for Fascism and after having been apprehended and given prison sentences escaped about the time of the armistice and whose re-arrest is still being sought.
2. It is said that a number of such persons are in hiding and although anxious to assist the Allies are afraid to show themselves for fear of arrest.
3. I should be glad to know whether any policy has already been contemplated for dealing with such persons and whether there has been any question of granting amnesty in such cases.
4. If you are of the opinion that there are likely to be a sufficient number of persons affected, I believe it would be a wise step to decide upon the policy to be followed so that the necessary publicity can be given.

SUBJECT: Deserters from Italian Army prior to Armistice.

TO : HQ ACC, Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. Information has been received at this HQ that certain persons who deserted from the Italian Army, on their own statements because they did not wish to fight for Fascism, and were given ^{prison} sentences, escaped about the time of the Armistice, and are now at large but wanted by the CC.RR.

2. It seems that a number of such persons are in hiding, and while anxious, so they say, to assist the Allies, are afraid to show themselves for fear of arrest.

3. It is possible that some policy exists for the treatment of such persons, but in any case the Regional Commissioner has asked that some directions may be given as a general guide on this subject, so that Public Safety officers may act accordingly, and give the necessary instructions to CC.RR.
