Subject : Request for uniforms and shoes to be assigned to
the Firemen-Corps.

To : Allied Force Headquarters - Caserta.

I, the undersigned, Chief of the Firemen-Corps of Sora (Province of Frosinone), in the name of the 11 members of this Detachment, take the liberty to apply to your Command so that 11 ordinary winter woolen uniforms, 11 woolen coats, 11 raincoats and 11 pairs of shoes, be detracted from the clothes which are being assigned to the Italian Government, and be allotted to our Corps.

It is pointed out that this Corps could not provide clothes and shoes for itself since 1933, either because they were not available on the market and because of their high cost. But now, we are forced by the necessity to appeal to the Allied Command who, not only liberated Italy from the Germans, but greatly has contributed to its rebirth.

Relying on the generosity of your Command and awaiting for an early reply, I thank you on behalf of the 11 members of the Detachment.

This Ministry requested requested the Ministry of War-
General Direction Commissariat and Administrative Services- to
grant to the Agents of P.S. Corps the 6.000 camp-beds presently
in stock at the CC.RR. Station of Tarquinia. We are informed by
the s/m Ministry that your Commission did not comply with such
request alleging that the s/m Corps are not included in the
Corps authorized.

Referring to the s/m this Ministry deems it necessary to
point out that, owing to the R.D.I. 31 July 1943 N° 587 the Agents
of P.S. Corps have been incorporated in the "Armed Forces of the
State together with the CC.RR. Corps". Consequently the s/m refusal
does seem to be explicable.

As the exclusion of the s/m Corps from the allotments of
this kind is prejudicial to the re-organization and the streng-
thening of the Police, we beg your Commission kindly to re-examine
the s/m request that is suggested by urgent necessities, which
could not be delayed.

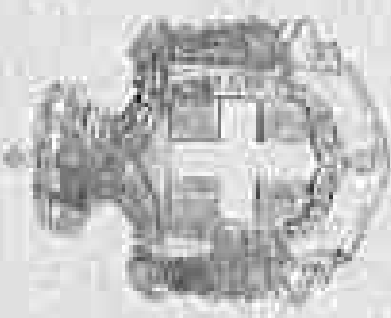

As per our agreement with you, we forward four lists of various materials needed by the Public Security Police Force. These four lists deal with clothing, equipment, weapons and transportation.

May we call your attention to the fact that these requirements are based upon the strength of 32000 agents, of which 22000 are in operation, and 10000 are in the process of being recruited, and that this total strength is an allocation, only, for the 49 provinces which come under Italian administration as of the present date.

We should also like to point out that to quite an extent, the bicycle requirements together with the parts requirements for them, include the needs of the Royal Carabinieri.

2. However, a representative of Commerce Sub-Commission is visiting Florence during the next few days and he has promised to investigate the position with a view to finding alternative material suitable for the purpose.
3. It is suggested that suitable material is sometimes sold by auction from Army Depots at Livorno, and it may be worth while instructing one of your officials there to solicit the help of the A.S. Police Officer at Livorno, to see the material with a view to purchase.
4. With reference to the list of requirements of threads, cottons and buttons, if you will submit a detailed list of sizes, colours, and quantities etc, of the thread, cotton and buttons, to this Office, it is anticipated that immediate supply can be made.
5. Respecting the other articles mentioned it is possible that within a short time, an allocation of some or all of these items will be made by Commerce S/C to the Italian Ministry of Commerce Industry and Labour, and you are advised to submit detailed demands to the Italian Ministry at once, and to keep in touch with them on the matter.

1. Reference letters addressed to your office from H.Q. 5th Army, Commerce and Industry Section of 23 February on the same subject.

2. As nothing further has been heard on this matter of obtaining 10,000 meters of cotton lining material for uniforms for the Agents of Public Security, this office is taking the liberty of communicating with you on this matter.

3. The agents of Public Security are a most essential part of the police forces and as such A.F.R.G. and A.C. are most anxious that they be clothed and equipped. Uniforms have been cut and are practically complete and ready for issuance with the exception of the linings. This Sub-Commission and the Italian authorities have searched all of liberated Italy for the necessary material without success. The only possibility that now remains of obtaining the material is in the territory under the jurisdiction of your office.

