1. With regard to the above, do you think we should reinstate these people and officially recognise them?
2. I hear that many of them did good work, and on the other hand a big proportion were only gufflers and mixed up in a series of rackets.
3. Col. Foletti would like us to submit an impartial report on the matter; their background, what powers they have and how they are paid.
4. I believe there were some 360 in the Rome area before. If there is a strong case for their reinstatement I think they should all be carefully screened before re-employment.
5. I believe all previous vigilanti were inscribed in the fascist party. Is this true?
