SUBJECT: Theft of electrical conductor and material

TO : Chief Commissioner - A.C.C.

1. The theft of transmission line conductor and other electrical material continues to increase. This is seriously interfering with the war effort. Unless it is stopped the supply of power for military and essential civilian requirements will be seriously curtailed and the transmission of power to Rome prevented.

2. It is requested that action be taken to stop such thefts and to apprehend and punish the thieves. Immediate action is required on the transmission line Frattina-More-Liri in the vicinity of Villa Literno and Cellio Croccia.