4. As the agents of public security are practically a military organization and are not able to enter commercial transactions it will be impossible for them to supply materials in exchange for the release of these textiles. However, it is felt that realizing the urgent and quasi military need for the lining material involved your office will be willing to waive this requirement.

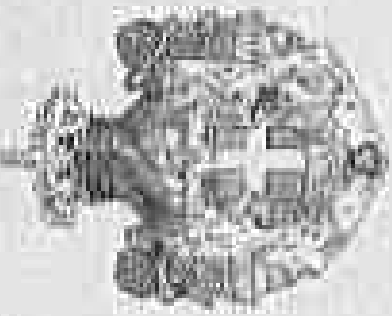

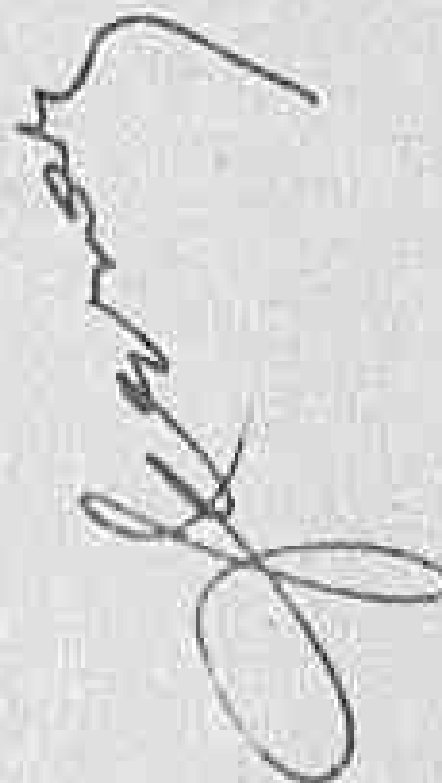

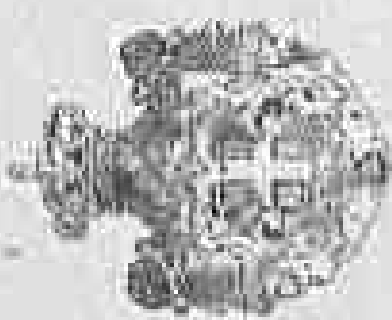

SUBJECT : Clothes and equipment for P.S. Agents.

In reply to your letter A.C./14613/5/P.S. of 30 June 1945 we inform you that, according to the principles printed out in your letter of 12 October 1944 in regard to the procedure to be followed in order to obtain the shoe and cloth supply necessary to re-organize the corps of the P.S. Agents, we have immediately made the requests, calculating the respective requirements roughly on the basis of an organizational plan which foresees the equipment of 5000 men within 30 June 1945 and another 5,000 for the future.

It was deemed opportune, however, to inform you also of the various requirements, (including arms and bicycles) not mentioned in the list of the materials for which requests should have been forwarded to the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour.

This was done by our letter No. 999.9687 A.G./3255 of 21 October 1944 which was answered by your letter ACC/14613/5/PS of 29th October 1944, stating that applications for clothes, arms etc. must be forwarded to the Italian Ministry of Industry, Commerce and

If this matter has been taken up with Commerce Sub-Commission

Labour.

The instructions laid down in the letter of 12th October 1944 have been communicated not only to the Offices and Commands under the Italian Government, but also to those of the provinces still under the A.M.G. jurisdiction. ~~Consequence of that~~ - Therefore the various Prefectures have forwarded to us several requests for large amounts of uniforms, arms, ~~the~~ underwear, shoes, civilian clothes etc., in order to obtain them through the Ministry of Industry Commerce and Labour. The a/m requests are in relation to the present needs of the various P.S. units, especially in those provinces where the Agents were disbanded by the Germans or dispersed and then came back without the necessary clothing to enable them to carry out their service with the decorum.

It was the intention of this Ministry to issue gradually the a/m material to the various units as quickly as possible in regard to the difficulty of transport, as we hoped that the material requested from as far back as the 19th of Nov - 1944 would be soon allocated by the Ministry of Ind - Comm - and Labour.

3

Although we have repeatedly pointed out to the Ministry the urgency of our needs, nothing positive has been obtained so far - Therefore, the complaints of the various ~~units~~ units, on which the Regional P.S. Officers have reported to you, are fully justified.

