Ref. your letter AC/14616/5/PS of 15 March '45 received via Region IV for reply direct.

The Forest Guards mentioned in the third paragraph of your letter have not been reinstated.

On 24 February '45, Dott G. Ganganelli, Direttore dei Servizi Forestali, took a complete report on these men to Rome with him. I made the following endorsement on the report.

" With reference to the seven men named herein the delegate for the epuration Commission and the F.S.S. have been consulted—there is no objection by Public Safety to the reinstatement of these men and it is considered desirable in the interests of the efficiency of the Forest Guards that these trained men should be re-employed. In view of the terms of the decree, however, the decision of Lt. Col. White is desired before the reinstatement is confirmed.

The Provincial Commissioner concurs with these views."

Lt Col CRISTOFANI Dr. Giuseppe of Alessandria and of Migliosi Emilia, born at Assisi on the 10th of September 1890, Commander of the R.F.C. Group at Jesi (Ancona), at the time of the liberation of said city was arrested as a spy suspect.

Later on he had the permission to circulate in the city; This permission was given every fifteen days.

With such a permission given by the Italian Command, he could not fully take care of his services, and this he brought up to the local Allied Authority in order to have a permit to circulate in the Province.

After this the F.S.S. searched his home and found a pistol and three grenades.

Therefore the Allied Police proceeded with the arrest of the officer mentioned, who still is in concentration camp No. 371 F.O.W. (Padula).

We ask this Commission to examine the possibility of effectuating certainty of responsibilities attributable to the officer in question, thereby settling his case.

Therefore, according to the Italian law, FRANCHETTI would be entitled to the treatment stated by art. 22 of the decree Luogotenenziale 27.7.1944 n. 159.-

In this case, the above mentioned Ministry, has brought to notice that, for similiar cases, the Allied Commission has answered in favour.

Therefore, it is wormly begged that with courteous urgency you will let us know if you have no opposition so that Franchetti be only considered suspended and not dismissed from his employment and be treated as above said.

2. In view of the security objection, this HQ has suspended MICHELANGELI from office.

3. Request that an order of dismissal be prepared and forwarded to this HQ in accordance with Executive Memorandum No. 45 (ACC) para 8 (b), assuming that list "B" of the officials to be screened is extended to cover this appointment.

AT THE TIME

Small forestal news.

We have seen for some time the desperate fussing of the old foxes of the bygone regime which, taking advantage of the present time of resettling are changing flags and creating alibis for themselves moving on again, to day as yesterday, and attacking, so as to regain some more or less safer position.

It is an opportunity for us to disclose one of those brazen faces: the Consul Mario Michelangeli, ex Commander of the VII Legione Forestale di Aquila.

To tell in few words of the servile work of this shameless fellow is certainly hard to do. We will only give a few examples. As a Legion Commander he was told to transfer the Command Northward. These instructions were followed by a counter order which repealed them. But Michelangeli, whose interest was to be transferred to Macerata, his native city, did not take any notice of it and concealing it, gave orders to retreat, pretending that any one who attempted to refuse to go Northward should be denounced to the Military Tribunal of War. As a matter of fact many denunciations poured on that tribunal about noncommissioned Officers and men of the Legione Forestale.

It is easy to understand the immense damage his arbitrary decision made on the forestal property of the Abruzzo.

The woods already so much damaged by German vandalism were left at the mercy of the transgressors.

Deprived of any control, the deposits of coal and fuel wood, constituted at the expense of the State for the use of the civil population were, for the most part, destroyed.

The Michelangeli, immediately, put himself at the disposal of the Republic and the Germans.

In order to deserve praise he organized a patrol service with the Forestal Militia men for the capture of the allied prisoners and the patriots rambling through the woods and mountains.

During the time he was on duty, at the Central Command of the Forestal Militia in Rome, he was the right arm of the ill-famed General Augusto Agostini, the same, being a medical Lt. in the Reserve was transferred to the direction of the Forestal Service making regular his position by the merits of others, getting his degree in Forestal science and Silviculture.

Now the Consul Mario Michelangeli, after so awful precedents, has had the sauciness to appoint himself head of the Forestal Compartment in Macerata of whom, so he thinks, should depend the same militia-men, the same non commissioned officers he so drastically threatened.

We invoke from the Allied Authority the immediate removal of this fellow who, when the time has come, will have to answer to the people for all his past misdeeds.