Moreover, we hoped that our letter 333.9687. A.G./Ah34 of 19th Nov. 1944 in reply to yours AC/4601/8/P.S of 16th Nov. 1944 would have had a more rapid and successful issue. In your letter you, while confirming the agreements made with the Ministry of Ind. Commerce and Labour on the supply of the P.S. Corps with shoes and clothing, you pointed out another source for exceptional issues of shoes, socks, under-pants, pull-overs, blankets and shirts, i.e. items that P.S. Agents need vitally.

The only allocations we have obtained for several months are that of 2500 pairs of re-built shoes, which was ordered by your S/C in October 1944, (those shoes are useful, in default of anything better, but cannot be used very long) and that of some small quantities of leather for the manufacture of 500 pairs of shoes and ~~also~~ for repair. The other requests for lining, shirt and pant linen and cotton have had no issue by the Southern Cotton Manufacturers of

Naples, where it seems that all products are blocked at the disposal of the War Office.

~~As our officials~~ ~~you verbally~~ ~~late~~

As one of our Officials has verbally informed you lately, the problem of the equipment for P.S. Agents is still to be solved, to the serious prejudice of the morale and of the discipline of the units.

While drawing your attention ~~to~~ to the requirements already indicated in the a/m letters of 21st October and 13 Nov-1944, we earnestly hope that you will lend us your valid assistance so that the P.S. Administration may be granted suitable allocations of material.

The following items are pointed out as particularly urgent: stuff for uniforms, civilian clothes, automatic arms and relative ammunitions, shoes, shirts, under-pants, vests, socks, blankets, sheets.

It is deemed particularly necessary that the a/m allocations should be made in Rome or in other cities not far from Rome.

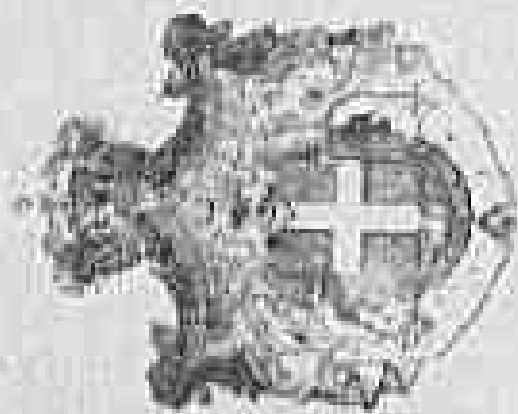

3. The essential information reported is:-
 - a. All of the cloth involved was allotted to the Ministry of War by Industry Commerce Sub Commission AC on 20 July 1944.
 - b. Considerable difficulty has been experienced in collecting the material, due to the fact that there has been some disagreement as to the price and terms of payment, and also due to the fact that the Italian Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labor have seen fit to issue additional release orders in conflict with the original allotment to the Ministry of War by ACC.
 - c. The Ministry of War have not issued any freezing orders against any items, except those already allotted to them.
4. All of the materials involved are critically needed for repair and maintenance of clothing and equipment for Italian Operational Forces. It is understood that the price difficulties have very largely been adjusted, and that collection of the materials by the Ministry of War is now in the process of completion.

Owing to absolute deficiency of its warehouses, and to lack of cloth for uniforms on the market, and to the fact that most important ^{textiles} manufactures of ~~are~~ in occupied Italy, this Ministry, even with the most favourable inclination of Board of Trade, Industry and Work, cannot rely on the execution of a modest plan of re-organisation of P.S. Agents Corps, which needs at least, of the essential supply of a few thousand uniforms.

From another reason, owing to present situation, it is impossible to change the usual uniforms of P.S. Agents Corps and therefore no hope of ^{reaching} in a short time, the assignment by War Department, of two stocks of grey-green cloth, the former of 5.000 mt. and the latter of 9.000 mt., which have been ordered to Lanificio Napoli Michele of Baronissi (Salerno) and Guida of Lago-Negro (Potenza).

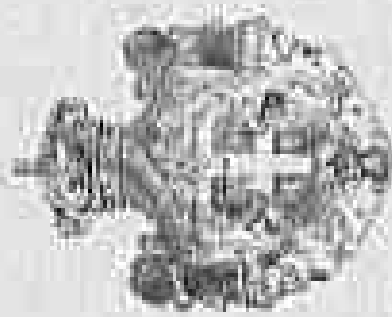
Consequently it is necessary to integrate the actual uniforms, with others of ~~the~~ same or similar cloth, with same changes in the fashion.

This stated, notwithstanding that's Subcommission letter, ACC/14613/5/PS, date 29 October ult., which states that, applications for equipment materials for P.S. Agents Corps, must be forwarded to the Board of Trade, I., and Work, this Ministry, all the same, seems advisable to appeal to A.C., in order that among cloth conveyed or going to be conveyed from U.S. into Italy, to this Ministry for P.S. agents, be granted stocks of 15.000 mt. of uniform cloth and 9.000 mt. of overcoat cloth, of a type and colour similar to attached samples.

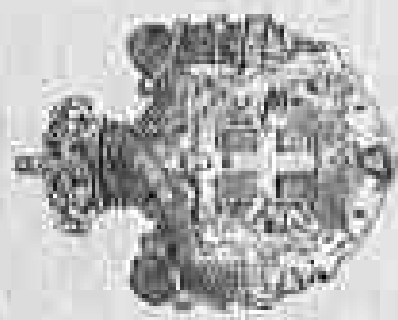

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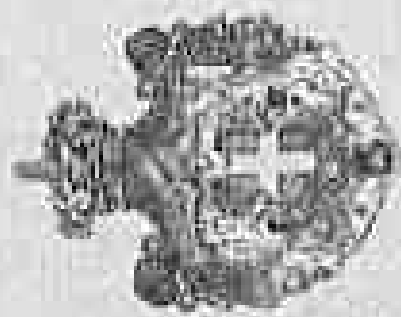

1. Reference your ACC/14601/SPS of 29 June.

2. A quantity of uniforms as requested in your application on ACC MAT 10 dated 13 May, have now been dyed, but they are at present in the possession of Br.Ord. from whom early release has been requested. On receipt of this and particulars of availability appropriate releases will be made to you for Agents of Public Security.

3. A small quantity of white cloth is available. This, however, is frozen and releases are only effected when a high degree of justification is made out, e.g. for hospital bed linen. Release for the purpose of making shirts is not normally regarded as being of a sufficiently high order of priority, but if a strong case can be made out, applications would be carefully considered.

4. Details of remaining stocks are not immediately available, but if you are of the opinion that requirements for Vigili Urbani can be justified over and above other sections of the community and administrative services and will indicate minimum essential needs, these would be considered in relation to other priorities.

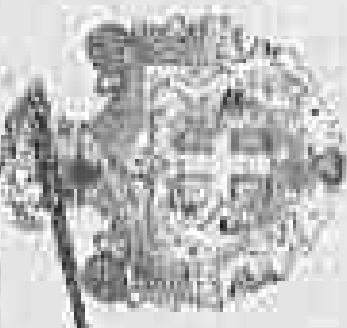

In March 1944 Representatives were made through the Chief Commissioner ACC that Agents of Public Security should be treated in the same manner as the Royal Carabinieri and the Royal Finance Guards, who draw clothing and equipment through the Italian Army. It has now been decided by AWHQ that the Agents of Public Security are not entitled to Italian Army supplies.
5. In normal times, clothing and equipment for Agents of Public Security is obtained by the Minister of Interior from Civil contractors, and is issued to Div. Commanders, who maintain their own Q.M. Stores and distribute it to their men. On a fixed term, such as 18 months for a jacket, 8 months for trousers and 10 months for boots, the clothing is renewed. Replacements are paid for by the agents. The last general issues were made at the end of 1942.
6. The existing supplies from such sources are nil. Almost the entire stocks remaining at the time of the Armistice were seized by the Germans. A very small supply held at Bari has been issued and stocks are exhausted.
7. As no new issued of clothing have been made for approximately 18 months, uniforms of Agents in liberated Italy are in a deplorable condition.
8. The present strength of Agents Public Security is as follows:-

The strength, if and when all the area up to the Pisa-Rimini line is occupied is estimated at 19,000.

9. The Minister of the Interior has supplied the attached "A" list of requirements based on an estimated strength of 19000 men.

10. The immediate requirements to enable Agents of Public Security to continue their duties are 4000 sets of uniform (i.e. battle dress and boots)

11. It is requested that arrangements be made to supply the immediate needs and to provide for future requirements.
